ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. Entries positively close 8:00 P.M. TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 26, 2019 or when the limit is reached and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Brantford & District Kennel & Obedience Club Inc. will use due care
 and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be
 responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other
 misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- 5. Judging will commence at 8:00 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule.
- Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy.
- 7. Show precincts are the entire Civic Centre.
- 8. No private Videotaping without the approval of the Show Superintendent.

The dog MUST be entered in either the Bred By Dog Class or Bred By Bitch Class in their respective breeds. Best Bred By in Breed will be selected from the 1st place winners in these two classes.

After Best of Breed, you may compete providing you have not already been defeated in the regular classes by another dog who is entered in the Bred By Exhibitor Competition.

Champions of any country are not permitted to entry this competition.

The breeder/owner MUST show the dog through each level of the competition.

SWEEPSTAKES AT THE BRANTFORD & DISTRICT KENNEL & OBEDIENCE CLUB

The Brantford & District Kennel & Obedience Club is holding Sweepstakes to promote the three areas of dog shows that need more recognition – Baby Puppy, Puppies and Veterans. The Club is also providing opportunities for potential judges to judge a larger number of dogs – something that is important to these potential judges due to the lack of Sanction Matches and Sweepstakes.

The Sweepstakes are being held at noon hour to facilitate a more appropriate time to hold such an event. This will, hopefully, result in a larger entry and a more enjoyable competition.

There will actually be three Sweepstakes each day – Baby Puppy, Puppies and Veterans. As Baby Puppy is being run as a sweepstakes, **entries must be made using Exhibition Only.** This is required by CKC Rules. Baby Puppy will be conducted as it is in any regular show. Each breed will be judged individually, then, there will be Group judging for that respective Group. The Group winners will advance to Best Baby Puppy in Sweepstakes.

Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes will be run as per normal sweepstakes and as per the rules outlined on the All Breed Puppy & Veteran Sweepstakes page.

BABY PUPPY

All entries will be made through Exhibition Only. Each breed will be judged individually in its respective Group. Breed winners will be judged at Group level and a Group winner disclosed. Group winners will then be judged to determine Best Baby Puppy in Sweepstakes. Rosettes will be awarded to winners at Group and Best in Baby Puppy Sweepstakes. There is no prize money for Baby Puppy.

SWEEPSTAKES

Sexes combined are offered at this Sweepstakes.

Classes - Junior (6 to 9 months) Senior (9 to 12 months)

Open (12 to 18 months)

All 1st Place Juniors will compete for Best Junior. All 1st Place Seniors will compete for Best Senior. All 1st Place Open will compete for Best Open. Best Junior, Best Senior and Best Open will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. Best Junior, Best Senior and Best Open will be awarded a Rosette.

To enter All Breed Sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in one of the regular CKC classes on the day of the sweepstakes.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Sexes combined (spayed and neutered dogs may compete).

 ${\it Classes - 7-10 \ years}, \qquad 10-13 \ years, \qquad 13 \ years and over \\ {\it First in each \ class \ will \ compete \ for \ Best in \ Veteran \ Sweepstakes}.$

First in each class will be awarded a Rosette.

To enter Veteran Sweepstakes, dogs must be entered in one of the regular CKC classes or Exhibition Only on the day of the sweepstakes.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize Money will be divided as follows, at the finals level:

First in each class will divide 30% of entry fees received for that class Second in each class will divide 20% of entry fees received for that class Third in each class will divide 10% of entry fees received for that class Fourth in each class will divide 5% of entry fees received for that class Best in Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes will be awarded a Rosette and 10% of Sweepstakes money. The Brantford & District Kennel & Obedience Club will retain 25% of entry fees for administration.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points allocated 0 1 2 3 4 5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <u>SHALL NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4-Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GCH POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Section 15.2.4 The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT AND GCHX POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Section 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) or a Best in Multiple-Breed Specialty with at least three (3) breeds represented plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Grand Champion Excellent point system:

Win	Points
First in Group or Best in Specialty Show	5
Second in Group or Best of Opposite Single-Breed Specialty Show	4
Third in Group	3
Fourth in Group	2
(Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	
Best of Breed	1
(To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Section 15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements: To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.



Travelling West: #403 West to Brantford to Wayne Gretzky Parkway exit. Turn left onto parkway and follow south to Colborne Street. Turn right on Colborne, merge onto Dalhousie Street (which becomes one way). Follow to Clarence Street and turn left. Exit right onto Icomm Drive, turn left at lights on Market Street. Civic Centre is next to Casino.

Travelling East: #403 East to the Paris Road exit , that becomes Brant Avenue. Drive straight on Brant Ave. to stoplights at the Armouries. Go through stoplights and follow Icomm Drive to Market Street. Turn right. **Travelling South:** Follow Hwy. 24 into Brantford, where it turns into King George Road.
