- ◆ ONLY APPROVED CKC collars will be allowed in the precincts of the Trials.
- ◆ SHOWING correct information on the entry form is the responsibility of the entrant. The PAKOC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.
- ◆ OBEDIENCE ENTRANTS: Obedience entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors whose females are in season during the trials (and must be withdrawn) IF: a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the trial.
- ◆ THE PRECINCTS of these trials shall be the AAP building & grounds. No dog will be allowed in the building unless entered in the Trials or Exhibition Only.

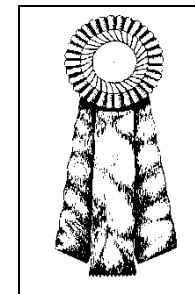
PLEASE NOTE:

- ◆ The PAKOC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, either to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- ◆ All dogs must be under complete control at all times.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Obedience Novice Class "A" and Open Class "A" shall be for purebred dogs of any breed and those breeds as designated:

- ◆ in the Miscellaneous Class if a Miscellaneous Class dog holds a CKC Miscellaneous Certification Number and
- ◆ if a Foreign Born and owned dog should have an Event Registration Number or obtain this form from the CKC within 30 days or
- ◆ if a dog has been issued a Performance Event Number and for either sex which have not earned the title of "C.D." (Companion Dog) or in the case of the Open Class - which have not earned the title of "C.D.X." (Companion Dog Excellent). One dog, only, may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor, who must handle the dog in all exercises, and every dog must be exhibited by the owner or a member of his/her immediate family. No licensed handler, trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "U.D." (Utility Dog) Title, in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled. The word "trainer" means any person who conducts or has conducted a dog Obedience training class, or who regularly assists with the training of dogs belonging to persons out-side his/her immediate family. A dog which has earned a comparable degree in any other country is not eligible for entry in this class but may be entered in the "B" class if it has not earned its "C.D." title in the Novice Class. No dog can be entered in Open "A" if it has earned its "C.D.X." or comparable degree in any country but may be entered in the Open "B" class.

NON MEMBER PARTICIPANT FEE

(April 20, 2011)

This fee applies to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

- ***A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.***
- ***The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.***
- ***In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.***
