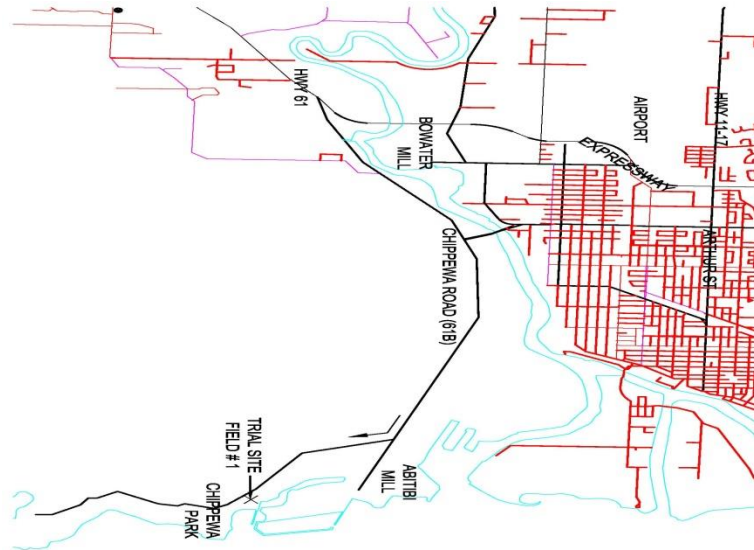

CONDUCT: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups will be permitted between trials. A dog earning a title after the closing date may advance to a higher level providing the Trial Secretary is notified by AUGUST 16, 2023.

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and 10 feet surrounding.
- Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials.
- The trials will be held outside on a grass surface. The courses will be set up within a fenced enclosure of 110' by 110'.
- No provisions have been made for rain or sun - bring your chair and protection from the weather for yourself and your dog.
- Please do not litter. Use the designated area for your dog, then clean up.
- Dogs must be under control at all times and kept on a leash except in the warm-up area and on the course.
- No food or other device will be allowed on the course. The dog may wear a well-fitted plain buckle collar, quick release collar or no collar on the course (note: no tags or decorations are permitted on the collar).
- The competitors participate at this event at their own risk. The release on the entry form must be signed.
- All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- The Flat-coated Retriever Society of Canada reserves the right to refuse entries, subject to CKC rules.
- There will be no contact familiarization for Novice dogs.
- Electronic timing will not be used.

CKC Agility Miscellaneous rule changes:

- ❖ A dog entered in Selected division may not move into Regular division at a later date. Dogs can no longer run in two divisions.
- ❖ Movement from Regular to Selected divisions is allowed.
- ❖ PAD – This strategic game involves a point gathering component and a distance element.
- ❖ STEEPLECHASE – This fast paced game is designed to test the dog's ability to negotiate a jumpers style course while performing the A-frame and weave poles.
- ❖ Now positionless table performance with a continual table count.
- ❖ Weave poles in all Novice Classes.
- ❖ A-frame at 5 feet for dogs jumping 12" or less.
- ❖ Mixed or unrecognized breed dogs are allowed to participate in the CKC Performance Events of Agility, Obedience, and Rally Obedience Trials effective July 1, 2014, with CCN.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors:

Please note that fees are due and payable as listed above. Discounted cheques will not be accepted. Cheques in US funds are accepted for the full amount of the entry (see US fee structure) and no exchange will be refunded. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par".

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

As of January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

Foreign born dogs require an ERN to earn CKC titles. The ERN MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event WILL result in the cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. To obtain an ERN, send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN. With the above, include a cheque, money order or MC/VISA number to the Canadian Kennel Club. Visit www.ckc.ca for current rates.

Performance Event Number (PEN) / Canine Companion Number (CCN)

A PEN allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. A CCN allows mixed breed dogs to participate in competitive events. A dog that is eligible for a PEN or a CCN may not be entered with a TCN. Events may only be entered after PEN/CCN has been issued.
