Listing Fees are payable with the entry fee for dogs that do not have their **Individual Registration Number** at closing date. **Full name and address of owner must be filled in and to whom the ID is to be sent.** A Litter Registration is not acceptable.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. However, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation are appreciated. Thank you.



All entries paid by credit card **MUST** be sent via The Entry Line. The SSKC does not accept credit cards for payment. It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & Regulations. Sent fax receipts and/or copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. All entries <u>must</u> be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper fees and submitted on an OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORM. If more forms are required, please photocopy. Include postal code and telephone number. Please type or print clearly.
- 2. Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted, and all "NSF" cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00. All fees must be paid before the show. The SSKC does not accept credit cards.
- 3. The SSKC reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how the error was made or who made it.
- 5. Any overpayment of fees will be considered a contribution to our trophy fund.
- 6. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trial Secretary after the closing time and date.

<u>ADVERTISING:</u> Full page: \$30.00. All copy must be ready for printing and received by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date.

PRIZES: Suitable prizes will be awarded each day for Best In Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Puppy In Show, Best In Group, Best Puppy In Group, Highest Qualifying Score In Trial, and Highest Qualifying Score in each Class, First in Class (Rally).

THE ARNOLD AND VERA CURRIE MEMORIAL TROPHY: A perpetual trophy, donated by the SSKC in memory of Arnold and Vera Currie, will be awarded for Best Of Breed – Rough Collie, on Saturday. This trophy remains with the SSKC with the winner's name engraved thereon. A keeper trophy will be given to the winner.

The Charles and Marjorie Larouche Memorial Trophy: A perpetual trophy, donated by the SSKC in memory of Charles and Marjorie Larouche, will be awarded to a Labrador Retriever or Beagle which attained the highest qualifying score in any official class in either Obedience Trial. In the event of a tie, the highest combined score will be taken. A keeper trophy will be given to the winner.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The building will be open at 8 a.m. with judging commencing at 9 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. **Friday set-up is from 6-8 p.m.**
- 2. Only dogs entered in the Shows and Trials will be allowed in the building.
- 3. Dogs will not be allowed in the building overnight.
- 4. Prong or Spike collars will not be permitted at this venue.
- 5. Judging will proceed without any dog that is not present when called by the Ring Steward. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers should judging times conflict.
- All Group judging will begin on completion of Breed judging within each group. Best In Show, Best Puppy In Show, and Reserve Best In Show will follow all Group judging. Reserve Best In Show will immediately follow Best In Show.
- 7. The Superintendent will be in full charge of the Shows and Trials.

- 8. To accommodate ALL exhibitors, <u>the SSKC reserves the right to limit set-up space, size,</u> <u>and location of crates and exercise pens.</u> Your co-operation is greatly appreciated.
- 9. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular Official Classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.
- 10. The SSKC will use all due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of, an accident or any misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons and will not be responsible for equipment left on premises.
- 11. The SSKC greatly appreciates your co-operation in cleaning up after your dogs.
- 12. Canteen facilities will be available.
- 13. Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events. A copy of these Rules is available from the Canadian Kennel Club.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy	A dog 3 months up to 6 months on the day of the show (does not compete for points)
Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	A dog that was born in Canada
Bred By Exhibitor	A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class	A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only	Dogs that are Canadian Champions
Exhibition Only	Dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B (Pre-Novice, Novice C and Novice Intermediate) SEPARATE ENTRIES ARE REQUIRED FOR EACH CLASS ENTERED. State Jump Heights

Pre-Novice	For all purebred dogs over 6 months of age (not eligible for H.I.T Competition)
"A" Classes	For dogs handled by owner or immediate family members through all exercises
"B" Classes	For trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Cdn. OTCH degree
	or dogs that have earned titles in another country
"C" Classes	For dogs that have completed a C>D> title in Canada (not eligible for H.I.T
	Competition)
C.D.I. Class	Novice Intermediate, for dogs that have earned a C.D. title in Canada (not
	eligible for H.I.T. Competition)
Open	For dogs that have earne4d a C.D. in Canada
Utility A	For dogs that have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D. in Canada
Utility B	For dogs that have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada
Exhibition Only	For dogs 6 months and over, not in competition

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms.

Novice A	For dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and are handled by
	the owner or an immediate family member
Novice B	For any dog until such time as a qualifying score in Advanced is earned
Advanced A	For dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and handled
	by the owner or an immediate family member
Advanced B	For any dog that has earned the RN title

Excellent A	For dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and are
	handled by the owner or an immediate family member
Excellent B	For any dog that has earned the RA title

A bitch in season may NOT compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian's Certificate BEFORE commencement of the Trial.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs which are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership: for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed"; however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

A dog awarded Winners which also places Best In Show at an All Breed Conformation Show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the Breed and Group level. A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.
