Fees: \$90 (plus TCN fee of \$11.50 if the dog is not yet registered with CKC)

Closing Date & Time: 6 pm, 23 October, 2024. The club cannot accept entries after this date and time. Entries received by the closing date will be acknowledged by the secretary by email and included in the Entry Draw.

Draw for entries in the test will occur at 12:00 (noon), Oct 24, 2024 at The Barking Lot: unit 1-B, 1757 Hanwell Road, Hanwell, NB.

All entries that were not drawn for a place in the test shall be assigned a position on the alternate list in the order drawn in the entry draw. At the time of the draw for tracks on test day, entries from the alternate list may fill any absentee spaces.

After the Entry Draw, the club will send out acceptance letters or emails, advising entrants of the status of their entry. Directions to the rendezvous site will be provided.

Draw for tracks will take place at the Rendezvous site at 11:00 am: Tim Hortons, 1713 Woodstock Road, Fredericton, NB, after which the participants and spectators will be escorted to the test site.

CKC Tracking Rules (14.7): It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Ribbons & Prizes: Passing dogs will receive a Rosette and a suitable prize.

Bitches in season are permitted, but must run last and must be kept separate from other dogs.

These tests are open to mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds as per section 2.2.4 of the Rules.

Making Entry: Official CKC entry forms must be used. Owners are responsible for any errors in making out entry forms, regardless of who completes the entry form. Incomplete or improper entry forms will not be accepted.

Completed entry forms are to be sent only to the Trial Secretary (see address above). Entries may be mailed or e-mailed. Full payment must accompany entries; in the case of emailed entries, e-transfer payment must be sent to the test secretary at the time of entry (email: FINDME@NBNET.NB.CA - use the following as the password for the e-transfer of fees: TDXFEE). Please make cheques or money orders payable to RVO&FTC. Do not send cash in the mail.

Entries will be refunded within ten (10) days of the Tracking Test to those on the Alternate List who did not participate in the Test. If an entrant withdraws from the test* and their position is filled by an alternate who accepts the position, then the alternate is now responsible for the entry fee paid to the club. The original participant will be refunded the entry fee in full. If an entrant or an alternate who accepts a position in the test pulls out after the closing date, and there are no additional alternates willing to accept the position, then the entry fee is forfeited to the club. Entry fees will not be refunded if an entrant is Absent without having withdrawn their entry, disqualified, excused by the judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

NSF Cheques: Section 6.3.3: "Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees, and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards."

TCN* Fee: \$11.50 (Formerly known as a Listing Fee)

* TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees when entering events using a TCN. TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

Canadian Residents, please note: The CKC has implemented an annual "non-member participation fee" for residents of Canada who are not members of the CKC. Check with the CKC for the current fee. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles earned and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

[NOTE: for 2024 the non-member fee is \$170.00 and CKC "basic membership" fee is \$54.00]
