**Listing Fee .....** \$ 8.85

A listing fee is required for any dog without an individual CKC Registration number or ERN, except for dogs entered in Exhibition Only or Exhibition Only (3-6 months)

CKC Rule 8.4.1. If a dog is not registered with the CKC, but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided that:

- (a) if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- (b) if not born in Canada, it is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC;
- (c) if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an ERN or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

CKC Rule 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee, in addition to the regular entry fee.

CKC Rule 8.4.3 The CKC has the right to require the owner of a listed dog to provide proof of the dog's eligibility for registration in the CKC. If it is found that the dog is not eligible, the CKC shall have the right to cancel all wins.

### CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO: Japanese Spaniel Club of Canada

Cheques dated after close of entries will **not** be accepted. Tendering of a NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. **Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge** (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules)

The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. There will be no refunds on overpayments or duplicate entries

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

### CHAMPIONSHIP POINT SCHEDULE

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Additional Championship points may be attainable at the group level. See the CKC Dog Show Rules for details.

### CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

#### 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) ***"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"***

If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

## ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

### CKC – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) Requirement

A foreign dog may be entered with its Foreign Kennel Club individual number, if an extra "listing fee" of \$8.75 per dog per show day is paid. Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number. However, all foreign dogs will require an Event Registration Number. (ERN) within the time stipulated by the CKC, before a title can be confirmed. An ERN is also required to move a dog to the Champion (Specials Only) class, after it completes the requirements for its Canadian Championship title.

An ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the *Animal Pedigree Act*. An ERN enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each foreign dog must have its own ERN number within the time specified by the CKC; failing which all wins may be cancelled. Your dog's ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE FIRST CKC SHOW DAY ENTERED.

To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate (FCI pedigree) with payment by money order in Cnd Currency or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) to the CKC. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. The ERN **cost is \$59.50 plus 5% GST**. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website at:

## DOG SHOW ENTRY CLASSIFICATIONS

The following Canadian Kennel Club conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

### REGULAR OFFICIAL CLASSES:

**Junior Puppy** – dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

**Senior Puppy** – dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

**12 - 18 Month** - dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

**Canadian Bred** - dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

**Bred By Exhibitor** - dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

**Open** - all dogs.

**Veterans** – (CKC 12.2.1 (h) - dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered. The winner of the Best Veteran Male Class and the Best Veteran Female class is eligible to compete for Best of Breed and for the non-regular award of Best Veteran in Breed.

**Specials Only** – Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration number OR Event Registration Number (ERN) and have attained the required points for CKC Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

**Baby Puppy Class** – dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The judging of Baby Puppy classes will occur after Best of Breed judging. All male baby puppies shall enter the ring and compete for 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup>. All female baby puppies shall then enter the ring and compete for 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup>. The 1st place Baby Puppy (Male) shall then compete against the 1st place Baby Puppy (Female) for Best Baby Puppy in Breed. Note: CKC Board of Directors Motion 23-12-10: Judges will be instructed not to disqualify dogs in this class for lack of testicles or not meeting a minimum height required in a breed standard.

**Exhibition Only (3-6 months)** – for puppies 3-6 months of age \*IF the owner(s) has also entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. Puppies entered in Exhibition Only (3-6 months) may not participate in any Regular Official class, Non-Regular Class or Unofficial class.

**Exhibition Only** -..dogs 6 months of age or older. All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may NOT compete in any Regular class; but they may enter and compete in the Non-Regular classes: Stud Dog & Get; Brood Bitch & Progeny; and Brace.

**Stud Dog & Get** - the Stud Dog and 2 or more of his Get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The Stud Dog may be neutered and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Each Get must be entered in a Regular class. **Please complete and send the “Extra Form”** with your entry.

**Brood Bitch & Progeny** - the Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her Progeny. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The Brood Bitch may be spayed and must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Each Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. **Please complete and send the “Extra Form”** with your entry.

**Brace** - 2 dogs, 6 months of age and older, of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). Each dog must be entered in either a Regular class or Exhibition Only. CKC Rule 12.6.1 (c) A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

### UNOFFICIAL CLASS (CKC Rule 12.9.1):

**Breeders’ Class** - for Breeders who enter a minimum of 3 dogs and a maximum of 5 dogs of their breeding. The **name of the breeder(s) must be identical on each and every dog exhibited** in this class. The breeder must handle one of the dogs throughout the judging of the class. Ownership, dog age (must be 6 months of age and older), dog gender and dog colour need not be identical. The class will be placed first to fourth based on overall excellence and uniformity of quality. Each breeder’s class of dogs will be presented to the judge as one unit, with the breeder and handlers working as a team to gait the dogs simultaneously in the ring. Table examination will be at the judge’s discretion. Each dog in the Breeders’ Class must be entered in either a Regular Official class or Exhibition Only. No neutered dog or spayed bitch may compete in this class. Judging will occur after Regular and Non-Regular class judging.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

**WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:** An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Specialty Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show and it will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will apply to this specialty. CKC Conformation Dog Show Rule books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.00 plus GST per copy.

“It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities” – CKC rule book, Section 19.7

In consideration of the acceptance of the dog's entry, the owner (or the agent acting on behalf of the owner(s), agrees to hold the JSCC, its members, directors, officers and agents, and the judge of this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may allegedly be caused directly, or indirectly, to any person or thing by the act of the dog entered, while in or about the event grounds, and the owner(s) and any agent acting on behalf of the owner(s), personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and by entering a dog, the owner(s) further agrees to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to the dog entered in this show.

**The owner(s) and any agent acting on behalf of the owner(s) of the entered dog further agree** to assume the sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person(s), on account of damage to property arising out of, or as a consequence, of participation in this event, **however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused, or may be alleged to have been caused, by negligence of the aforementioned JSCC, its members, directors, officers, or any employees, or agents.**
