**Entries will close at 6:00pm sharp on Wednesday, June 10, 2015 and the draw will be held immediately after the close at the home the field test secretary.**

**Entry fees:** \$55.00 per dog per test (NOTE: each day is a separate test) are to be paid in Canadian funds by cash, cheque or money order payable to the **Calgary Pointing Dog Club**. The Field Trial Secretary will acknowledge the receipt of electronically transmitted entries. All entry forms are to be completed and in the hands of the Field Trial Secretary and entry fees paid in full prior to the running of a dog.

**Listing Fee:** A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is \$8.93 per dog per each event entered during the field trial and is in addition to the entry fee(s).

All entries for this Field Test are accepted on condition that the CPDC, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this Field Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.

## TEST INFORMATION:

- **Courses & Birds** - Chukar partridge, quail and/or pheasant will be released. The tests will be over a single course with birds released along the course. There may be a bird field. The CPDC reserves the right in case of a bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.
- **Horses on the course** - Bird planters, marshals and judges may use horses. All other participants & spectators must be on foot. **All dogs will be handled on foot.**
- Total entries will be limited to the **number of dogs** that can be run in approximately 8 hours of judging time.
- **Starting times** will be announced after the draw (earliest start will be 7:00 am) Running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.
- **FDJ & FD** dogs will have **20-30 minutes** to complete all aspects of the test. **FDA** dogs will have **30-40 minutes** to complete all aspects of the test. **FDX** dogs will have **30-45 minutes** to complete all aspects of the test. Dogs will be run individually in the FDJ & FD Tests; dogs will be run in braces in the FDA & FDX.
- **Firearms:** Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD, FDA & FDX, shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by **official gunners** only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired – please **provide your own starting pistol** (calibre not less than .22 long).
- Bitches **in season** will not be permitted to run.
- **Collaring** a dog will be allowed only at the judge's instruction.
- **Tracking Collars:** Approved electronic tracking collars may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Trial Secretary.
- **Training or exercising** of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test weekend (from Friday evening until completion of judging on Sunday).
- **Smoking** is prohibited except in the designated camping area or individual's
- **Accommodations:** Camping will be allowed on the grounds on Friday & Saturday nights and will be restricted to marked areas. Facilities are limited so please come prepared. An outhouse will be provided. Cochrane motels: Bow River Inn, 932-7900; Cochrane Super 8, 932-6355; Harvest Country Inn, 932-1410.
- **Food: There will NOT be a concession** at the grounds. Please bring your own food, snacks etc.
- **Prizes** - Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test – no ribbons will be mailed
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test Rules are available from the CKC. **NOTE: Make sure you review the rules for Field Dog Tests (available on the CKC website: [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca))**
- **Location** – The test will be held at the home of Jim and Sue Deyell. The club is grateful to have these grounds and we ask for your co-operation in keeping the grounds free of litter by using the garbage bags provided. Parking will be restricted to the marked areas. **Please ensure that you slow to 50KM/H on the gravel road in front of Gone Wild Kennels.**
- **A map to the trial location will be forwarded to all participants along with the running order upon completion of the draw and prior to the running of the test.**
