### **MUST READ GENERAL INFORMATION!**

- Rules:** Hunt Test Rules and Regulations Books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club, 400-200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 6R4  
A judge officiating at a hunt test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the hunt test. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the hunt test to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
- Entries:** If not using DogShow.ca, entries must be typewritten or clearly printed. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms.  
No phone, faxed, emailed or late entries will be accepted.  
A separate entry for each dog in each test is required (official CKC entry form).  
ERN's (Event Registration Numbers) for foreign born or foreign owned dogs can be obtained from the CKC or Hunt Test Headquarters. ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.
- Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after closing.  
In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, no refund of entry will be made.  
**Bitches in season MAY NOT compete.**  
Full refunds will be given for dogs withdrawn because of an injury, illness or death and for bitches in season, if notification in writing is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. All refunds must be requested in writing and once the catalogue has been printed, will be less CKC event fees and listing fees if applicable.
- Running Order:** Running Order will be drawn shortly after closing and will be sent by email to the participants shortly before the tests. Start times will be adhered to as strictly as possible and participants are asked to be at their stake 15 min prior to start time regardless of running order.
- Clothing:** This is a "hunt test" – wear dark or camouflage clothing. No white or light clothing at any time.
- Birds:** Dead ducks and pheasants may be used in each stake. Live pheasants, pigeons and/or chukars may be used at the flushing test in the Master stake.
- Grounds:** No training will be allowed on the test grounds within 24 hours of the start of the test. A bumper thrown by the handler for the purpose of warm-up shall not be considered training.  
All dogs when not running in their test **MUST** be on leash and under control.  
Electric collars (either dummy or live), prong, or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the grounds, at any time during the event.  
Bring adequate shade, water and cover for hot or rainy weather for both you and your dog(s). Be prepared and carry a first aid kit.  
PLEASE pick up after your dog. Airing is only allowed in areas designated by Test Headquarters.  
Please pick up ALL garbage and keep the grounds clean at all times.
- Concession:** There is no concession available on the test grounds.

## TEST HEADQUARTERS

Hunt Test Headquarters will be located on the grounds off Swallowfield Road and will be well marked with signs.

Directions: If driving from Sidney (Swartz Bay Ferry Terminal), follow Hwy 17 to Victoria. Follow the signs to Hwy #1 North to Nanaimo. Follow Hwy #1 North past Duncan. Turn **RIGHT** at Mt Sicker Road - the Crofton/ Saltspring Island turn off. Turn **LEFT** at the T- intersection onto Westholme Road, then **RIGHT** onto Swallowfield Road.

If traveling from Nanaimo (Departure Bay or Duke Point Ferry Terminals) follow Hwy #1 South past Chemainus. Turn **LEFT** at Mt Sicker Road - the Crofton/Saltspring Island turn off. Turn **LEFT** at the T-intersection on to Westholme Road, then **RIGHT** onto Swallowfield Road. Please check BC ferries for departure times **and reservations are recommended**. It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. On report of the test-giving Club of an alleged indignity of any kind, the Hunt Test Committee of the Club shall forthwith conduct an investigation and shall at once render its decision to the parties concerned. It shall also, within twenty-one days after the test, report to the Canadian Kennel Club the nature of the alleged indignity, the names of the parties concerned and its findings. The Discipline Committee of The Canadian Kennel Club shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated. A copy of this rule shall be prominently placed in every premium list.

BY ATTENDING this test, competitors and spectators acknowledge that the Pacific Rim Hunting Retriever Club, test officials and the Landowners involved do not accept liability for any loss, damage or injury incurred by exhibitors, dogs or spectators.

**IF YOU FEEL at all UNWELL, in ANY way...PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND. If you have been in contact with anyone who *may* be infected, whether confirmed or not...PLEASE do not attend.**

### **COVID Hunt Test Information**

These guidelines may be altered or amended before the test, as per current PHO recommendations.

- Parking - Please leave more space between your vehicles, *within reason*.
- All participants need to bring ALL their own supplies.
- Practice social distancing. Maintain a MINIMUM of 2 meters distance between you and other participants, *at all times*. Don't be offended if someone reminds you to step back!
- Bring your own water and soap for hand washing and your own hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes. We will have some hand sanitizer, bleach wipes and a wash station there, but people need to plan to provide for themselves because of the difficulty in procuring some of these items.
- All judges, workers and handlers should use proper hand washing, be conscious of respiratory etiquette and avoid borrowing others equipment.
- You are welcome to wear a mask. Masks are our best line of defense against COVID 19. Masks may be removed at the line. The judges will ensure that they are well back of the handler, when the whistle or duck calls are being used.
- Do not shake hands or give hugs!
- There will be a designated area for airing your dogs. Please pick up after your dog, especially in any parking areas or along the road where the public walks. There will be moving vehicles, so please keep your dogs on leash.
- Please avoid petting other people's dogs.
- There will be a designated area for the gallery. Please maintain the 2 meters distance from anyone who is not in your household or in your social bubble.
- If you have any questions, they must be directed to the Marshal. Please do not come to talk to the judges at the line.
- While the test dog is running, please be very conscious of not crowding the line. Individually, you can come up to the running line to look at the test. Please wait your turn and do not move to the line until the previous person is over 2 meters away.
- Please bring your own duck calls, for use at the line. *Absolutely no sharing*.
- The handlers will place the bird in a pail or on a bird rack. Judges will not take them from the handlers. If the judge needs to check a bird, they will do so after the handler has left the line.
- If you are Marshalling, or might be gunning, please bring all your own supplies, such as radios, ear protection, pistols (209 shot will be supplied). Please do not share.
- Please be sure to pick up and take ALL your belongings at the end of the day. It is imperative that personal items not be left behind.
- There will be no Saturday night dinner.
- There is no camping at Westholme School. Please contact one of the listed campgrounds.
