- ✓ US cheques are acceptable but do NOT mark them "Payable in Canadian Funds". Our bank will refuse them. Payments may be made by cash or money order.

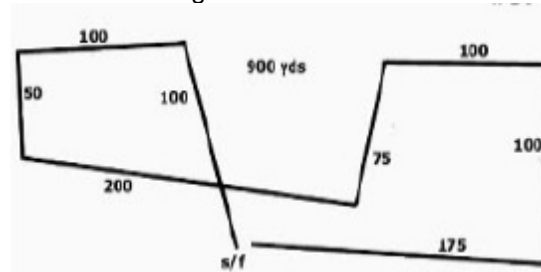

ELIGIBILITY: Only Purebred Sighthounds may be entered. All dogs must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial. Dogs not registered with the CKC must pay a \$8.72 Listing Fee per trial / per day until CKC registration is obtained. Altered and neutered hounds may compete. **DOGS PRESENTLY DISQUALIFIED IN CANADA OR THE US ARE NOT ELIGIBLE!**

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE APPLIES ONLY TO DOGS WHOLLY OWNED BY A NON CKC MEMBER AND ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CKC MEMBERS

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

EQUIPMENT: A continuous loop machine with white and/or coloured plastic streamers will be used. Back up equipment will be on site.

CONDITIONS: Stakes will be split in any breed has more than 24 dogs entered at the time of the draw. All dogs will run twice in braces or trios unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season or lame hounds will be excused, and any entry refunded if notice is given prior to roll call. Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched and entry fees not refunded. Handlers must use slip leads when starting their hounds. Muzzles may be used at owner's discretion. All hounds will be slipped from a standing start.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS IN REGULAR STAKES SHALL BE AWARDED ON THE BASIS OF THE FOLLOWING:

1st Place 4 x # of hounds in Stake (Max. 40 points)
 2nd Place 3 x # of hounds in Stake (Max. 30 points)
 3rd Place 2 x # of hounds in Stake (Max. 20 points)
 4th Place 1 x # of hounds in Stake (Max. 10 points)
 NBQ No Points

“A judge officiating at a field trial under these rules and regulations (CKC) shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the field trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the field trial to see that this regulation is effectively carried out. The Field Trial Chairman shall promptly report to the Canadian Kennel Club any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this regulation has been violated.”

 - Rosette and prize awarded for Best in Field.
- NOVICE COURSER-** Flat ribbon awarded all Hounds completing 3 qualifying scores.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER - \$58.85

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but may obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-born and foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Dogs may be entered as 'listed', however failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.

To obtain an ERN number, send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number Include cheque, money order or credit card authorization for \$58.85. PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER -\$53.50

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Those events are as follows: Obedience Trials, Tracking Tests, Herding Trials, Draft Dog Tests, Agility, Lure Coursing, Earthdog Tests, Hunt Tests, Working Certificate Tests and Pointing Field Dog Tests.

In order for a dog to be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met;

1. The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC.
2. The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration.
3. The dog must be spayed or neutered.
4. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (except dogs with an ILP number).
5. In the case of a foreign owned dog residing in the US, the dog must have an AKC ILP number.

HOUND CERTIFICATION

Effective January 2011: A hound must be tested with another dog, of the same breed or a breed with a similar running style (preferably not a kennelmate) and certified running clean by a licensed judge. Hounds must be a minimum of 11 months old prior to being certified, and must run a course of at least 600 yards (548.4m) in order to be certified.
