IMPORTANT NOTE FOR EXHIBITORS / PATRONS

- 1. Entry Limit 90 Runs (includes Instinct Testing, Novice, Open, Excellent & Master Runs Maximum 20 Instinct Tests).
- 2. One dog per handler per class.
- 3. The MG7 Club respectfully asks that no posting of testing be placed on social media until end of trial.
- 4. The only dog permitted in trial area is dog being tested; no dogs allowed with spectators.
- 5. No Prong Collars.
- 6. All dogs must be under control on a leash except during the
- 7. No exhibitors under 10 years of age.

To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Trial Secretary after the closing time and date.

All entry fees must be in the hands of our Trial Secretary prior to closing date.

Personal cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to the **Maritime Group 7 Club**.

No post-dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques and declined credit cards will be subject to a charge of \$40.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trial.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Scent Detection Trials effective January 1, 2024 is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via Dogshow.ca. No other entry service is authorized to accept entries for these events. The MG7 Club does not accept credit cards for payment.











A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Eligibility to Compete – If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under those rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay a fee (\$11.50) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

CLASSES OFFERED

Instinct

Novice Container, Interior, Exterior Open Container, Interior, Exterior Excellent Container, Interior, Exterior Master Container, Interior, Exterior

ROSETTES

A Rosette will be awarded for each qualifying score per component at all levels.

Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive ribbons.

An MG7 New Title Rosette will be awarded to all dogs earning a Novice, Open, Excellent or Master Title, as well as to any dog earning a Container, Interior or Exterior Title.

A Special Rosette will be awarded to any dog earning a CKC Scent Detection Championship and a Scent Detection Grand Master Title (based on the requirements in the note adjacent to this paragraph).

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the event which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Judging schedules and Armband Nos. will be sent as soon as possible after the Closing Date.
- 3. The MG7 Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- 4. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 5. All exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs and/or dogs they are handling.
- 6. Precinct includes the entire property.
- 7. A judge officiating at a trial shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trials and it is the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- 8. No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour their entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)
- 9. **Bitches in season** are eligible to compete in this trial but must run at the end of each class and wear clean, properly fitted panties. Please read the rules in the new Scent Detection Rulebook under Section 6.5.2. When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the owner of the dog must inform the host club. If bitches in season are permitted to compete by the host club, the bitch in season will be moved to the end of all run orders for any class they are entered in.
- 10. There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

Scent Detection Grand Master - A dog must have already obtained a CKC Scent Detection Master Title (SDM) to be eligible for this title. A dog must obtain five (5) additional qualifying scores in the Master Class in each of the three Master components of Containers, Interior, and Exterior to obtain the SDGM title. Qualifying scores do not have to be earned at the same trial. SDGM will be a suffix title.
