There are NO extra fees for e-transfers. Due to COVID 19, we will not be accepting any paper or emailed entries.

All fees are payable in Canadian Funds. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied with payment in full within 24 hours, confirmation and judging schedule will only be sent to entries that are accompanied by full payment. Unpaid entries will be deleted without notice. Cheques will not be accepted due to the short turn around time of this trial. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

CKC has a Non-Member Participation Fee of \$63.90 + HST. This fee only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members. "These events held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club"

*** NEW*** You will be provided a time to attend this trial and the time your runs will be scheduled. Due to Covid 19 we can only allow a limited number of dogs and people on the premises. You will be asked to leave if you are not there at the appropriate time. When you have completed all of your runs you must leave the Red Barn Property. We truly appreciate your understanding.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

The Trial Secretary, Dara Murphy, is in full charge of the Trials. Trial precincts consist of the Red Barn property. Whistles, clickers, "squeaky" toys, flexis and prong collars are NOT permitted within 20 feet of any active agility ring and no food or toys within 10' of the ring gates. (Non squeaky toys are permitted in ring with judge approval for FFO runs). Bitches in season are NOT permitted anywhere on the trial precincts. Ring is grass covered. Ring enclosure is snow fencing & there will be gates that close on each ring. Ring dimensions are 100 ft x 100 ft. Handlers in all classes may walk the course without their dog prior to the start of their class. There will be NO obstacle familiarization. Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules & Regulations effective January 1st, 2020. The broad jump and wall jump will not be offered at this trial.

To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 months of age and eligible for a registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Misc. Certificate, TCN or a CKC Performance Event Number. Spayed bitches, debarked dogs and neutered males are eligible to compete. Mixed breed dogs may enter these trials with a CKC Canine Companion Number.

Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed, a Vet's certificate certifying the bitch was in season within a 10-day period preceding the trials must reach the trial secretary on or before the start of the first trial. A full refund of entry & listing fees will be given.

As of January 1, 2020, as per CKC regulations if a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3-day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The club will refund the entry minus the TCN fee and a \$10 administration fee.

Please note that senior handlers 65 an older or handlers with a disability can request a modified course time or point requirement as of Jan. 1 2020. Please ensure you check the box on the entry form to qualify for this if you wish.

No entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries, except as provided in the rules. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how and by whom the errors were made.

Foreign Exhibitors fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, in US funds. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated. Thank you.

COVID 19 modifications

Check in: When you arrive you must park one car distance from the next car. All competitors must crate from their car. Anyone with reactive dogs that bark in their car must park towards the back of the Red Barn property. Running order & courses will be emailed by PDF 1 hour prior to the trial starting. Download it before you come or you will need to have a smart phone with data as no WiFi is available. Course & running order will be posted so you can take a picture but we will not be handing out hard copies. Please do NOT crowd course area or entrance gate! Gate steward will use a microphone to call out names, so LISTEN!

Running Order: Standard & 2 JWW Novice runs, then all 3 Intermediate runs, then all 3 Excellent/Master Excellent runs.

Handlers will report to the Standard Ring upon arrival for judge briefing & walk through (this may be done in groups if we have too many handler's for one group). 5 minute walk through will take place in the Standard ring. No briefing will take place in Jumpers

ring. Standard ring will start running dogs after the Standard walk through is completed. The Jumpers ring will be open for walk throughs and supervised by that judge as soon as the Standard ring walk throughs are completed (it will not be timed). It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure they have walked the Jumpers course <u>at some point</u> while the Standard ring is running. There will be NO Jumpers briefing. The Jumpers ring will start running dogs as soon as the Standard ring is finished. We ask that all competitors help with changing the course before they leave for the day.

 Volunteers & Course building:
 All competitors are required to help out by changing the course when they are done (COVID 19 modification). We have volunteers coming to time/scribe, run leashes & set bars. Please thank them! If you can provide a volunteer, please email volunteer@redbarneventcentre.com

 You may put your leash in your pocket instead of having it moved by leash runner.


Results: Results will be posted immediately following each class and REMOVED from posting area when that level (Novice, Intermediate, Exc/Mst Excellent) is done. They will also sent to you by PDF as soon as the trial secretary has completed data entry and judge has double checked it. We hope to have this done at the very latest one hour after the trials are over. We are doing this so that people LEAVE when they are done running due to this unprecedented COVID 19 situation, thank you for your understanding.

Ribbons: You need to bring a labelled self-addressed stamped envelope with your name and your dog's name(s) place it in the ribbon envelope box located at the help station. We will not be handing out ribbons at this trial. **New title rosettes** will be offered at a cost of \$10.00 per rosette, exact change only &pick up before you leave.

Refunds

Anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date will receive a credit in the amount of 50% of their entry fees, excluding the online entry service charge if applicable) towards a future SPD CKC event held within twelve (12) months of this trial. In case of public health restrictions that prevent the event occurring a full credit will be provided to your account to be used within one year. No refunds will be issued. If you are sick or think you have come in contact with someone who has COVID 19, PLEASE email us and STAY HOME! We will determine trial credits on a case by case basis but at the very least you will get 50%.

We thank you for your understanding in maintaining minimum 6 foot social distancing during this event.

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27.(aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From Hwy 27: When traveling North on CR 27 you must turn left shortly after passing through the town of Thornton. Look for the 20th Sideroad on your left and then the 10th Line on your right, that's your cue to slow down. Then you will see a small sign on your right that shows you must turn left to stay on CR 27. Turn left on CR 27 and continue north. After passing Mapleview Dr. W. you will go down a big hill, the Red Barn is on your left at the bottom of the hill.
