

FROM THE CKC RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 13.3 Judging of Altered Classes
- 13.3.1 The breed standards for each breed shall be followed except as defined in this section 44
- 13.3.2 All disqualifications shall apply except for those that disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conformation competition.
- 13.3.3 Judges shall judge this class as if judging regular conformation classes. Withholding of awards for lack of merit is encouraged.
- 13.4 Eligibility for Altered Classes
- 13.4.1 Eligibility for the altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six (6) months of age that have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure.
- 13.4.2 Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the altered class

CKC SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

NOTE: per CKC rules, Baby Puppy (4-6 month) classes will be offered at only one show per day

— Shows 1, 3, and 5.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

U.S. Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

FEES / CHEQUES / N.S.F. CHEQUES

All fees must accompany your entries. No entries will be accepted without accompanying full payment. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$50.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the Prince Albert Kennel & Obedience Club. (Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted).

Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded.

OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS

ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR DISTINCTLY PRINTED. Owners are responsible for errors on entries. Incomplete entry forms must be returned to the designated owner or his authorized agent. Unsigned, telephone, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal strike when telephone entries may be made in accordance with the Canadian Kennel Club Regulations.

BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All of these classes must be divided by sex except for Specials Only.

Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH: for dogs 12 - 18 months on the day of the shows.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be canceled. Dogs entered in this Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

ALTERED: For the purposes of this section, "altered" shall mean dogs that have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure Winners of their perspective altered Class compete for points for Altered Champion Status. All rules and regulations in the Conformation Rules & Regulations shall apply to this class unless otherwise specified in this section.

VETERANS Class Dogs seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. This class may, at the discretion of the club, be divided by age into not more than three age divided classes. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

BABY PUPPY: shall be for dogs four to six months of age on the first day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. The class is to be judged after breed judging.

EXHIBITION ONLY (4-6 Months): Puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in Sweepstakes if a 4–6-month class is offered.

EXHIBITION ONLY: for all dogs 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC. Must be entered in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions; may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in non-Regular classes and/ or Parades if offered.

MOVING DOGS TO "SPECIALS ONLY": A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or agent at least 1 hour prior to the judging of the breed. A dog that has a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) is not eligible to be transferred from one (1) of the regular classes to Specials Only. NOTE: Class dogs may be moved to "Specials Only" as long as the registration number is on the "Move Up" Sheet.

- We will be accepting mailed in (or courier), drop off and ONLINE entries only no faxed nor
 emailed entries.
- Couriered entries are NOT to have a signature required upon delivery.
- There will be 160 online entries available with a closing date of Wednesday August 7, 2024, 7:00 P.M. CST
- For those who do not have access, or have limited access, to online entries via DogShow.ca, we
 will be accepting no more than 40 entries via mail-in or courier or drop-off, with a closing date of
 Friday July 19, 2024, noon CST.
- Please note all of these entries MUST be paid via cheque or credit card no e-transfers or debit cards will be accepted.***Those exhibitors entering via mail/courier/drop off shall be limited to the maximum of 4 dogs being entered. More than 4 dogs being entered/handled MUST be entered via ONLINE. If an exhibitor/handler should submit via mail more than 4 dogs' entries, those entries will be returned via Canada Post
- Entries will NOT be accepted prior to the opening of the entries.
- Any entries received prior to the posting of the entries will be returned via Canada Post.
- Entries will NOT be accepted that are not on the Official PAKOC Entry Forms provided with the Premium (released at 7 PM on July 15, 2024).
- All entries MUST be filled out in its entirety and with no errors or omissions.
- Entries with errors or omissions will NOT be processed and will be mailed back to the sender via Canada Post.
- The Show Secretary shall not be contacting exhibitors to inform them of errors/omissions on their entry forms.
- Please note those paying by credit card MUST have the correct credit information on the entry
 – if not, the entry will be considered incomplete/incorrect, and will not be processed, and will be
 returned via Canada Post.
- Envelopes of entries received will be numbered and marked in the order and date of receipt.
- Envelopes with entries received after the official opening entry date and time, and prior to the closing of the shows, will be opened on the entry opening date or later, in order of receipt, and, if complete and correct, will be processed up to the amount of 40 entries received.
- Entries received that are more than the limit of 40 allowed will be mailed back to the sender.
- All entries, once processed, result in an email from DogShow.ca being sent to the sender notifying
 them of a pending approval entry. This is how you will know that your entry was received on time,
 was among the allowed 40 available entries and was complete and correct. Please do not contact
 the Show Secretary prior to this time to allow her to complete the entry processing.
- Should less than 40 entries be processed as a result of the mailed-in/dropped off/couriered method
 of submitting entries, the balance available for total entries (200) will be made available for Online
 entry.
- As per section (h)Should a club receive the number of entries that the show has been limited to before the closing date of the show, a waiting list should be kept by the Event Secretary based on date order and time of entries received. If a dog is withdrawn from a multiple show, the next dog on the waiting list must be offered the opportunity to enter the show. Exhibitors that withdraw an entry from a multiple show cannot replace that entry with another dog of their own.

SHOW TIMES

All start times will be specified in the judging schedule emailed to all exhibitors after entries close. Both shows each day will be judged concurrently. Group judging will commence immediately following breed judging. No two groups will be judged at the same time. Should a conflict arise, the Chief ring Steward shall determine which Group will be judged first. Best In Show will follow shortly after the last group has been judged.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. THE BOTTOMS OF ALL EX PENS AND WIRE CRATE BOTTOMS **MUST** BE LINED WITH PLASTICSUPPLIED BY THE OWNER/HANDLER.
- 2. Exhibitors are required to clean up their benching area upon leaving. Those who do not will be billed a\$50.00 clean-up fee which must be paid before entering future PAKOC events.
- 3. Dogs will be allowed to stay in the building overnight; however, they will be left at the owner's/handler's own risk. There will be security on site. Please leave your name and contact information in plain view at your benching site so that you may be contacted in necessary.
- 4. As per CKC rules all dogs on the show premises **MUST be listed in the show catalogue**. Any dogs not listed will be asked to leave. If you have a dog at the show that is not entered, you must obtain an "INTRANSIT" ticket from the Show Secretary (no charge).

Because we have limited benching space, please leave your extra dogs at home.

- 5. DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN THE **DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.** NON-COMPLIANCE WILL RESULTIN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE SHOW. POOP/SCOOP RULES ARE **STRONGLY** IN EFFECT!
- 6. We recommend booking your Hotel Reservations early.
- 7. Entries will be acknowledged after entry by DogShow.ca and a judging schedule will be available after the closing date. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary
- 8. Entry fees will not be refunded for cancellation of entries if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly.
- 9. If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 10. **NOTE TIME!! The show grounds/building will be opened Monday, at 4:00 pm (NO SOONER) for exhibitors to set up. **The Club volunteers ask that you please wait until 4:00 PM before coming into the building so that they all have the time to complete what they need to do. The building will be open from 6:30AM to 11:00PM Tuesday & Wednesday and 6:30 AM to 8:00 PM on Thursday.
- 11. Any show official, member, volunteer, employee or exhibitor shall not be subjected to any interaction which is deemed an indignity or disrespectful by anyone at these shows. This includes inappropriate volume, tone or language used. There will be a ZERO tolerance for this kind of behavior, and should this occur, the offender may be excused from the show/building by the Show Superintendent or his/her representative.
- 12. Unsportsmanlike conduct (e.g., loud, abusive, profanity ringside, etc.) will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the show. Please demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior while on the show grounds as a good example to other exhibitors and to spectators.
- 13. PLEASE NOTE THURSDAY EXHIBITORS TO BE GONE FROM THE BUILDING BY 8PM.

15.1 Championship Points

15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 OR MORE
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

^{*}Includes the dog awarded Winners In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

- 15.1.3 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.4 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.5 If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.
- 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section. Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated. (26-06-17)

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

- 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.
- 15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group. (26-06-17)
- 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level
