*A listing fee of \$8.95 must accompany each entry for each dog per show and is payable with the entry fee if the entry form for the dog does not include its CKC individual registration number.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

1. No entry will be accepted unless the entry forms are completed in full. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or cancelled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries cannot be accepted.
3. Cheques dated after the close of entries will not be accepted. Tendering of an NSF cheque will be considered non-payment of entry fees. All NSF/returned cheques or declined credit card transactions will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge. There will be no refund of overpayments or duplicate entries.
4. Fax entries and/or credit card payment will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD credit card number, expiry date and cardholder's name. 10% of total fee will be added for FAX/Credit Card/Interact on entries.
5. An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. Written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary by the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.
6. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. MOVING DOGS FROM BRED BY – Should the breeder/owner be unable to handle the dog in the Bred By class, the dog may be moved to the Open Class at least one hour prior to the start of judging.

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a non-member of the CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

CLASSES

Regular classes (divided by sex)

JUNIOR PUPPY – for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age

SENIOR PUPPY – for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age

12-18 MONTHS – for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age

CANADIAN BRED – for dogs born in Canada, champions of any country excluded

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

OPEN – for all dogs

VETERANS – for dogs 7 years of age or over (split into two age categories 7—10 years and 10 years and over). These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs competing in this class may be spayed or neutered.

FIELD DOG – **The field dog class is divided by sex** Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY – for dogs that have a CKC registration or ERN number and have attained their Championship. Entry of a dog in “Specials Only” is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a “listed dog” in Specials Only is not allowed.

Sexually Altered Classes – for dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered. Two classes only will be offered, Altered Dog and Altered Bitch. Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes. The first-place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second-place winner from each sex will be for awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Dog and Altered Winners Bitch will then compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite Altered.

EXHIBITION ONLY – for all dogs

Non-Regular classes

BRACE – two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex), handled by one person on one lead.

STUD DOG – shall be comprised of the stud dog and two or more of his get. Ownership need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

BROOD BITCH – shall be comprised of the brood bitch and two or more of her progeny. Ownership need not be identical. The brood bitch may be spayed and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class.

Champions & Points

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points ranging from 0 to 5 and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows:

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points ranging from 0 to 5 the number of championship points shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

PRIZES AND ROSETTES

Through the generosity of members and friends, trophies/rosettes will be offered for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Puppy, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Award of Merit, first in each regular class, Best Sexually Altered, Best Opposite Sex Sexually Altered, Best Bred by Exhibitor, Best Veteran, Best in Youth Sweepstakes, Best Opposite in Youth Sweepstakes, Best in Veteran Sweepstakes, Best Opposite in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best in Breeders' Sweepstakes.

Awards of Merit will be presented after Best of Breed judging. One Award per every 10 entries competing for Best of Breed may be offered.

Best Bred by Exhibitor in Specialty

The award for *Best Bred by Exhibitor in Specialty* will be between the winner of the Bred by Exhibitor Dog Class and the Bred by Exhibitor Bitch Class. The judging for this award will take place after the Awards of Merit.

Best Veteran in Specialty

The award for *Best Veteran in Specialty* will be between the winner of the Veteran Dog Class and the Veteran Bitch Class. The judging for this award will take place after Best Bred by Exhibitor in Specialty.

YOUTH SWEEPSTAKES (divided by sex)

Dogs 6 to 18 months of age are eligible and these dogs must also be entered in the regular show. Dogs holding a championship title may compete.

JUNIOR PUPPY – for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age

SENIOR PUPPY – for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age

12-18 MONTHS – for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age

Class winners will compete for BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES and BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES (divided by sex)

Dogs entered for sweepstakes must be entered in regular classes or for Exhibition Only.

Dogs competing in this class may be spayed or neutered.

VETERAN (7-10) – for dogs over 7 years and up to and including 10 years

VETERAN (10+) – for dogs over 10 years

Class winners will compete for BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES and BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX.

BREEDERS' SWEEPSTAKES (divided by sex)

Dogs entered for sweepstakes must be entered in regular classes. Classes divided into Dogs and Bitches. Class winners will compete for BEST IN BREEDERS' SWEEPSTAKES.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

Salukis entering sweepstakes classes must be entered in a regular class or Exhibition Only. The first-place winner of each class will compete for Best in Youth Sweepstakes, Best in Veteran Sweepstakes or Best in Breeders Sweepstakes. Best of Opposite Sex will be chosen for Youth and Veteran Sweepstakes only.

The prize money for each sweepstakes will be distributed as follows:

- 50% of the class entry fees from each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class
- 15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweepstakes**
- 10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best of Opposite Sex*
- 25% will be retained for administrative purposes

*Not applicable to Breeders' Sweepstakes.

**Best in Breeder Sweepstakes receives 25% of total sweeps entry fees.

JUNIOR HANDLING

Conformation only. Judge to be announced. All dogs handled by Juniors must be entered in one of the Regular Classes or for Exhibition Only on September 3, 2016, but need not be owned by the Junior or his/her family.

CLASSES:

PEEWEE – 4 to 6 Years inclusive (non-competitive)

JUNIOR (Novice/Open) – 7 to 10 years inclusive,

INTERMEDIATE (Novice/Open) – 11 to 14 years inclusive

SENIOR (Novice/Open) – 15 to 18 years inclusive.

A Rosette and/or prize will be offered for First in each class, ribbons will be awarded to 2nd through 4th in each class. Participants' ribbons will be awarded to all Peewee entrants.

Best Overall (excluding Peewee) will receive a rosette and/or prize.

Registration will take place at the Show Secretary's desk up to 1 hour before judging on July 30, 2017

JUNIOR HANDLING NUMBERS:

Effective January 1, 2016: Junior Handlers with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

SPECIALTY CATALOGUE

Dr. Robert Place, Arabesque Salukis



Dr. Robert Place is an approved NOFCA, NACA and TCC huntmaster and judge. He is also an AKC and ASFA lure coursing judge and AKC conformation judge (Salukis, Whippets, Greyhounds, Scottish Deerhounds). Along with spouse, Joseph Minor, Place has participated informally in coursing for over 34

years, and competitively for about 20 years. Place and Minor started in sighthounds in 1983 when they adopted a rescue Afghan and Whippet, which Robert and Joe would regularly free course. Soon Place and Minor became intrigued by the athleticism of the dogs and continue to pursue this functional aspect as a priority.

In addition to their interest in coursing sighthounds, Place and Minor became interested in the show aspect and have finished scores of dual and triple conformation/performance champions (lure and open field). In 1988, Joseph and Robert acquired their first Saluki and have since bred and raised multiple litters of award-winning dogs. As active members, Minor and Place belong to a number of coursing and conformation clubs including Saluki Club of America, American Sighthound Association, Southwest Coursing Club, The Coursing Conservancy (TCC), among others. Place is past president and a board member of The

Coursing Conservancy, past president of Southwest Coursing Club (a NOFCA affiliate), and past president of Eastern Slope Coursing Association (ESCA), an ASFA affiliate club.

Past assignments include Empire Saluki Specialty, Huron Valley Saluki Specialty, the SCOA Western Regional Specialty Show (Redmond, WA), The AKC Lure Coursing National Championships, the Southern Greyhound Specialty show, and the NOFCA Grand Course (2004, 2014, 2015), to name a few. Place continues to have a heavy schedule of open field and lure course judging assignments for the upcoming 2017-2018 season.

Carole Adley, Hilerica Whippets and Salukis

My real start in Salukis was in September 1961 when I met Hope Waters at Willesden Dog Show in London. It was a small open show and she was showing 'Freyha' and two others. When she learned I was interested in Salukis (besotted would be a better word), she invited my husband and me to lunch the next Sunday. We all became lifelong friends, and I had the incredible good fortune to get the world's best mentor. In 1989 Hope moved to Canada and lived next door to me, then in 2000 we shared a home, until her death in 2009 year at age 97.

My foundation bitch was Ch. Burydown Calluna, a Freyha granddaughter, and over the years I bred a total of nine Saluki litters, the last three co-bred with Hope. My aim, both in Salukis and my other breed, Whippets, is to preserve genetic diversity and the qualities of each breed that make it unique and valuable.

Since July can very warm, exhibitors, owners, and handlers should take necessary precautions to protect their dogs from the heat. The use of shade tents is recommended. Please ensure you have made sufficient water available to your dog at all times.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL DOGS BE LEFT IN VEHICLES.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from these shows, which will be held strictly under Canadian Kennel Club Rules.
2. The Club reserves the right to decline to accept entries for just cause, in which case the fee will be refunded with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club holding the show or any official connected therewith for refusal of an entry.
3. The Show-giving Club will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds. Exhibitors are responsible for their equipment and possessions.
5. Dogs must be ready for judging. The club will not be responsible for and not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agent of breed or class judging. **NO RING WILL BE HELD UP WAITING FOR EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS.**
6. For the benefit of the health of animals, the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping the show grounds as clean as possible. **EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS.** Dogs are to be exercised in **DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.** Failure to comply may result in future entries being refused.
7. All trailers, motor homes, campers and recreational units will have buckets underneath their sink drains. Anyone found discharging gray or black water from their unit will immediately be removed from the grounds.
8. There will be no other facilities in case of inclement weather.
9. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
10. Entries will be acknowledged with a judging schedule as soon as possible after the closing date by email only. If it is not received within a reasonable time please contact the Show Secretary.
11. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Any exhibitor wishing to substitute or cancel an entry must do so in writing before the hour of closing. Substitutions or cancellations of entries after the closing time are prohibited. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUND FOR OVERPAYMENT OR DUPLICATE ENTRIES..**

Event Registration Number

For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC titles and degrees, foreign born, foreign owned dogs may apply for an ERN — Event Registration Number. This number must be obtained within 30 days of the first show entered to avoid cancellation of the points or legs earned and can be obtained by submitting a copy of your foreign certificate of registration along with a fee and a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN replaces an individual CKC registration number or MCN — Miscellaneous Certification Number for Trial entering purposes only. For breeding purposes, the individual CKC registration number must still be obtained.

Personal Identification and Dog's Rabies Certificates

Canadian Government regulations require that a dog entering into Canada must have a valid Rabies Certificate. The Rabies Certificate must be dated 30 days prior to be valid for re-entry into the United States. When entering into Canada, all persons must present proper photo identification and/or a valid passport to Canada Customs and Immigration at the border crossing, or airport terminal.
