To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN to you. The cost is \$64.07. Dog may initially be entered as listed but the ERN must be applied for within 30 days of winning CKC points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. Canadian Bred: for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded.

Bred by Exhibitor: for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Open: for all dogs.

Specials Only: dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and have attained championship status may be entered in the 'Specials Only' class. Exhibition Only: for all dogs over 6 mths of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (non-competitive class).

OBEDIENCE

Pre-Novice: for any pure bred dog that has not earned the title PCD (Pre Companion Dog) title in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A dog may be entered in this class that has not earned the title of CD in Canada or US.

Novice A: for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for this class.

Novice B: for any purebred dog that has not won the title of CD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class.

Novice C: for any purebred dog that has gained a CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced title and exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice classes. Scores earned in Novice C are not eligible for High in Trial. This is an elective class and offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience. Dogs may be entered in Novice C class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial classes.

Novice Intermediate: For any dog which has earned the title of CD, CDX, UD or any Obedience Trial Championship.

Open A: for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Open B: for any purebred dog that has won the title of CD, CDX or UD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class. A dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial. A dog eligible for UD is also eligible for entry in this class at the same trial.

Utility A: for any purebred dog that has won the title of CDX in CANADA. Handlers may enter more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'group examination' exercise.

Utility B: for any purebred dog and handler where the dog has achieved a CDEX and a UD title and for dogs and handlers where the handler has put a MOTCH title on any dog.

Versatility: for any purebred dog that has attained the title of CDX and at least 1 qualifying score towards the Utility title, prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The exercises to be performed by each dog will be determined by the handler's drawing 1 of a set of 4 cards listing a combination of 6 exercises after the handler has entered the ring. Dogs entered in the Versatility class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Veterans: for any dog that has earned the title of CD or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Classes. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Brace: Open to any 2 dogs that have earned a CD or higher (not necessarily of the same breed or owner). Owner or any other person may handle the Brace, however the same handler must handle each brace in all 6 exercises (unless he has more than one Brace entered). This class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class. The 2 dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on the performance of the two dogs as though they were one.

Team: Open to any 4 dogs that have earned the title of CD or higher (not necessarily of the same breed or owner). 5 dogs may be entered, one an alternate. However, the same 4 dogs must compete in all exercises. The exercises will be performed simultaneously and judged as specified for the Novice Class with the exception of the Figure 8 and the Drop on Recall (see rule book). Judgment will be based on the performance of the dogs and handlers, plus team precision and coordination.

RALLY

Rally Novice A: Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

Rally Novice B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. No dog may be entered in Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Intermediate: This class shall be for dogs that have earned the Rally Novice (RN) title. A dog competing in Rally Intermediate or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely.

Rally Advanced A: For dogs that have won the Rally Novice title but have not won the Rally Advanced title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

Rally Advanced B: for dogs that have won the Rally Novice title. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

Rally Excellent A: for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced title but have not won the Rally Excellent title or any CKC Novice Obedience title.

Rally Excellent B: for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced title. No dog may be entered in the Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B class at the same show.

Brace: Rally Brace requirements shall be the same as those listed above for obedience Brace, except that they are open to any 2 dogs that have earned a title of RN or higher.

Team: Eligibility for Rally Team shall be the same as that listed above for the Obedience Team except that the class is open to any 4 dogs that have earned a title of RN or higher.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trials) is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
2. "A judge officiating at a dog show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
3. "The participation in any manner or in any capacity at a competitive event held under these Rules shall be considered a privilege accorded to any person by the CKC and such privilege may be extended and withdrawn by the Discipline Committee". "Any person availing himself of the privilege of participating in any manner, shape or form and in any capacity, including that of a spectator at a competitive event held under these rules shall, by such participation, be deemed to have agreed to the authority of the CKC and its Board of Directors."
