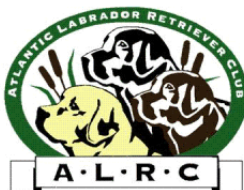

Faxed entries will be accepted with VISA or Mastercard payment. There will be a 10% charge levied per transaction (not per dog). You may also submit Entries through The Entry Line (see ad page 3) they accept ALL credit cards.

All entries are to be sent to the Show Sec't and must be received on or before the closing date & time.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the errors were made. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules. NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of **\$25.00**. N.S.F. cheques are considered **Non-Payment of entry fees** and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please not that the **full name and address of owners MUST be filled in** and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2 Dog Show Rules)

Regular Conformation Classes

- Junior Puppy A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
- Senior Puppy A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.
- 12-18 Months A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.
- Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada.
- Bred by Exhibitor A dog owned and handled by the breeder.
- Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older
- Altered Class For dogs that have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure
- Veterans Class A dog 7 years of age or older on the day of the event
- Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions.
- Exhibition Only Dogs 6 months of age and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of Age and under 6 months on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the Regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 Puppies

NOTE BABY PUPPY CLASS 3-6 months of age (if this Puppy does not yet have a CKC Registration Number the \$9.65 Listing Fee is waived.)

Non Regular Conformation Classes

- Stud Dog & Get Stud Dog and 2 of his Get (owners need not be identical). Stud must be Entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. Get must be Entered in a Regular Class
- Brood Bitch & Progeny Brood Bitch and 2 Progeny (owners need not be identical). Bitch must be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular Class
- Gun Dog shall be for any dog that has earned at title at WC or Hunt Test or a placement at a field Trial.
- Brace Class A "Brace Class" shall be judged as a "similar" pair ~ size, gait and stride. The term "identical" has been replaced by "similar" due to removal of the "same colour", requirement

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Champion & Championship Points ~ Chapter 1 Section 1 ~ A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B (Pre Novice, Novice C & Novice Intermediate) SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED ~ State Jump Height

Unofficial Obedience Classes

- Brace Open to 2 dogs (either sex) that have attained not less than a CD title in Canada.
- Team Open to 4 dogs (either sex) that have attained not less than a CD title in Canada
- Veteran Open to dogs that are a minimum of 7 years old on the day of the trial and that have earned an obedience title

**Exhibitors entering both obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms
"EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THAT THEY ARE ENTERED IN
THE CORRECT CLASSES. PLEASE REFER TO THE CKC RULE BOOKS"**

**NOTE: Bitches coming into season MAY NOT compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees
will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian's Certificate PRIOR to the
commencement of the Trial.**

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering
CKC events will require and Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the
following:

1. send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current
ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for
an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently
required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the
ERN to be sent to you
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard
number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a
CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days
will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

Puppy and/or Veteran Sweepstakes

Entry Fee \$15.00

Puppy Sweeps These sweepstakes are first divided by sex and the sexes are divided into 3
classes as follows: 6-9 Months ~ no younger than six months and no older than 9
months on the day of the sweepstake ~ 9-12 months ~ no younger than 9 months
and no older than 12 months on the day of the sweepstake and the third
class 12-18 months ~ no younger than 12 months and no older than 18 months
on the day of the sweepstake

Veteran Sweeps The Veteran Sweeps are first divided by sex and the sexes are divided into 3
Classes as follows; 7-9 years~ no younger than 7 years and no older than 9 years
on the day of the sweepstake; 9-11 years ~ no younger than 9 years and no older
than 11 years on the day of the event; and 11 years and older ~ dog must be no
younger than 11 years on the day of the event.

Division of Sweepstake Prizes (both Puppy and Veteran)

15% of the total entry will be awarded to Best In Sweepstakes

10% of the total entry will be awarded to best of Opposite Sex In Sweepstakes

25% of the total entry will be retained for Administrative purposes

The remaining 50% of the total entry will be dispersed as follows:

Classes with 4 or more entries ~ 1st Place 40%; 2nd Place 30%; 3rd Place 20%; 4th Place 10%

Classes with 3 entries ~ 1st Place 50%; 2nd Place 30%; 3rd Place 20%

Classes with 2 entries ~ 1st Place 60%; 2nd Place 40%

Classes with 1 entry ~ 1st Place 100%

PARADE OF VETERANS & PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS

Entry Fee \$15.00

Parade of Veterans is open to any Labrador Retriever 7 years or older on the day of the event. Parade
of Title Holders open to any Labrador holding any CKC recognized title. If you are entering either of
these Parades we would appreciate it if you would also write a short biography of your dog and his/her
accomplishments. Thank You.

"REFUND INFORMATION ~ COMMUNICABLE DISEASES"

Entry Fees will be refunded for dogs/bitches that are posing a threat of a COMMUNICABLE
DISEASE on the day of the Specialty. To obtain the refund a letter from a practicing Veterinarian
MUST be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of the show/trial.

PRIZES

An appropriate prize and rosette will be awarded for each of the following:
Best of Breed, Best of Opposite, Best of Winners, Winners Dog,
Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Puppy
Best Stud Dog, Best Brood Bitch, Best Brace, Best Gun Dog,
Altered Male, Altered Female, Best Altered. As well, 1st place in each Class
as follows: Canadian Bred Male & Canadian Bred Female, Bred By Exhibitor
Male, Bred By Exhibitor Female, Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch
Rosettes will be given for 2nd to 4th in each class.
Rosettes will be given for up to Four Awards of Merit
to be chosen at Breed Level.

An appropriate prize and rosette will be awarded for each of the following:

High in Trial High Novice A High Novice B High Open A
High Open B High Utility A High Utility B High Scoring Brace
High Scoring Team
High Scoring Lab in Trial
High Scoring Veteran

Rally Obedience – High qualifying Score in each class
Flat Ribbons will be given to all Qualifying dogs in both Obedience & Rally
Rosettes will be given for 2nd to 4th in each class.

All awards are limited to dogs earning Qualifying Scores only.

RULES & RULE BOOKS

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC Rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

A copy of the Rules pertaining Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club 1-416-675-5511. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules pertaining to these events.

GENERAL INFORMATON

1. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
2. The Coliseum Building will be open between 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.on Thur 02 May 2013 for Exhibitor set-up. The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. daily
3. To comply with **CITY OF MONCTON** regulations **NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.**
4. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
5. All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs or dogs they are handling. Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground. PLEASE FOLLOW THIS RULE SO THAT OUR ARENA AND MOTEL PRIVILEGES ARE NOT REVOKED.
6. The Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The Moncton Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left in the building or on site overnight.
