#### **Chapter 20: Champions and Championship Points**

Section 1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Section 4. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition as provided in Chapter 4, Section 8(j) of these Rules shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

#### **Section 15.1.2 Dog Show Rules:**

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.
