DIRECTIONS TO SITE

Take Hwy 101 from Halifax towards the Annapolis Valley. Take exit 4 off Hwy 101 (St. Croix) Turn right off the off ramp and continue straight for 3 km. Turn left onto Hwy 215. Proceed 3.4 km to the McKay Road. Turn right onto the McKay Road and proceed 1.5 km to # 294 McKay Road.

Section 21.7 CKC Field Trial Rules and Regulations

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at the event held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
