Indignities:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the Ottawa Valley Pointing Dog Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

Courses & Game:

Chukar, pigeons, pheasant or any combination there-of, will be used in all field test categories. A recognized game bird (duck, chukar, pigeons, or partridge) will be used in the FDX water retrieve. Ducks will be used for the WDJ, WD, WDX, and WDE tests.

Shooting will be by "Official" gunners only.

FDJ, FD, FDA, FDX, & FDXCH courses will be a single course with a bird field.

FDJ and FD dogs will be run individually.

FDA, FDX, FDXCH dogs will run in braces.

FDJ handlers must carry a starter pistol.

For safety, FD, FDA, FDX, and FDXCH handlers must wear blaze orange clothing items.

Fees:

- \$60.00 (\$55 OVPDC members) per field entry & \$60.00 (\$55.00 OVPDC members) per water entry per day, or \$115.00 (\$100 OVPDC Members) for both field tests Saturday, and \$115 (\$100 OVPDC Members) for both water tests Saturday, prior to the closing date of June 2, 2023.
- Day of Test entries \$70.00 per field entry and \$70.00 per water entry or \$130.00 for both on the same day.
- Move-ups will be allowed between events.

Fees are payable in Canadian Funds only.

A listing fee of \$11.30, as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the Entry Form.

Entry Close:

Closing of entries will be by June 2, 2023 or when the tests are full.

All entries must be paid in full prior to your tests- Saturday, June 10th, 2023.

NO females in season will be permitted on the test grounds

Draw:

• Running order draw will take place at the home of the Event Test Secretary at 21:00, June 8th, 2023.

The drawing will be random and specific times assigned. You will be notified of your start time via email. If two dogs owned by the same person draw consecutive numbers, the second dog will be redrawn.

Prizes:

CKC blue flat ribbon will be awarded to each dog earning a qualifying score. OVPDC will present rosettes to those that earn a Field or Water Title. Ribbon's will be awarded at the end of each class (i.e. after FDJ)

Shelly Price Field Dog Junior Award: In memory of Shelley Price, long time OVPDC club member and passionate dog sports woman, the second annual 'Shelley Price Field Dog Junior Award' will be awarded on Saturday afternoon to the judges choice, dog & handler team in FDJ class, in recognition of excellent teamwork and sportsmanship.

Meals:

No lunch served for participants, only judges and volunteers. Please bring your own snacks/lunch and water for you and your dog.

Camping/Hotel:

Limited camping for judges & OVPDC executive ONLY due to space.

Please check for dog friendly accommodations at the Microtel in Casselman, ON if you require them.

Other:

- No training of dogs on the grounds during the test.
- There will be a port-a-potty on test grounds
- It is recommended that dogs competing have up-to-date immunizations.

Special Note: Field Dog Test Rules and Regulations

Paragraph 18.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or competitor at a Field Dog Test or Water Dog Test is not subject to indignities. The Field/Water Test Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that one has occurred.

Paragraph 11.3

It is mandatory that judges, handlers of the working dogs and marshals, wear a blaze orange outer garment (vest or jacket) and blaze orange headgear in any tests where shotguns are used. The requirements also apply to any gallery members on the course.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee:

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to Canadian Non-Members of the CKC. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards & titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

AGREEMENT OF EACH ENTRANT

In consideration of the acceptance of my/our entry (ies) and of the holding of the test and of the opportunity to have the dog tested and to win ribbons or trophies, I/we acknowledge and agree as follows:

- 1) The Ottawa Valley Pointing Dog Club (OVPDC) may refuse any entry for just cause, which the OVPDC deems to be sufficient.
- 2) Field tests have certain inherent dangers associated with them, including, without limitation, those due to the presence and/or use of firearms, and as such any person participating in the test or being present on the test grounds assumes the associated risks.
- 3) To hold the Canadian Kennel Club (the "CKC"), any CKC approved judge, the OVPDC, its members, directors, officers, agents, committee members, test secretary, official gunners at the test and the owners or lessor of the test grounds and any employees of any of them (collectively, the "Club"), harmless from:
 - a) Any claim for loss or injury which may be caused or alleged to be caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by any act of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, while in or upon the test grounds, or near any entrance to the test grounds;
 - b) Any claim for loss of any dog I have entered in the test, or am responsible for, by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether the loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury is caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any other person or any other cause or causes;
 - c) For bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting from bodily injuries, sustained by any person or persons, including myself/ourselves, any minors for whom I/we is or are responsible or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my/our or their participation in the test or presence on the test grounds, however such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of the Club or any of them or any other person; and

I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I/we further agree to assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the Club harmless from any and all losses and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law or a court of competent jurisdiction upon the Club or any of them for any of the foregoing.

I/We agree to be bound by this Agreement of Each Entrant printed in the Official Premium List. I/we certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs.
