ENTRY INFORMATION

PLEASE NOTE: This is a limited Trial. **Entries will close on Wednesday July 4, 2012 at 6:00pm** OR when the limit of 15 Stockdog runs.27 Arena sheep runs, & 6 HTT runs have been reached.

Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MAILED. EMAILED ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Are allowed to compete.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All dogs must be at least 6 months of age and registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate. CKC Miscellaneous Breeds cannot enter CKC events unless they have a Miscellaneous Number.

ENTRY FEES: - \$50.00 per dog for each Stockdog Class entered. \$45.00 per dog for each Arena Class or HTT entered.

FEO (For Exhibition Only) entries will be permitted provided regular trial entries do not fill the trial. FEO ENTRY FEE is \$40.00 per dog for each class entered.

Lunch will be provided fpr entrants.

ATTENTION US EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however; they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Please do no mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks and we will not accept them as an entry. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase a bank draft or money order payable in Canadian funds. All awards and Rosettes must be picked up on the day of the trial - none will be mailed.

RULES

- 1. We will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to dogs, exhibitors or property.
- 2. The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any trial held under CKC rules.
- 3. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward volunteer or competitor at the Herding Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 4. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs.
- 5. There is limited shade. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own shade, crates, etc.
- 6. Exhibitors must sign the waiver form (attached to this Premium List) before being allowed to compete.
- 7. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their dogs while they are on the trial grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates except when competing.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From Guelph: Go North on Hwy 6 for 20 km to Fergus. Follow signs through Fergus on Hwy 6. After crossing through the main street in Fergus and up a hill, turn Right at Garafraxa St. E. After 1.3 km, street becomes Wellington Road 19. Continue about 4.km. You will see a Fergus Golf Club sign on the right – at the end of the golf course, go South (turn right) onto Third Line. # 6498 (Woolagon Farm) is 2nd farm house on the right after the golf course.

FROM the NORTH (Orangeville): Going west on the 109/9, just past the light at the 25, there will be a sign to Belwood & Fergus. Turn south (left) onto Belwood Rd. and follow it for several kms until you reach a stopsign – turn left. This is still Belwood Rd., but it becomes Wellington Rd-19. Follow it past Belwood, past the campgrounds & Belwood Pines Restaurant on left, past WR-16 and the next left is Third Line. If you see golf courses you've gone too far! We are the 2nd farm on the right side, 6498 Third Line.
