## **United Kennel Club rules**

For exhibitors attending their first UKC show, here is a brief summary of some of the rules that you should be familiar with – this is for general information purposes, the exact wording of the rules is available in the Conformation Rule Book and online at the UKC site.

- 1. Grooming should be kept to a minimum no foreign substances or excessive grooming is allowed.
- 2. No grooming or grooming tools in the ring.
- 3. No bait unless the judge allows it, in which case it must not be thrown, tossed, or land on the ground.
- 4. No professional handlers.
- 5. Dogs must be kept under control.
- 6. Exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs.
- 7. No alcohol or illegal drugs are permitted at a UKC event.
- 8. UKC events are family-friendly events; poor sportsmanship and foul language will not be tolerated.

    - (j) Best in Show

For the purpose of this award, competition through Best of Breed is defined as defeating another dog of the same breed. If there is no competition of the same breed, a Best of Breed winner who defeats another dog of a different breed by placing in the Group, by winning Best or Reserve Best in Multi-breed Show, or by winning Best or Reserve Best in Show shall be considered to have a win with competition.
