

## RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1-HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY IS MADE
6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

**ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES**

### CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

<b>DOGS COMPETING*</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3 to 5</b>	<b>6 to 9</b>	<b>10 to 12</b>	<b>13 or more</b>
<b>POINTS AWARDED</b>	<b>0</b>	<b>1</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>4</b>	<b>5</b>

\*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

## **DOG SHOW CLASS INFORMATION**

**BABY PUPPY CLASS:** A Baby Puppy class is also offered for dogs 3 to 6 months of age . Entrants of this class do not compete for Championship points or for other awards.

A **Baby Puppy** class is divided by sex. Each sex will compete prior to the regular class (eg. Baby Puppy Male, then Junior Puppy Male,) The winner of each sex will compete for Best Baby Puppy in Breed between Best Veteran and Best of Breed.

The winner of BBP In Breed will receive a flat ribbon, then go on to compete for **BBP In Specialty** prior to **the judging of the Group (BB winners). The winner of BBP In Specialty** will receive a rosette and a prize. Flat ribbons will be awarded to second to fourth placement wins.

**JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of this Specialty

**SENIOR PUPPY CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

**12 to 18 Months Class** – This class shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

**CANADIAN BRED CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS** - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

**OPEN CLASS** - This class shall be for all dogs

**VETERANS CLASS** – Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes DO NOT compete for Championship points but go directly on to the Best of Breed competition. **NOTE: SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS**

**SPECIALS ONLY CLASS** - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. **Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FIRST SHOW. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded**

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades

### **JUNIOR HANDLING - JUDGE-----Ms Jill Scholl**

The Terrier need not be owned by the junior but it must be entered in the Specialty. Registration will be at the BCATC table with the Judging Schedule indicating times.

CLASSES: All offered. Fee \$2.

Prizes: Rosettes and Prizes will be awarded for Best Overall and First in each class, with flat ribbons offered for all remaining placements including PeeWees.

### **BRED BY EXHIBITOR - COMPETITION**

To showcase the breeder/exhibitor, the BC All Terrier Club is offering a **BRED BY EXHIBITOR Competition**, as an unofficial class. The dog **MUST** also be entered in a **REGULAR** class , but the handler must be the Breeder in only the unofficial Bred By Exhibitor class.

PLEASE check the appropriate box on the entry Form, with an additional \$10. fee.

After Best In Specialty -- all dogs entered in the **Bred by Exhibitor competition** will compete

(unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best Of Breed level, by another breeder-handled dog that is entered in this competition.) The winner of **Best Bred By Exhibitor In Breed** may compete in the **Best Bred By Exhibitor Group** (unless the dog was already defeated, at the Best in Group level, by another breeder-handled dog that is entered in this competition.)

The winners at the breed level will receive flat ribbons.

The group winner of the Bred By Exhibitor (unofficial class) will receive a Rosette and a suitable prize.
