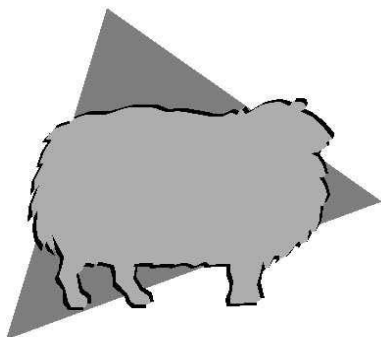

No post-dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trials.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.

PLEASE USE SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR OBEDIENCE AND RALLY OBEDIENCE

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Obedience & Rally Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

The precincts of the trials shall be the building and its entrances.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS:

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs who are owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. NON-PUREBRED DOGS IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS

Non-purebred dogs will be accepted in both Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials. If entering your non-purebred dog in either of these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number. Please check the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.34 (found online at the CKC website) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN.

A plaque will be awarded for the highest obedience score (from a regular class) earned by a *Change of Pace* student in each Obedience Trial.

A prize will be offered to each *Change of Pace* student earning a Rally Title at this event.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Trial Supt. will be in full charge of trials which will be governed by CKC rules.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for cleanup on the trial grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- The MG7 Club and Ace It Canine Academy will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A judge officiating at a trial shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial and it is the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The MG7 Club and the Trials Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the MG7 Club and its Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or close the trials, no refund of entries will be made.
- All rules and regulations as outlined in the Maritime Group 7 Club Premium List apply to this event.
- Rally Ring Size will be 40' x 60'.
