Entry Fees (Canadian Funds or U.S. Funds)

As of July 1, 2014, mixed-breed and unrecognized-breed dogs (purebred from CKC recognized registries) will be able to compete in CKC Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials alongside purebred dogs and receive the same titles.

Obstacles: Agility obstacles meet the requirements of the CKC Agility Rules, January 2014.

Note: A-Frame, Dogwalk, Teeter and Table have rubber surfaces and the tire is a breakaway self healing type.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Course Familiarization: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class.

Warm-up a jump will be provided in proximity to the ring area.

Exhibitor Information: Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations Effective Jan. 20014, a copy of which may be obtained by calling the Central Order Desk of CKC at 1800 250 8040.

Check-in will start at 12 noon on Friday with first dog on the line at 1 pm and check in will start at 7:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday, with the first dog on the line at 7:45 a.m.

Equipment familiarizations: There will be supervised contact equipment familiarization for **Novice Dogs** only *each day* before the Novice Std class begins.

Food: is available on the show grounds.

Order of Classes

Awards and Prizes: (for qualifying scores, only)

Ribbons: Rosettes will be offered for all first places in each jump height in each class and flat ribbons will be awarded for 2nd, 3rd and 4th places as well as for all qualifying scores.

Rosettes will also be offered for any new title earned at this trial.

Precincts of the trial: All grounds within 30' of the ring area or the fenced area of the grounds, whichever is less, shall be considered the trial grounds.

Move-up option: Dogs may be moved up to the next class between days i.e., from Saturday to Sunday, by filling in the required move-up form and dogs may move from Excellent to Master Excellent between trials, however, no other move-ups will be permitted between trials on the same day.

The BMDCC (Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Canada) and the BMDCO (Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Ontario) are offering one prize to each Bernese Mountain Dog that qualifies in Agility on the day of their Specialty (Saturday for the BMDCC and Sunday for the BMDCO).

Height Divisions

Handlers are responsible for entering the correct height division. The judge may request any dog be measured. Selected Class dogs will jump one height lower than the equivalent regular class height shown in the table below and dogs who measure 10" or below will jump 4" in the Selected Class. Veteran dogs may jump one or two heights lower. The following jump height divisions shall be used in all regular classes:

8 inches for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

Levels and Divisions Offered

Novice is for dogs that have or have not acquired the Agility Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate.

Intermediate is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.

Excellent is for dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Master Excellent is for dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent, the Agility Master Excellent, Agility Excellent Jumper or Agility Master Excellent Jumper titles.

Regular: Any dog may enter the regular class (as long as it has not competed in the Selected or Veteran class)

Selected: An Owner may enter a dog in the Selected class at any time and if the dog has earned legs in the Regular class will carry these legs into the Selected class. Once a dog has been entered in the Selected class it may no longer be entered in the Regular class. Dogs entered in the Selected Class run the same course as dogs in Regular but jump one height lower and receive 10% more time (20% more time in Steeplechase)

Veterans A dog 7 years or older may be entered in the Veterans class. The dog will retain its titles and qualifying score previously earned but may not revert back to the Regular or Selected Classes once it has run in the Veterans class. Dogs entered in the Veterans Class run the same course as Regular but jump one or two jump heights lower and receive 10% more time (20% more time in Steeplechase)

Some Changes to Note for CKC Agility Trials 2014

Two New Games: Points and Distance-PAD This strategic titling game involves the accumulation of points within a specified time, and incorporates a distance challenge. Titles will be earned at all levels. (for further details see Summary and Exhibitor Briefing on Belleville and District Kennel Club website <http://www.bellevilledistrictkennelclub.com/agility-trials.html>). **Steeplechase** A jumpers style titling game that involves the two most dynamic obstacles; weaves and A-Frame. Every dog runs the same course regardless of titles earned in other classes. (Summary for this game is also included on the B&DKC website)

New Class designations: The A and B classes designations have been changed. Now there is simply NOVICE for all divisions. Excellent A is now simply EXCELLENT while Excellent B is now MASTER EXCELLENT. (Intermediate did not change). Requirements for titles remained the same.

New Level designations: The owner may choose to enter the Selected Class in lieu of entering the Regular Class at any trial. The dog must be entered only in Selected Classes or in Regular Classes and may not move back and forth between the Selected Classes and the Regular Classes. **Once a dog is entered in the Selected Classes, the dog may not go back to compete in the Regular Classes. Dogs moving into the Selected class move laterally, and take any legs they have earned in the Regular classes with them.** The Selected class shall be subject to the same rules and regulations as all Regular classes except for the Standard Course Time and jump heights.

Mixed-breed and unrecognized-breed dogs (purebred from CKC recognized registries) which will be listed as "All Canadian Dogs" with Canine Companion Numbers may compete at this trial.

Obstacle Changes: Table: The dog must remain on the table for the judge's cumulative count of 5 seconds. The count is not dependent on the dog's position and begins as soon as 4 paws are on the table.

The Bar Jump may have only one bar in any level. At least one jump with only one bar is still mandatory in the Excellent Level.

Weave Poles: Novice standard courses will contain six weave poles in order to provide novice dogs with reasonable and easier transition to Intermediate courses. The weave poles will not follow a fast jumping sequence nor will they have a difficult entry. Weave poles will not be faulted at the novice level unless taken in a backward fashion (back weaving).

Tire: The height of the tire jump is 4", one jump height lower, than the jump height for other jumps, except for the 4" height.

Contact Equipment: A-Frame: The height of the 9' A-frame is set to 5 foot 6 inches for dogs who jump 24", 20" and 16" and at 5 feet for dogs who jump 12" 8" or 4" .

Dogwalk and Teeter: Contact zones are designated on the lower 42" of both ramps with a 1/4" tolerance. The contact area must offer an obvious contrast to other sections but may be divided into two colour zones, 36" and 42" to accommodate equipment being used by different organizations. Slats are optional on the dogwalk but no slats are used on the teeter.

All particulars called for on the entry form must be complete. Any telephone calls required to confirm information will be made COLLECT. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog/s regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full entry fees. The SD&G club can not accept fax or phone entries and reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules. If because of riots, civil disturbances or acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. All entry confirmation and judging schedules will be mailed or e-mailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Attention U.S. Exhibitors: We will accept U. S. cheques (checks) as noted in entry fees. Due to the constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they must be made payable in U.S. funds in amounts noted under entry fees.

Listing Fees A CKC listing fee of \$9.70 (incl.13% HST) Can. or US per dog per trial is payable with the entry fee if the entry of the dog does not include a CKC individual Registration number, PEN (Performance Event Number), ERN (Event Registration Number), or Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN).

Eligibility: To be eligible to compete in this trial, a dog must be at least 18 months of age and registered with the CKC or eligible for registration with the CKC, have a PEN, an ERN, a CKC MCN (Miscellaneous Certificate Number) or a CCN (Canine Companion Number). Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in the trial however, entry and listing fees will be returned, providing a veterinarian's certificate stating that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial is submitted to the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial.

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred". (4.1.3 t)

ACCOMMODATIONS

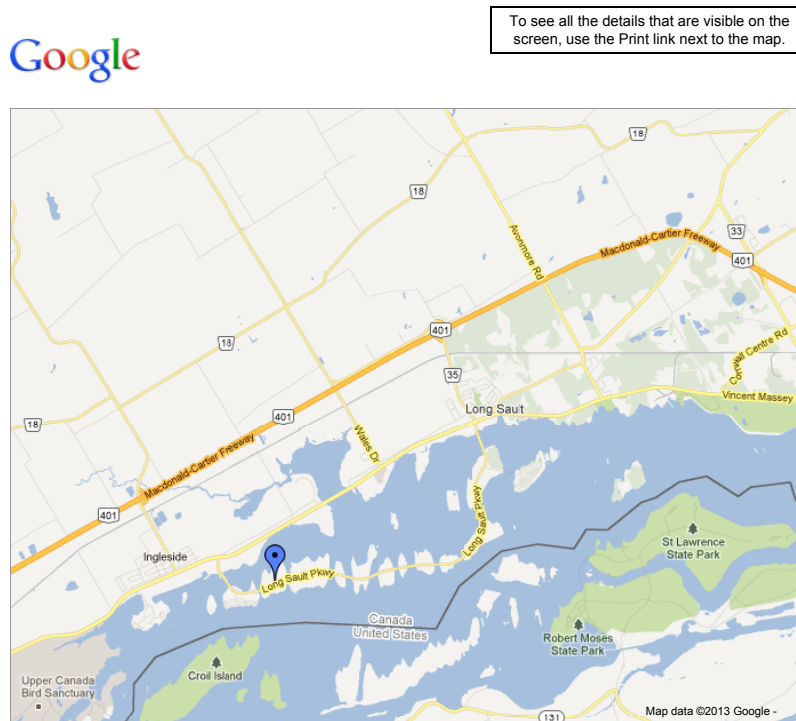
