SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more POINTS AWARDED 0 1 2 3 4 5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN).

Transition Obedience Classes

<u>PRE-NOVICE</u> – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

<u>NÓVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS</u> – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and

earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

For the benefit of the health of the animals, and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators, we insist upon keeping our grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and for maintaining a clean camping/benching area. Please report any areas that require cleaning to the show office. Thank you!

The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER OF A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "CDX" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but MUST COMPETE IN ...

NOVICE B - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog <u>ONLY</u> may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor MUST BE THE OWNER or A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY and MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES. No person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS 'A' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS 'B' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. prior to the start of the class.

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

NOTE: DOGS ENTERED IN THE ANY NON-REGULAR OF UNOFFICIAL CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

BRACE CLASS -This class is open to any two dogs of the breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. Same person need not own both dogs.

VETERANS CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries and have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class".

GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have not gained a qualifying score toward the "CDX" title in Canada BUT that has obtained the title "CD" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

GRADUATE OPEN CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have not obtained a qualifying score toward the "UD title in Canada BUT which has obtained the title "CDX" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

VERSATILITY CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have attained the title of "CDX" in Canada and at least 1 leg on the Utility title, or that has obtained the "UD" title in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

TEAM CLASS - This class is open to any four dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own all four dogs.

CLASSIFICATION

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 TO 18 MONTHS: Shall be for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs (divided by coat variety - Groenendael, Malinois, Tervuren, Laeken)

VETERANS CLASS: Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will NOT compete for Championship points but goes directly into the Best of Breed competition.

SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS.

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON-REGULAR / UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Note: Any dog entered in a Unofficial/Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

STUD DOG & GET: Shall be for Sire and three maximum of his Get. BROOD BITCH & PROGENY: Shall be for Dam and three maximum of her Progeny.

BRACE CLASS: Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), MUST be identical ownership

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes ONLY will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed.
