EMAIL ENTRIES WITH E-TRANSFER OR PAYPAL PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED AS FOLLOWS:

- Entries must be submitted on official ASCA entry forms
- Forms must be filled in completely and signed. Please type (preferred) or write legibly
- Email completed forms to coasc@bell.net
- Payments must be made via PayPal using Friends and Family or they will be rejected
- For payments to be accepted, please include your name and the events you are submitting payment for. Payments without proper identification will not be accepted.

The club does not run a tab, all entries submitted without payment will be considered null and void.

Exhibitors, through submission of their entry/entries, acknowledge they are knowledgeable of ASCA Rules and Regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Exhibitors will be competing for ASCA titles. All dogs must show in the class appropriate to any previous ASCA titles earned. Exhibitors who have NEVER earned an ASCA Obedience or Rally title must enter at the Novice level.

No entry shall be accepted for a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA® Conformation or Rally program, a dog or handler disqualified from any ASCA® program, or a person not in good standing with ASCA®.

Entry fees will **not** be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the show committee, ASCA®, the show veterinarian or the judge.

Anyone having any dogs with or exposed to any communicable diseases within 30 days of these shows is NOT allowed to attend per ASCA® Rules.

INTACT & ALTERED CONFORMATION INFORMATION

Judging order for conformation: Juniors; Non-Regular; Altered; Intact

Regular Conformation Classes:

All Regular Classes, Intact & Altered, divided by sex: 6-9 months; 9-12 months; 12-15 months; 15-18 months Novice; Canadian Bred; Bred By Exhibitor

Open Blue Merle; Open Red Merle; Open Black; Open Red

Winners; Best of Breed

Class winners to compete for Winners Dog / Winners Bitch.

Winners Dog & Winners Bitch will compete with Specials for BOB, BOS, and BOW.

Non-Regular Conformation Classes:

2-4 month puppy; 4-6 month puppy, divided by sex. Class winners to compete for BOB Puppy & BOS Puppy. Veterans 7-9 years & 10 years and over, divided by sex.

Class winners to compete for BOB Veteran & BOS Veteran.

Regular Junior Handling Classes:

Novice Junior 8-12 years; Novice Senior 13-17 years; Open Junior 8-12 years; Open Senior 13-17 years. Class winners to compete for Best Jr. Handler and Reserve Jr. Handler.

Non-Regular Junior Handling Classes:

Pee Wee 3-5 years; Sub Junior 6-7 years.

Attention All Regular Intact and Altered Class Entries:

ALL dogs in Regular Conformation Classes must be at least 6 months of age or older on the day of the show and must be ASCA® registered. You must show proof of your dog's ASCA® Registration if requested.

RALLY TRIAL INFORMATION

Rally Trials # 1, 2 and 3 are limited to 40 entries; Trial # 4 is limited to 20 entries.

ALL Rally trials will run in the following order: Masters B, A & C; Excellent B, A & C; Advanced B, A & C; Novice B, A & C.

Masters & Excellent will run in jump height order.

Junior Rally exhibitors be sure to NOTE "Junior" on your entry form!

ALL ASCA® RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED. Per ASCA Rules NO Bitches In Season are allowed to run.

Rally Class entry is open to all Australian Shepherds that have a permanent individual registration or LEP Number and are over 6 months of age, or any dog over 6 months of age that has a tracking number issued by ASCA or a tracking number application completed and fees paid:

Rally Refunds: Withdrawal for any reason before entries close will be eligible for a full refund. Withdrawal after entries close because of sickness or a dog coming in season are eligible for a full refund. Withdrawals on the day of the show are not eligible for a refund. Entries refused because the trial is full are eligible for a full refund.

Rosettes for WD/WB; RWD/RWB; BOB/BOS/BOW; Best Veteran, Best Opposite Sex Veteran
Rosettes for BJH/RJH and BOBP/BOSP

RALLY AWARDS:

1st through 4th place - Flat ribbons for all classes , Qualifying, X Leg Flat ribbons Rosettes for HC, & HIT & HIT JR

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Rings will be **outdoors on grass**.

Grounds will be open at 8am both days and closed at 8pm Friday & Saturday and 6pm Sunday. Grounds are open Friday July 19 at 2:00 pm for set-up. Please observe parking and set-up instructions at the facility.

All **grooming** will be outdoors with **no electricity on site**. No chalking is allowed. Generators are allowed 100 feet away from rings and pavilion. No dogs may be left on grounds overnight.

NO FOOD, BAIT, CRATING or SEATING allowed within 10 feet of the rings.

Pavilion is for club and ring entrance use only, no set-up allowed under the pavilion. All pop-ups must be secured with spikes and, if left overnight, lowered to the ground.

Please respect and abide by all local laws.

Please dispose of all your garbage in the designated containers. Porta-potties on site.

There will be raffles on Saturday and Sunday. Look for tickets at the registration table.

There will be no official show photographer.

No puppies under the age of 8 weeks are allowed at the show site.

There is no overnight RV or camping allowed on grounds. There are campsites nearby for rent.

Bring Your Own: pop-ups, pens, chairs, food, water, drinks. There is no potable water available on site.






From Hwy 401: (eastbound)

At Exit 232, head right on the ramp for County Rd-59 / Norwich Ave toward Delhi, Turn right onto County Rd-59 / Norwich Ave toward Delhi, Turn right onto Oxford Road 13, Turn right onto Salford Rd, then immediately turn left onto Oxford Road 13, Road name changes to West St N, Turn left onto Main St E, then immediately turn right onto West St S, Road name changes to Oxford Road 13, Road name changes to County Rd-13 / Norfolk County Road 13, Keep straight to get onto County Rd-59 / Highway 59, Turn right onto Talbot St, Road name changes to Colonel Talbot Rd, Turn left onto Norfolk County Road 23, Turn right onto 7th Concession Road Enr, Arrive at 7th Concession Road Enr, The last intersection before your destination is Graves Sideroad.
