EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. TRACKING FEE – Non CKC Member Canadian Resident

Effective January 1, 2011 the CKC will be instituting a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. In order to protect any points and awards earned at any CKC event, a resident non-member can choose to become a CKC member or pay the tracking fee of \$55 for each dog. Failure to comply with 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members resident in Canada and does not apply to U.S. exhibitors nor to CKC members or dogs coowned with a CKC member.

INDIGNITIES

20.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this has occurred.

A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please not the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and fax entries cannot be accepted.
- The club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the shows & trials, which will be governed by
CKC RULES.
- The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show grounds.
- The Precincts of these trials will be the entire Training Hall building and grounds on which the Hall is located, including parking lots and front yard.
- The owner of dogs entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping the grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the ring.
- Dogs must be exercised in DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, not in the ring areas.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund entry will be made.
- IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE when necessary. There will be no paging of individual dogs.
- Dogs must be on leashes at all times on the show grounds or in the show building with the exception of the Obedience rings.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their children while at the show and will be held accountable for any damages caused by children playing unattended
- The entire show site is designated as NO SMOKING.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. If bitches come into season after the closing date, a veterinarian's certificate, stating that the bitch was in season within the ten-day period before the trial must be in the Trial Secretary's hands before the start of that day's trial, in order to obtain a refund of entry fees.
- Limited Entry – obedience Entries are limited to 180 minutes of judging, based on 8 Novice entries per hour, 7 Open entries per hour and 6 Utility entries per hour. When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries may be assigned a position (by class) on the reserve list. The person making the entry shall be notified of their position on the list. In the event that the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after the closing date, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. Entry fees will be refunded within 10 days following the trial for those on the reserve list who did not participate in the trial.
- Moving up: As per 6.9.1, a dog may be moved to the next level of competition providing the transfer is submitted to the Trial Secretary on the appropriate form at least 15 minutes prior to the start of the class, schedule permitting. Please note, that in order to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a PEN, an ERN, or a Miscellaneous Class Certification.
- All entries must be typed or distinctly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms. The OVGR does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or for errors due to illegibility of information on an entry submitted by the owner or agent, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to enter or compete. **Entries must be signed by the owner or agent or the entry will be rejected.**

COVID 19 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- **The OVGRC Trials will be held in the Ottawa Public Health Unit and we will be required to follow any additional restrictions enacted by that Health unit in addition to those required by the Province of Ontario.**
- **Guidelines and restrictions around COVID-19 are prone to changing frequently and rapidly. It is your responsibility to be aware of the current guidelines and restrictions and to follow them at all times. If you have questions please ask any Trial official.**
- **The safety measures below are subject to change based on information received from or decisions made by federal, provincial and local governments and health units.**
- **You must not attend if you have any symptoms of COVID-19, are supposed to be self-isolating/quarantining, have been out of the country in the past 14 days or have come into contact with someone that tested positive for COVID-19 or was symptomatic for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.**
- **Full Vaccination is required to enter the trial precincts “The Training Hall” Please be prepared with a copy of your vaccination certificate. If the app is available we will be utilizing it. You will be given a wristband to wear once proof of vaccination has been provided.**
- **Wearing of masks by competitors in the ring will be at the discretion of the judge. Masks must be worn outside the ring.**
- **There will be no food or beverages available on site.**
- **There will be no spectating.**
- **There will be no move ups or day of entries.**
- **You must maintain 6 feet of distance from people not in your household at all times unless it is unavoidable for a brief moment.**
- **There will be hand sanitizer available.**

THE SUSAN ROBERTS MEMORIAL TROPHY

The Susan Roberts Memorial Trophy (SRMT) has been established to recognize the combined field and obedience achievements by a Golden Retriever and their owner/handlers. The annual award will be given to the top performing Golden with a CKC field title at the fall Ottawa Valley Golden Retriever Club (OVGRC) Obedience Trials.

The trophy is named in honour of Susan Roberts (1954-2020). For more than 30 years, Susan was active as a competitor, breeder, and club supporter. Her passion for the breed and drive for excellence was evident in her achievements. Her greatest success was with her boy Baron (**Can CH NMH2 GMH GMOTCH Sterre Texas Tycoon at Lynwood Am MH CCA Can WCX *** VCX**), accomplishing what few have, earning the National Master Hunter title two times, Grand Master Hunter title, the Grand Master Obedience Trial Championship and Versatility Excellent title.

Above all, Susan loved to learn new things and share her knowledge and passion for the breed. She was mentor to many in the Ottawa area and has helped grow a new generation of obedience and field competitors.

Susan was a long-time supporter of the Ottawa Valley Golden Retriever Club and served as board member and president – and so it is fitting to award the trophy at an OVGRC event.

Criteria for Eligibility:

Any Golden Retriever/Handler team with a CKC field title (i.e. a title from a working certificate series, or a hunt test or field trial series) entered in any official class in the OVGRC Obedience Trials on October 31, 2021 (subject to changes and approval by the CKC). To be considered handlers must, In addition to the official entry submitted as specified in this premium, send a copy of their most advanced field titles to:

Criteria for Winning:

The SRMT will be awarded to the Golden Retriever/Handler team achieving the highest score in any official class during the OVGRC trial weekend. In the event of a tie, the trophy will go to the team with the most advanced field title. The trophy will be presented at the conclusion of the Trials in accordance with Covid-19 protocols.
