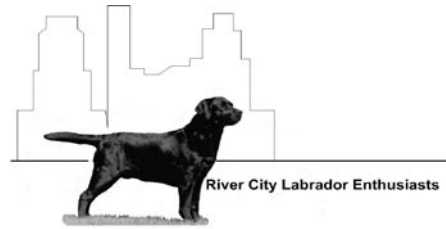

A separate entry form for EACH DOG in EACH STAKE is required.

All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee and, if applicable, a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) fee of \$10.50. Dogs not registered in Canada (CKC registered or with an ERN) must obtain a TCN before submitting an entry for an event. TCN's can be obtained from the CKC online, by paper application, or by contacting the Shows & Trials division toll free at 1-855-364-7252. CKC Registration or ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the event or all awards will be cancelled.

## **Canadian Kennel Club Non-Member Participation Fee as of January 1, 2011**

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.
- The non-member participation fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry Fee. Telephone entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries are made. The test committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge. Entry fee plus service charge for NSF cheques must be paid prior to the test.

### **TEST DETAILS**

- Running order will be determined by a draw. Multiple entries by the same OWNER/HANDLER will be automatically separated unless otherwise requested.
- WC followed by WCI followed by WCX on land and then on water
- Ducks will be used in all stakes, land and water
- **Meet at 8:30 am on the test grounds, dogs to line at 9:00 am**
- Check in with marshal at the test site
- All handlers must wear dark or camouflage clothing
- Handlers may be needed to throw birds or other duties, when not running their dog
- Standard CKC rosettes to all dogs qualifying in each stake
- Bitches in season shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the test grounds. Entry fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus shall be refunded in FULL. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the test to qualify for a refund.

**Excerpt from CKC Rules and Regulations for Working Certificate Tests (section 14.7)**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participants at an event held under these rules, is NOT subject to indignities of any kind. The Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**GROUNDS**

MGDA Grounds are located north of Balmoral. Travel north on Hwy # 7 for 34.8 km to 88th Rd N. Turn left on 88th Rd N. and travel 14.8 km west until you reach the MGDA grounds which are located on the north side of the road.
