IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THIS SHOW

By submitting entries to this show you are declaring that you agree to the following rules and regulations. All these rules will be **strictly enforced**. Please do not enter this show if you have personal or political reasons for not respecting the protocols and guideline set forth by the Alberta Government, regarding COVID-19 protocols, rules to keep us all safe. Execution of the show is contingent on permission from Albert Health Services and the Alberta COVID reopening plan that allows ADULT SPORT EVENTS and we are allowed to compete in the numbers expressed in the catalogue. CKOC is communicating regularly with AHS and will follow their direction. Refunds will not be considered if you cannot travel to the show due to a restriction on travel, at the time of the CKOC All Breed Dog Show.

There will be a PHOTOGRAPHER at this show. Photos Now will have their own COVID-19 Protocols in place. See attached information sheet.

THE SHOW GROUNDS

The Official Show Grounds will be the **Cow Palace - MAIN ARENA** and will be used for all shows. Both Obedience and Conformation will have rings inside the Cow Palace, but there will extra rings located outdoors, if needed. The building will be split with barriers and kept segregated. The Cow Palace and only the Cow Palace is considered the Official Show Grounds.

There will be signage as to Entrance and Exit of the official Show Grounds (The Cow Palace). All entrances will have Screening Booths. There will be hand sanitizing stations provided in all areas.

The building will be thoroughly CLEANED each night, and anything left behind will be removed and disposed of. There will be NO lost and found. Judges' tables and other touch surfaces will be sanitized regularly, throughout the day.

MASKS

Masks are mandatory at all times while in the building and while in the ring. Masks must be worn properly. <u>Additional</u> Face Shields will be accepted as well, worn along with a face mask. Neck warmers, masks with exhalation valves, handkerchiefs and any other loose fitting face coverings are NOT masks and will not be considered as Masks.

If you do not bring a mask, one will be provided for you, at a cost.

WRIST BANDS

Every day, before you can enter the building you will fill out the COVID-19 Assessment Tool located in this Premium List and bring it to the Screening Station. Upon acceptance, a CKOC volunteer will give you a wristband and watch you place the wristband on your wrist. The wristband is ONLY GOOD for one day. The COVID-19 Screening can be done at any time throughout the day, at any Screening station.

Upon entry into the building, you will need to show your wristband before you can enter. CKOC will refuse entry into the "official show grounds" (the Cow Palace), to anyone without a wristband.

Each exhibitor will receive a maximum of ONE wristband only per entry. Due to COVID-19 protocols, there will be a maximum number of people allowed in the building at one time. NO replacement wrist bands will be issued.

COVID-19 WAIVER/DISCLAIMER

Order 05-2020 legally obligates any person who has the following core symptoms of cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat (that is not related to a pre-existing illness or health condition) to be in isolation for 10 days from the start of symptoms, or until symptoms resolve, whichever takes longer, or they receive a negative COVID-19 test. If they are exhibiting any of these symptoms, it is suggested they complete the COVID-19 Self-Assessment online tool to determine if

they should be tested. If you exhibit any of these symptoms or the symptoms on the COVID-19 Assessment Tool, you will NOT be allowed to attend the show.

A CKOC COVID-19 waiver/disclaimer, found in this Premium List will be required EACH DAY you are entered in the show. When you arrive for the first time, please fill out the WAIVER/DISCLAIMER, in this Premium List and bring it to the Screening Station. Look for the SCREENING Stations at the East entrance. Do not wait until just before you need to be in the ring with your dog, to get your wristband for the day. The CKOC volunteers are not responsible for poor timing on your part and the COVID-19 Screening will take priority over everything else.

If you are unable to attend/exhibit due to COVID-19 or any other ailment, it is your responsibility to find an alternative handler for your dog, if you wish to show/trial your dog.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

Maintain SOCIAL DISTANCING while in the Cow Palace. The Cow Palace is fairly large and without indoor benching, there will be no issues with Social Distancing. We are providing extra space in the rings to maintain these distances. We are marking the asphalt floor, so you do not encroach upon the person in front of you, be respectful.

There will be a staging area for each group, do NOT encroach on other areas or rings.

SHOWING/TRIALING

Exhibitors should arrive on the grounds at least ONE HOUR prior to their scheduled show/trial time and allow time for COVID-19 screening. Once screened, stay outside of the Cow Palace until 15 minutes before your breed time for showing. Once inside the Cow Palace, go directly to your staging area and stay there until your breed is called into the ring.

Once you have finished showing your breed, you will be required to leave the building promptly if you have no other dogs to show within the next 15 minutes. You may return 15 minutes before your next breed or Group judging, etc.

BENCHING

There will be NO BENCHING in the show building. If you are showing more than one dog you may bring a crate to house your conflicting dogs, in a holding area. This crate must be removed at once, upon completion of your breed judging. **No X-pens, floor mats or tables will be allowed inside the building.**

BATHING FACILITIES

The wash bay will only be available in 15-minute intervals. There will be a sign-up sheet at the entrance to the bays.

FOOD

You will not be able to eat in the building. The concession may or may not be operating, but there will be food trucks available if the concession is closed.

REFUND POLICY

If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any Alberta Government, City of Olds or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies, or directives, as outlined in paragraph 1, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be reimbursed. In the event of any refunds, credit card and Dogshow.ca charges will not be refunded. If you are refused entry due to you not passing the COVID-19 Assessment Tool you will not be given a refund.

Violation of any of these rules set forth will result in your entries for the weekend being cancelled with NO refund of entries. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS AND NO EXCUSES. Be respectful to each other, the CKOC volunteers and let us keep each other safe, so our beloved sport can continue to thrive in this chaotic climate.



Refund of entry fee is allowed for bitches in season provided a signed certificate is provided from a veterinarian. *Rally Obedience Ring size: 40' X50'*

DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE SHOW SECRETARY UP TO ONE HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE TRIAL

To be eligible to compete in these obedience or rally obedience trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, ***CCN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee - (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee
 will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by <u>Canadian resident non-CKC members</u> and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

<u>NOTE</u>: There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all NSF cheques and credit card declines. Tendering of an NSF cheque or declined credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the CKC.

CKC 19.7: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.."



CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

* includes the dog awarded Winners						

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more then five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

IMPORTANT: Please make sure you read all the COVID and General Rules.

By entering this show, you agree to abide by all the rules and guidelines of this show. Masks will be MANDATORY AT ALL TIMES IN THE BUILDING, and must be WORN PROPERLY – mouth and nose completely covered – no exceptions.

Masks must be worn IN THE RING. Full Face Shields are acceptable provided that you are also wearing a mask underneath it.

If you do not bring a mask, one will be provided for you.

- 1. The CKOC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be held responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 2. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant.
- 3. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$12.50 per copy + 5% GST.
- 4. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules
- 5. Entries will be acknowledged after entry by DogShow.ca and a judging schedule will be available after the closing date. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 6. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 7. ENTRY FEES WILL ONLY BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- 8. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS.
- 9. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs during the shows.
- 10. SHOW PRECINCTS shall be restricted to the entire Cow Palace, Regional exhibitions Grounds
- 11. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- 12. NO PINCH COLLARS ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE REGIONAL EXHIBITION GROUNDS. Exhibitors using Pinch/Prong collars will be excused from the shows/trials for the remainder of the weekend.
- 13. Group judging will follow breed judging through to BIS whenever possible. No two groups will be judged simultaneously. Should a conflict arise, the Chief Ring Steward shall determine which Group will be judged first.
- 14. The entire show site is designated "NO SMOKING" Exhibitors are not to be smoking near or about entrances/exits.
- 15. All exhibitors are to physically show their dog's bites to the judge in the ring. Thank you for helping to prevent the spread of disease.
- 16. Any show official, volunteer, employee or exhibitor shall not be subjected to any indignity by anyone at these shows. Should this occur the offender may be excused from the show/building by the Show Superintendent or his/her representative.
- 17. Unsportsmanlike conduct (e.g. loud, abusive, profanity ringside, etc.) will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the show. Please demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior while on the show grounds as a good example to other exhibitors and to spectators.

TEMPORARY CHANGES TO OBEDIENCE RULES PERMITTED BY THE CKC

COVID19 Obedience and Rally Rules General Guidelines Clubs will follow all Federal, provincial and local health rules when holding a trial and the protocol will be detailed in the Premium List.

Judges, officials, and handlers will abide by the rules specified

The following are allowable temporary changes to the Obedience rules and regulations that a club may opt to use during their event while operation under COVID restrictions. However any other changes to any other rule not mentioned here will not be allowed.

- Judges may wear a mask even if not required by the club
- The chair or table where the leash and other equipment is to be placed should be located at a convenient place determined by the judge but can be located in the ring or if not appropriate, just outside of the ring such that the handler can obtain the item without leaving the ring
- If a chair or table or any other surface is used to hold leashes, dumbbells, gloves or any other equipment owned by the handler, that surface must be sanitized immediately after use. Paper can be placed on the surface if sanitizing is not done but that paper must be removed immediately after use, disposed of appropriately and replaced ready for the next exhibitor
- If a re-throw of the dumbbell is required, the handler should be allowed to ask the dog to stay and the handler will go and pick up the dumbbell and return to where the dog was left. If the dog moves during this process, it will not be judged unless it is out of control
- For the article exercise in Utility, the handler can retrieve the articles to be scented from the article bag and put them on the 'article' chair
- Score sheets should not be given out to competitors in the ring, but the club may pass the score sheet information on to the competitors electronically or some other 'touch free' means
- In the Rally Advanced Class, the handler can put the leash in their pocket or hang it around the neck as in the Pre-Novice recall
- The exhibitor may either leave the dog on a sit stay or heel with the dog to the location of the chair to both obtain and return their leash and articles used during the exercises.

Covid Protocols for Photos-Now dog show Photography.

Taking photos inside and out.

Our usual setup for picture taking is

Flowers and sign, then Judge, dog and handler.

Revised setup.

Judge, flowers and sign, dog then handler.

This setup would have at least 6 or more feet from judge to handler.

Mask protocols would follow what is set for the show.

The photographer is at least 15 feet from those getting their photos taken. He will follow show mask protocols as well.

We would also take photos for each judge as they arrive for the day so they can be inserted into a photo taken without a judge.

Viewing photos

Inside

We normally set up the viewing stations behind the main table to allow multiple exhibitors to view at once.. the covid protocol will change the setup to have the viewing stations in front of the table to restrict access. Only one exhibitor and those in their bubble will be allowed at the viewing stations at a time. The viewing stations would be wiped down before another exhibitor uses them.

Outdoors
