Listing Fee: The Listing Fee has been replaced by a **Temporary Competition Number (TCN)**

Temporary Competition Number (TCN): TCNs allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). Any dog of a CKC-recognized breed and not registered with CKC and entering CKC events is required to have a TCN.

- A TCN must be obtained **before** submitting an entry for an event.
- The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.
- There is no fee to obtain a TCN. However, exhibitors are now required to pay TCN fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number.
- TCN fee: \$10.00 + HST
- To obtain a TCN:
 - 1) Go to the CKC web site, click on forms, under Shows and Trials click Exhibitors. Find the Temporary-Competition-Number-Application Form. Complete the application form online and the TCN should be issued instantly; **or**
 - 2) You may print the application form and submit it to CKC via mail; or
 - 3) You may contact Shows and Trials Division by telephone (1-855-364-7252) toll free or email information@ckc.ca

Event Registration Number: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered with a TCN; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

Non Member Participation Fee for Canadian Dog Owners who are NOT already members of CKC: If your dog places and thus earns points, CKC will require you to either join CKC for \$54.00 or pay a non-member participation fee of \$170.00. CKC will notify you after the trial and allow you 30 days to pay or forfeit the points. This new fee applies to the owner (not the dog). You can run as many dogs as you want, and if none of them places, you don't have to pay. But every year that one of your dogs places you have to pay the fee. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Puppy Stake: "A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations*, 10. 2.1

Limit Stake: "A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial and have not placed in an All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations*, 10.3.1

Open All-Age Stake: "An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations*, 10. 4.1

Amateur All-Age Stake: "An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age, on the day of the trial at which the stake is being judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations*, 10. 5.

Points: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the All- Age Stake, provided that there are 12 or more starters:

1st place - 5 points 2nd Place - 3 points

3rd Place - 2 points

4th Place - 1 point

Indignities: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations*, 21. 7

The site is located at 5982 HWY 215 in the village of Kempt Shore.

Take Hwy 101 from Halifax. Take exit 4 (St Croix/Ellershouse) and merge onto Hwy-1. Proceed east on Hwy-1 for 3km and turn left on Hwy 215 (at the radio transmitters) to Brooklyn. Proceed along Hwy 215 approx. 25kms through Summerville to Kempt Shore. The site is on your right beside the Credit Union. If you see the sign for the West Hants Municipal Recreation Park go back about 200 meters
