The following CKC CONFORMATION classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; <u>champions in any country excluded</u>
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
Open	for all dogs.
Specials Only	for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
	The entry of a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or
	Parades if provided for in this premium list.
Exhibition Only	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog
3-6 months	in a Regular Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular classes or Parades</u> .

The following CKC OBEDIENCE classes will be provided:

Novice A for dogs who do not have a "C.D." Must be handled by owner or immediate family member.

- Novice B for dogs who do not have a "C.D." title in Canada. For trainers, multiple entries, or dogs who have earned titles in another country. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person.
- Open A for dogs who have earned the title "C.D." in Canada, but have not earned the title of "C.D.X.". Must be handled by owner or immediate family member.
- Open B for dogs who have earned the title "C.D." in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person.
- Utility for dogs who have earned the title "C.D.X." in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person.

The following CKC RALLY OBEDIENCE classes will be provided:

Rally Novice A Doos entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs that have earned titles or are not the owners may enter in the Novice B class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class has been earned. The owner or any Rally Novice B person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class is for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) title or any CKC Rally Advanced A Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Rally Advanced B This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. Upon completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title a dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any Rally Excellent A CKC Novice Obedience title. A dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class after official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title (RE). No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at any one trial. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judge off leash and the dog must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely. Any Rally Excellent B person is allowed to handle a dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

For information only: Rally Advanced Excellent title -- Upon completion of the Rally Excellent title, qualifying scores may be accumulated from Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B to earn the Rally Advanced Excellent (RAE) title. To receive the RAE title, a dog must qualify ten (10) times in both Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent at the same trial. The title will appear at the end of the dog's name and a numeric designation will indicate the number of times the dog has met the requirements, i.e. RAE2, RAE3, etc.

To be eligible to compete in these obedience or rally obedience trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only <u>providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show.</u> When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration</u> <u>Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$55.85 plus 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. - 2 The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. 3. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" - CKC rule book, Section 19.7.
- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disgualified, 5. excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON 6. after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- 7. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
- All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs. 8.
- SHOW PRECINCTS shall be the entire North & South Pavilions, Exhibition Park. 9.
- "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and 10. be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
