OUTDOOR Agility Trial Judging Schedule

If you have not already done so, please review your entry for classes and jump heights and notify the trial secretary Dara Murphy at dlmagility@gmail.com as soon as possible of any concerns.

You will get course maps on the table where the ribbons are located. Maps will be put there after the optional unofficial warm up run for dogs entered in the standard run. Those who have entered the novice standard run can enter the warm up run at the registration desk where we will be there to help enter the warm up run (\$10 cash exact change if possible please).

You will also be able to sign up for your 2 volunteer positions there. For those of you that don't wish to run the warm up run or you are at higher levels you can check in at the registration desk and sign up for your volunteer positions. Your entry was dependant on your volunteering for at least 2 positions during the trial, without you we would be unable to run the trial

There cannot be food or toys (non squeaky toys are allowed in FFO runs and must be shown to the judge when entering the ring) within 10 ft of the ring (this is a CKC regulation).

Parking is available for quiet dogs under the trees along the laneway and on the SOUTH side only of the main parking lot if you have dogs that bark in the car. People parking under the trees at ringside **MUST** have dogs that do not bark in the car. Barking disturbs both the dogs in the ring and our neighbours. Please note we will not be looking for you, please keep an eye on the easel with the running order. **If you have entered conformation with your agility dog please notify the trial secretary in am of any conflicts. We will do our best to support you but we will not be able to rebuild courses. You will need to be at ringside for your run before the class has finished.**

Please note day of trial entries will not be accepted at this trial for official (and unofficial) runs.

Running order for the day is: Running Small to tall

Site is open at **7:30 am** for parking.

Running Order:

There will be a 30-minute lunch break at judge's discretion.

8:00 Warm up run (optional for dogs entered in novice standard, \$10.00 cash at door). Each dog will get 75 seconds.

8:30 Briefing and walk through for Novice Standard

You will find the results posted on the table where the ribbons are located. Your qualifying ribbon and placement ribbons are self-serve. If you do not wish to take them that is okay, we will be able to reuse them. Congrats to those of you who achieved a new title and wish to get a new title ribbon.

Results will also be emailed to you and posted on the Red Barn Event Centre's website.

In 2010 the Board of Directors of the CKC passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting, the Tracking fee motion was deleted and replaced with the following motion. Non-Member Participation Fee a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. This fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either, to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member Participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Cost is \$63.90 + HST.

The CKC has also asked clubs to remind competitors of the following;

HEALTH REMINDERS:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- PLEASE drive slowly down the long driveway. 10 km limit!
- There is a private residence at the front of the property. Do not walk your dogs down the driveway towards the residence as it upsets the dogs who live there.
- Only Park in the designated parking area.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring. No exceptions. No choke chains, pinch collars or flexi leashes are allowed on Red Barn Event Centre property.
- Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is friendly.
- Garbage policy at the Red Barn "IF YOU BRING IT PLEASE TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU" There will be a garbage can for the dog poop outside the door but that is all that can be put into it.
- No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum
- Be nice to our judges and volunteers. Remember if you want to be treated with respect – give others the same respect. We have a zero tolerance for any abuse of dogs or humans.
- Agility is a team sport, so please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home. Remember we enter the ring as friends and leave the ring as friends.
