BORDER TERRIER CANADA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

(Adapted With Permission From The Border Terrier Club Of America Room Policy)

Border Terrier Canada (BTC) has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future:

Any individual attending a Border Terrier Canada (BTC) sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTC Board of Directors.

- 1. May be banned from showing at the next BTC sanctioned event(s).
- 2. May be subject to CKC sanctions.
- 3. Membership in the BTC may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated. Damages shall be defined as:
- 1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
- 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3. Any verified complaint by a BTC member.

BTC Room Regulations:

- 1. All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
- 2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel or campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
- 3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible.
- 4. Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
- 5. All owners/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.

DIRECTIONS TO THE STRATFORD ONTARIO FESTIVAL INN

From Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal

Follow Highway 401 West to Interchange 278 at Kitchener.

Follow Highway 8 West through Kitchener onto Highway 7 & 8 to Stratford

Highway 7 & 8 becomes Ontario Street.

The Festival Inn is located at 1144 Ontario Street, near the intersection of Ontario Street and Road 111.

From Chicago, Detroit and Highway 401

Cross into Canada at Detroit/Windsor.

Follow Highway 401 East to Exit 222 **

Follow Road 6 North to Stratford.

Highway 6 becomes Highway 113 after it crosses Perth-Oxford Road.

Continue on Highway 113 North to Highway 7

Follow Highway 7 East

Highway 7 joins with Highway 8 and becomes Ontario Street.

The Festival Inn is located at 1144 Ontario Street, near the intersection

of Ontario Street and Road 111.

Alternatively: Take Exit 218 at Ingersoll instead of Exit 222.

Follow Highway 119 North through Ingersoll to Highway 7 East to Stratford

Highway 7 joins with Highway 8 and becomes Ontario Street.

The Festival Inn is located at 1144 Ontario Street, near the intersection of Ontario Street and Road 111.

From Port Huron

Cross into Canada at Port Huron/Sarnia and follow Highway 402 East to Interchange 65 at Stathroy.

Follow Highway 81 North for 3 kilometres (2 miles) to Country Road 19.

Head North to Ailsa Craig, then follow Highway 7 East to Stratford.

Highway 7 joins with Highway 8 and becomes Ontario Street.

The Festival Inn is located at 1144 Ontario Street, near the intersection of Ontario Street and Road 111.

From Buffalo and Queen Elizabeth Way

Enter Canada at Buff alo/Fort Erie.

Follow Queen Elizabeth Way (QEW) across the Burlington Skyway.

Take Exit 100 West onto Highway 403 West.

Take Highway 403 West to Highway 6 North to Highway 401, at the village of Morriston.

Proceed West on Highway 401.

Exit at Interchange 278 onto Highway 8 West to Kitchener.

Follow Highway 8 West to Highway 7 & 8 West to Stratford.

Highway 7 & 8 become Ontario Street.

The Festival Inn is located at 1144 Ontario Street, near the intersection of Ontario Street and Road 111.
