

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE: (#1 on map) – 501 Lefeuvre Road, Aldergrove

From Highway 1: — take Exit #73 (Aldergrove/264th Street/Highway 13). Go south on Highway 13 (264th Street) for 9.5 kms, thru two traffic lights. Turn left onto 8th Ave. Go thru a 4 way stop, *go past main park entrance* and turn right at the next street onto Lefeuvre Road (follow signs to "Aldergrove Bowl). Go to top of the hill and turn right at the gravel entrance (yellow bar-gate) and proceed into parking lot.

From the US —take exit #256 in Bellingham and proceed north on Hwy. 539 (Guide Meridian Road) to the Lynden/Aldergrove border crossing (opens at 8 a.m.) and turn right at the second street onto 8th Avenue. Go thru 4 way stop, *go past main park entrance* and turn right at the next street onto Lefeuvre Road (follow signs to "Aldergrove Bowl"). Go up the hill and turn right at the gravel entrance (yellow bargate) and proceed into parking lot. Show site is approximately 10 minutes from the border.

If you wish to cross the border before 8 a.m., we suggest the **Sumas/Abbotsford** border crossing (open 24 hours). Follow directions as above (and see map), but turn right onto E. Badger Road (Hwy. 546/9) just south of Lynden and follow directions to border. Cross the border and turn left onto Vye Road (traffic signal) and follow to Lefeuvre Road. Turn left onto Lefeuvre and follow signs to "Aldergrove Bowl" – at top of hill turn right at the gravel entrance.

NOTE: This is a long weekend in BOTH Canada and the USA (Friday is Canadian holiday, Monday is US holiday) so please allow plenty of time for border crossing as it could be very busy.
