ENTRIES CLOSE JULY 22, 2023 AT 9:00 AM. Entries received after this date may be rejected. Entries may not be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date. Cancellations prior to the closing are to be made to the Trial Secretary.

NRCC Fee: Effective 2018, the NRCC is taking a proactive role to ensure future funding for National events. The NRCC is asking member clubs to collect \$5.00 per dog competing in each All Age Stake held. Fees collected will be submitted to the NRCC Treasurer. At the end of the trial season, 100% of the funds collected will be distributed retroactively to the Host Club(s) for that year. **Please Note: The \$5.00 fee is included in your entry fee of \$85.00.**

ENTRIES:

DRAW:

- The draw will be held on July 22, 2023, 6:00 pm at 83 Gilbert Road, French River, ON.
- The draw will be held in accordance with <u>CKC Field Trial Rulebook</u>, per Section 6.6, p.17-19.
- Cancellations prior to the draw are to be made to the Field Trial Secretary by phone at 705-626-8866 or by email to <u>nickelbeltretrieverclub@gmail.com</u>. For refunds after the draw, please refer to p.16, Section 6.3 of the Rulebook.

HEADQUARTERS:

- Headquarters will be at the Noelville Rod and Gun Club - 5438 HWY 64, Noëlville, ON.

STANDING RULES:

- Dead ducks will be used in all stakes.
- The judges will impose a system of rotation which will be used in all the All-Age stakes.
- Starting numbers will be the two digits including digits to the right of the decimal on the prior Tuesday's (July 25) TSX closing.
- Judges shall have the power to disqualify any dog which does not appear within 15 minutes of the time designated for its turn to be tested.
- Dogs are required to run in order of the draw (males and females alike) unless excused by the marshal or member of the Field Trial Committee for that stake.
- Females in season may not compete. Refund of entry fee is subject to veterinary certificate or is at the discretion of the Field Trial Secretary and/or Chair.
- CKC rules prohibit training on the grounds designated for the holding of a licensed trial.
- CKC Licensed Trial rosettes will be awarded to all dogs placing in each stake.
- CKC Retriever Field Trial Rules and Regulations Chapter 21, Sect 21.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- Private property is used for the trial, and permission was obtained for Club use on this weekend only.
- Stakes will be signed from headquarters.

TAILGATE:

- A tailgate will be held at Headquarters on Saturday evening at a cost of \$10/person. For planning purposes, if possible, please let Dave or Stefanie Gemmell know by July 22 if you will be attending the tailgate.
