#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. Current shoulder heights and jump heights, breed and weight exemptions, a description of classes, levels and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook. Through submission of their entry, the exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitors Handbook.

Exhibitor's Handbooks are available free of charge by downloading from NADAC's web site at www.nadac.com.

• All dogs must have a NADAC dog registration number when entering a trial. Entries will not be accepted for dogs using "pending" in lieu of a number. Dogs can be registered on-line at <a href="https://www.nadac.com">www.nadac.com</a>.

**IMPORTANT**. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the <a href="www.NADACForum.com">www.NADACForum.com</a> within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to <a href="www.NADACForum.com">www.NADACForum.com</a> and submitting your request. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

**Levels**. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

There shall be no refunds, cancellations, or changes for entries after the closing date, unless a veterinarian certificate verifies a bitch is in season.

Please take responsibility for your dogs and children. The Calgary Canine Centre Ltd will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked by the Trial Committee to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds for entries if a dog or handler is dismissed from a competition for any reason. Anyone not in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

This event will be held indoors on shavings/dirt mix. Dogs must be kept under control always and must be on a leash unless competing. Bring your own, chairs, pens or crates and water.

#### **Class Changes**

If you complete a title on Sunday, you may move up to the next level on Monday. There will be NO same day move ups. Class move up forms will be available at the Table. You are not required to move up to the next level until you wish to. Classes will be double run classes this means that Round 1 & 2 of all classes will be the same round run twice.

#### **Check In and Measuring**

Only dogs entering the Small and Medium dog classes are required to be measured at the trial prior to competing unless they have a NADAC permanent height card or are competing in skilled. Please bring height cards with you. Check in and measuring dogs will be Sunday and Monday from 8:00 AM to 8:30 AM. Judges briefing will be at 8:30 AM each day and first dog on the line at 9:00 AM.

#### **Proficient/Skilled Categories:**

Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled. In the Skilled Category, dogs *MUST* jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog may jump less than 4"). In the Regular Agility class, dogs may incur 5 or fewer faults, and earn a 5 pt. qualifying round.

#### Non-Jumping Classes – Veteran Or Disabled Handler:

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only. The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

## **INTRO LEVEL INFORMATION**

- The Intro level will be a shorter course than Novice.
- The only Intro level class with weaves will be Intro Weavers and it will have one set of 6 poles.
- No other classes will have weaves in them.
- The Intro level will have no tunnel/contact discriminations.
- The Intro level is a full titling level with the basic titles at 30 points, Outstanding Performance at 60 points and Superior Performance at 100 points for Chances, Jumpers, Tunnelers, Weavers, Hoopers, Touch N Go, Barrelers, and Hoopers. For Regular the basic title is at 30 points, Outstanding Performance is at 100 points and Superior Performance is at 200 points.
- All other NADAC rules apply.

#### As of January-2014

Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes

**CONTAINERIZED TRIAL:** Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a ziplock bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container must not be visible to the dog or anyone else and may not be opened within 10 feet of the ring boundary. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose.
