

Simcoe Performance Dogs Oct 17th 2022 Outdoor Agility Trial Judging Schedule

We will be using RING ONE for these trials. Ring one is on the east side of the Red Barn. Bathroom building is open; please enter through French doors on that building.

You will get course maps at the registration table where you will be checking in and selecting your volunteering positions. Course maps for novice will be given out AFTER the novice warm up run. Barb, our volunteer coordinator will be there to assist you. Your entry was dependant on your volunteering for at least 2 positions during the trial, without you we would be unable to run the trial.

Please note we will not have a leash runner. Please either put your leash in your pocket or bring a second leash and hang it on the fence at finish area. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash (this is a CKC regulation).

There can not be food or toys (non squeaky toys are allowed in FFO runs) within 10 ft of the ring (this is a CKC regulation).

Thank you for supporting our trial. If you have not already done so, please review your entry for classes and jump heights and notify the trial secretary at dlmagility@gmail.com as soon as possible of any concerns. The Red Barn property will be opened at 8:30 am. Judge briefing and walk through will be 9:30 a.m. sharp.

PARKING: Competitors may park along the laneway if they have quiet dogs. We ask that those with barking dogs please park in our main parking lot. Please park your car under the trees to allow 2 cars in each spot so more cars will be able to get in the shade.

Those of you that will be parking in the main parking lot please park by the trees (your dogs will be closer to the shade in the afternoon.

Please note day of trial entries will not be accepted at this trial.

In 2010 the Board of Directors of the CKC passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting, the Tracking fee motion was deleted and replaced with the following motion. Non-Member Participation Fee a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. This fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either, to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member Participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non- CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Cost is \$63.90 + HST.

The CKC has also asked clubs to remind competitors of the following;

HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);

3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Garbage policy at the Red Barn "IF YOU BRING IT PLEASE TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU" There will be a garbage can for the dog poop outside the door but that is all that can be put into it. Thank you so much for your cooperation.
