Late and/or Day of Show entries are not a guaranteed entry and will be accepted only up to judging limits. Confirmations will not be sent for late entries. Judges are limited to 8 hours judging and a maximum run value, which will require this Club to limit entries accordingly.

**Run Order** - Run order for all days will be Ring 1 – Instinct, Novice 1, Novice 2, Open 1, Open 2. Ring 2 – Crazy 8s 1, Senior 1, Master 1, Master 2, Senior 2, Crazy 8s 2.Fraser Valley Ratters reserves the right to change the run order based on entries received and shall send out the final class run order and judging schedule **TWO DAYS** prior to the start of the trial. For instinct, novice and open, dogs will be staged in blinds of no more than 6 dogs. Senior, master and crazy 8s will have blinds of 5. Dogs handled by the same person will be in separate blinds. Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged prior to the official start time or as the first blind(s) of the Event.

### Directions to 4480 Hunt Road, Agassiz, BC

**From Mission**, take the Lougheed (BC 7) eastbound. Right on Cameron Road (first right after you come off Woodside Mountain.) Right on Hunt Road (past the railroad tracks, then between the farm and the rose garden.) Follow to the end of the road, which ends in the farmyard. Barn Hunt barn on front right side, across from sink.

**From the Trans Canada** (Highway 1) eastbound, take Exit 135 (BC 9) towards Agassiz/Harrison Hot Springs. Follow through Agassiz on BC 9. At 4 way stop, go left on BC 7 towards Mission. Left on Cameron Road. Right on Hunt Road (past the railroad tracks, then between the farm and the rose garden.) Follow to the end of the road, which ends in the farmyard. Barn Hunt barn on front right side, across from sink.

### Exhibitor Information

### Crating

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times unless actively working. The trial will be held in a concrete and dirt floored partially open barn. Inside dog crating will not be available. There is parking nearby to crate in cars. Parking spaces are first come, first served.

### Collars and Leads

Electronic collars, bark collars, muzzles and head halters are not allowed on Barn Hunt show grounds. Collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced are strongly recommended for the ring. No flexi leads in the barn.

**Bitches in Season** - Bitches in season MAY compete at a Barn Hunt Trial. They will be run at the end of each class and will be crated and pottied in a designated area. Bitches in season MUST wear pants at all times except when being pottied. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the start of the trial.

**Eligibility** - Open to all breeds and mixed breeds, 6 months or older. Your dog **must** be registered with the Barn Hunt Association to participate in this event.

Height Divisions (at withers)

Small - 13" and under Medium - 13.1" to 18" Large - over 18"

### Dog Aggression

Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner towards another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial at the discretion of the judge and/or trial committee.

### Safety

The safety of our dogs and rats are a primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and physically able to perform all course elements.

Abuse of any kind towards volunteers, dogs, rats, competitors, judges or trial committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from this event.

#### Awards

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each height category of the A classes, 1st through 4th in the B classes and for all qualifiers. Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> place, High In Class and New Titles. Special awards may be made at the discretion of the Trial Committee.

### **Refunds and Cancellation Policy**

After the closing date, entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. Entry fees will be refunded in the event the handler is not well on the day of the trial.

Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. No event fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.

Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will be eligible for a 75% refund of entry fees paid upon receipt of a note from a veterinarian. The note must be dated and emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary prior to the close of the trial.

#### **Returned Check**

A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$35 fee for all returned checks.

**Smoking or Vaping** There is NO SMOKING or vaping in the barn area. If you must smoke, please do so inside your vehicle or off the event site.

Move Ups and Lateral Moves are allowed between trials.

#### COVID-19

We will be following the temporary rules as directed by Barn Hunt, LLC. For the most up to date regulations, check out <u>covidrules.pdf (barnhunt.com)</u>

All handlers **MUST** wear masks at all times within the blinds or barn and at all times when within 10 feet of another handler on event grounds. Handlers are required to provide their own masks.

Provincial directives in effect at the time of the trial will be adhered to. This may limit the number of handlers able to be on site at a given time.

If you are not feeling well the day of the trial, please stay home. We all want to compete with our dogs, but must also be concerned with the well-being of all competitors. Contact the Trial Secretary for a refund of entry fees.

A Covid Waiver must be signed and dated on your first day of competition at this trial. A covid waiver will be emailed with your final trial confirmation package. Please print and sign the waiver and bring it with you to the trial or email it to fvratters@gmail.com. If you are unable to print it, you must sign one upon entry to the trial site.
