Coming from Kingston? Hwy 38 / Gardiners Road: Big Sky is approximately 15 minutes from Hwy 401. Follow 38 north and turn left at Yarker Road. Take first Left onto Henderson Road. Take first left onto Florida Road. Drive approximately 5 minutes down Florida Rd. It is a private property on the left side at 4445 Florida Rd.

Coming from Hwy 401? Exit 599 County Rd 6 / Wilton Road: Big Sky is less than 10 minutes from Hwy 401. Follow County Rd 6 north to the flashing light at Simmons Rd. Turn Right. Proceed through the village of Wilton. Continue along Simmons Road. It ends at Florida Road. Turn Right. The property is on the right side at 4445 Florida Road.

Obstacles: Agility obstacles meet the requirements of the CKC Agility Rules

Note: A-Frame, Dogwalk, Teeter and Table have rubber surfaces and the tire is a breakaway self-healing type.

Entry Fees (Canadian Funds)

This is a privately owned business that charges a fee for its service.

All particulars called for on the entry form must be complete. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dog(s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full entry fees. The K&DKC cannot accept fax or phone entries and reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules. If because of riots, civil disturbances or acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Listing Fees A CKC TCN fee of \$11.30 per dog per trial is payable with the entry fee if the entry of the dog does not include a CKC individual Registration number, PEN (Performance Event Number), ERN (Event Registration Number), MCN. (Miscellaneous Certificate Number) or a CCN (Canine Companion Number). The CKC receives this entire fee.

Eligibility: To compete in this trial, a dog must be at least 18 months of age and registered with the CKC or eligible for registration with the CKC, or have a PEN, ERN, or MCN. In addition, mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds with a CCN may compete. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in the trial, however, entry and listing fees will be returned, providing a veterinarian's certificate stating that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial is submitted to the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial.

"It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred". (4.1.3 t)

Awards and Prizes: (for qualifying scores, only)

Ribbons: Rosettes will be offered for all first places in each jump height in each class and flat ribbons will be awarded for 2nd, 3rd and 4th places as well as for all qualifying scores.

Rosettes will also be offered for any new title earned at this trial.

Precincts of the trial: All grounds within 100' of the ring area or the fenced area of the grounds, whichever is less, shall be considered the trial grounds. Any equipment such as pop-up tents or other personal structures must not be closer than 10 feet from the rings.

Course Familiarization: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class. There will be a 5 minute break between the end of the walk-through and the first dog on the line.

Warm-up jump(s) will be provided in proximity to the ring area.

Move-up option: Dogs if eligible may be moved up to the next class between days by filling in the required move-up form and presenting it to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. ONLY if there are 30 minutes scheduled between consecutive trials will move-ups be permitted **between** trials on the same day.

Exhibitor Information: Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations Effective Jan. 2023, a copy of which may be obtained by calling the Central Order Desk of CKC at 1-800-250-8040

Check-in each day will start at 8:00 a.m.

Trial start time each day 9:00 a.m.

Equipment familiarizations: There will be supervised contact equipment familiarization for Novice Dogs only immediately before the first Novice standard class of each day.

Food: Bring your own food and beverages.

Classes Offered

Regular Selected Veterans

Standard, Points and Distance, Jumps and Tunnels and Jumpers with Weaves

The owner may choose to enter the Selected Category in lieu of entering the Regular Category at any trial. The dog must be entered only in Selected Category or in Regular Classes and may not move back and forth between the Selected Classes and the Regular Classes in the same trial, or associated group of trials. Once a dog is entered in the Selected Classes, the dog may go back to compete in the Regular Classes in a different trial.

Dogs moving into the Selected class move laterally, and may choose to take any legs they have earned in the Regular classes with them.

Veterans Class: A dog 7 years or older may be entered in the Veterans class. The dog will retain its titles and qualifying scores previously earned but may not revert back to the Regular or Selected Classes once it has run in the Veterans class.

Novice class is open to dogs that have not acquired an intermediate leg (qualifying score) in the class entered.

Intermediate class is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title in the class entered.

Excellent class is for dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in the class entered.

Master Excellent class is for dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title in the class entered.

Height Divisions

Handlers are responsible for entering the correct height division. The judge may request any dog be measured. Selected Class dogs will jump one height lower than the equivalent regular class height shown in the table below and dogs who measure 11" or below will jump 4" in the Selected or Veteran Class. All other Veteran dogs may jump one or two heights lower than the regular class height.

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all regular classes:

8 inches for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers

12 inches for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers


16 inches for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers

20 inches for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers

24 inches for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of these agility trials and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the agility trial premise or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these agility trials, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused.

HEALTH REMINDERS: No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

EVEN THOUGH MASK MANDATES MAY NOT BE IN PLACE, THE K&DKC RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ASK THAT MASKS BE WORN WHILE ON THE TRIAL SITE AND DURING THE WALK THROUGH. This will not be necessary while running your dog.

SOCIAL DISTANCING OF 2 METRES (6 FT) BETWEEN INDIVIDUALS IS SUGGESTED.

CRATING SHOULD BE IN YOUR CAR. SOME POP-UP TENTS MAY BE ALLOWED. Only the Judge, Trial Secretary, and Chairperson have access to the TRAINING BUILDING. If you need to speak to any of these individuals, please see them outside at a safe distance. Unfortunately, indoor crating is not available (Above mentioned authorized persons excepted). All dogs must be kept in an x-pen, crate or on leash when not in the ring

NO FOOD IS ON SITE. - PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN BEVERAGE, FOOD, SNACKS AND WATER FOR YOUR DOG.

SANITIZE YOUR HANDS AS MUCH AS APPROPRIATE

PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG AND USE THE DESIGNATED POOP CANS FOR DISPOSAL STAY IN YOUR SAFE BUBBLE AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE
