

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers and agents please note that the full name and address of all owners must be completed. Incomplete entries will be returned. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
2. Receipts and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after closing.
3. Telephone and telegraph entries are prohibited and will not be accepted, except in the case of a postal strike.
4. The Show Superintendent shall be in full charge of the show.
5. Entry of a dog cannot be canceled after entries have closed.
6. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick or excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or because he is entered incorrectly.
7. The Fort Garry Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
8. If because of riot, civil disturbance or any acts beyond the control of the Portage Kennel Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.
9. All dogs must be kept under control at all times. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to clean up after their dog in all arena areas outside. An exercise area will be provided for dogs and it is expected that this area will be used.
10. Dogs should be in the show building one hour prior to judging of their breed. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when it is required for judging. Handlers are requested to report any absentees and have assistants at ringside if they are engaged elsewhere. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.
11. The building will be open from approximately 3 -10:30 pm the evening prior to the first show. It will open at 7:00 am and close at 10:30 pm day of the show. Exhibitors leaving dogs in the building do so at their own risk.

Conformation Classifications

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **6 months of age and under 9 months of age** on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show

12 TO 18 MONTHS: Shall be for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (**Champions of any country excluded**)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/coowner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog, which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status.

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition.

VETERAN CLASS: - Dogs must be 7 years and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed/neutered. Awards are: Best Male Veteran; Best Female Veteran; Best Veteran in Breed; Best Veteran in Group; Best Veteran in Show.

BABY PUPPY CLASS: - Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The Awards are: Best Baby Male Puppy; Best Baby Female Puppy; Best Baby Puppy in Breed; Best Baby Puppy in Group; Best Baby Puppy in Show.

ALTERED CLASS - These classes shall be for any spayed or neutered dogs over six (6) months of age. (divided by sex) Winners Altered Male & Winners Altered Female compete for Best Altered in Breed

Rally Obedience Classifications

NOTE: The Dimensions of the Rally Ring will be 40 x 54 feet.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" AT SAME TRIAL.

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH ADVANCED "A" & ADVANCED "B" AT SAME TRIAL

For complete rule including description of exercises, please refer to CKC Rally Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations

RALLY NOVICE A: Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY NOVICE B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE: Is an elective Class.

RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY ADVANCED B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Obedience title other than PCD. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC CDX shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

RALLY MASTER: This class will be for dogs that have earned the RE title. A dog completing the RM title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

Obedience Classifications

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & "B" AT SAME TRIAL

For complete rule including description of exercises, please refer to CKC Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations

PRE-NOVICE – This class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class, but must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of CD may enter the Pre-Novice . The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" . **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "CDX" title shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE "B" CLASS**

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class, an additional handler is required for group exercise.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has earned the title CD or any higher obedience title. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. Exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open Class. This class shall be for any dog of any recognized breed or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a CD or higher title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

OPEN CLASSES There are four (4) Open classes: The Open HA and Open HB classes, which include the Out of Sight Group Stay Exercises and the Open 18A and Open 18B classes, which include the Change of Positions and Group Sit - Walk Around exercises.

OPEN "HA" & "18A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX". **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title. CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN "HB" & "18B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in Canada, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. Dogs that have earned the title CDX or higher obedience titles may enter either of the Open b classes. A dog may also be entered in the Utility class in the same trial. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS 'A' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS 'B' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside approx. 30 minutes prior to the start of the class.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1—A dog awarded Winners at a Championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with the number of Championship points (ranging from 0—5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded winners shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2—The schedule to be employed in the determination of the numbers of points to be allocated to a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **not** be included in the calculation for Championship points. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also places in the Group as listed below:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **NO CASE** may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must (a) earn at least ten (10) points under 3 different judges, (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number, and © have earned at least one 2-point in either at the breed or the group level (15.1.13)

BEST PUPPY IN BREED Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award of Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed is NOT required to compete for Best Puppy in Group.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A DOG WHICH IS INDIVIDUALLY REGISTERED IN THE RECORDS OF THE Canadian Kennel Club or has an ERN Number at the time of closing of the entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show rules, after the closing date and time of entries for a show, but whose Championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing that the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to breed judging** by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994; If your dog has the required number of Ch. Points and you do not have your registration number **before** entries close, and you receive your registration before the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the show secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a listed dog. Listing fees, however, **will not be refunded.**

AN ERROR IN AN AGE SPECIFIC CLASS, DATE OF BIRTH, OR SEX, MAY BE AMENDED ON THE ENTRY FORM UP TO ONE HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW.
