As per 2010 CKC Agility Rules and Regulations:

8.1.2: “A dog may be entered in both the Standard Class and Jumpers with Weaves Class in each trial however, they must enter **only Regular or Selected or Veterans at any given show-weekend**. A dog may be switched back and forth in Regular and Selected but not during the same set of trials”

8.1.3: “A dog must be started at the Novice level for each Class: Regular Standard, Regular Jumpers with Weaves, Selected Standard, and Selected Jumpers with Weaves”.

TRIAL 1 - Saturday (Judge: Roger-Pierre Cote)

Round 1 – One Regular and Selected round of JUMPERS WITH WEAVES agility for Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only), Intermediate, Excellent A and Excellent B levels – all height divisions.

Round 2 – One Regular and Selected round of STANDARD agility for Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only), Intermediate, Excellent A and Excellent B levels – all height divisions.

TRIAL 2—Saturday (Judge: Roger-Pierre Cote)

Round 3 – One Regular and Selected round of STANDARD agility for Excellent A and Excellent B, Intermediate, Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only) levels – all height divisions.

Round 4 – One Regular and Selected round of JUMPERS WITH WEAVES agility for Excellent A and Excellent B, Intermediate, Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only) levels – all height divisions.

TRIAL 3 - Sunday (Judge: Carolyn Dockrill)

Round 1 – One Regular and Selected round of JUMPERS WITH WEAVES agility for Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only), Intermediate, Excellent A and Excellent B levels – all height divisions.

Round 2 – One Regular and Selected round of STANDARD agility for Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only), Intermediate, Excellent A and Excellent B levels – all height divisions.

TRIAL 4—Sunday (Judge: Carolyn Dockrill)

Round 3 – One Regular and Selected round of STANDARD agility for Excellent A and Excellent B, Intermediate, Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only) levels – all height divisions.

Round 4 – One Regular and Selected round of JUMPERS WITH WEAVES agility for Excellent A and Excellent B, Intermediate, Novice (Selected / Veteran Class only), Novice A and Novice B (Regular Class only) levels – all height divisions.

NOTE: No entry will be accepted without entry fees. Tendering of a NSF cheque shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC Rule 13.7.2). Charges for any NSF cheques issued to the Australian Cattle Dog Club of Canada will be \$35.00. No post-dated cheques will be accepted. Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded. To comply with the CKC, no entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time of entries (Chapter 13, Section 13.4 of the Dog Show Rules). Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted except in the event of a postal strike. Attention Foreign Exhibitors:

Please note that fees are payable in Canadian Funds. Due to the constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. We recommend the purchase of Bank Drafts or Money Orders in Canadian Funds. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "at par"; the banks will not clear them.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice:

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC by phone at (416) 675-5511 or by fax (416) 675-6506

Canadian Resident Non-Member Participation Fees (NEW):

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

PRIZES

Suitable prizes and / or rosettes are offered for High In Trial for each trial.

Top Australian Cattle Dog for each trial (Saturday and Sunday)

Placements: CKC Agility Rules and Regulations 15.2: "Dogs must have qualifying scores to be eligible for placement. The 4 highest scores in each height division in each class shall be awarded first through fourth placements...."

- Qualifying Score: Ribbon or Rosette
- First to fourth placing in each height division in all Regular and Selected classes: Ribbon

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- Showing correct information on the entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included with the premium or they will be rejected.
- No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. No telephone or fax (ie. Credit card) entries will be accepted. Post mark date will be the determining factor to accepting entries.
- Post-dated cheques are not acceptable. Tendering of a NSF cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$35.00 service charge will be levied on all NSF cheques.
- A refund of entry fees will be permitted for bitches in season or dogs unable to compete due to injury provided that the Trial Secretary receives satisfactory written confirmation from a Veterinarian prior to the start of the trial. No refund will be permitted for any other reason.
- Withdrawal of entry fees prior to the closing date may be made by telephone but must be followed-up in writing to the Trial Secretary so as to be received no more than 7 days after the closing date.
- The entry of any dog cannot be altered or cancelled after entries close, except as provided in the Agility Rules and Regulations.
- After closing of entries, an identification / receipt and judging schedule will be mailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address. There will be a running order posted with the dog's call name.
- There will be no armbands issued at the show.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be given. As well, any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog while on site will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refund of fees will be given.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not to be subject to any indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitor, but will not assume responsibility or be liable in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dog, exhibitor, patron, or property.
- DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEASH. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. Any one not following the 'stoop and scoop' policy will be excused from the trials.
- All dogs not entered in the trial, but on the show grounds, must be PRE-REGISTERED with the Trial Secretary.
- There will be no obstacle familiarization for any dogs.
- Handlers are responsible to keep their dogs quiet at all times, excluding the time they are running in the ring. If unable to do so, you will be asked to keep your dog in your car.
- TRIAL PRECINCTS: The precincts for this trial include the agility ring and within 30 feet of the ring.
- Move-ups will be allowed after the closing date. For Trial 1 move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than 72 hours prior to the trial. For all other trials move-ups must be received a minimum of 15 minutes after the class the title was completed in.
- Electronic timing will be used.

Directions to Trial Site

From Either Direction off Highway 101:

Exit 3 (Mount Uniacke): Coming from Halifax, turn right at the end of the off-ramp. Coming from the Valley, just follow the ramp. At the "T" junction (opposite the Irving Station), turn right. Continue approximately 4.7 km. Weir Centre is on your right. Follow the driveway around the fields behind the building.
