We will be allowing Bitches in Season to compete at this event.

First Dog on the line at 6:00 pm sharp Friday and 9:00 am Saturday/Sunday!

Confirmations will be emailed. We reserve the right to cancel the trial at any time up to and including the day of, if any conditions are present that would deem it unsafe to go ahead. In which case full refunds will be provided to all entrants.

REFUNDS – because this event is strictly limited, refunds will only be issued for trial cancelation, or medical / veterinary reasons.

Dogs must have an AAC ID card to compete at this trial

Measuring - If your dog is under 2 years old or has not had their first measurement, you must have your dog measured. Limited measuring will be available on Friday at 5:30 pm, and Saturday/Sunday at 8:30 am. In order to limit unnecessary contact and to eliminate the need for measuring at every trial, judges will provide a one-time measure for dogs under 2 years. A temporary measurement card will be e-mailed to the handler to be used during this time. Dogs under 2 years of age may compete with their temporary card until they reach 2 years of age, at which point they will require an official measurement. Judges will resume signing Dog ID cards for dogs 2 years and older. Dogs over 2 years of age must be measured until they have their final height circled on their ID card.

Volunteering – All competitors are expected to volunteer. We will have a volunteer prize draw. Each event requires a 1 timer, 1 scribe, multiple course builders, multiple ring crew.

Benching – Competitors are expected to bench dogs in their vehicles and remain outside of the building between runs (unless volunteering)

Move ups – we will do our best to accommodate move ups during the trial.

Ribbons – Ribbons will be awarded for placements 1st through 4th and there are ribbons for ADC, AADC, MADC, SGDC, AGDC, MGDC & ATChC. We will also have ribbons for other titles. As we are just starting up... If you are close to earning a title, please let us know in advance what you are hoping to achieve so we can make sure we have a ribbon available for you. If you do not take ribbons, you will receive an entry to a prize draw.

IT IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

- You must not attend the trial if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or feeling unwell, have been in contact with someone that has the virus. You will be asked to leave the trial site immediately if you are visibly unwell.
- Always maintain a minimum 2 meters distance from other individuals: be respectful of other peoples' bubbles!
- Be mindful: avoid unnecessary or inadvertent touching of equipment on course or surfaces anywhere on the trial site.
- Bring an adequate supply of masks, gloves, and disinfectant for your personal use during the trial
- Anticipate that many of the usual routines we have come to expect at trials are changing. Be gracious and kind in adapting to the 'new normal' of agility trialing. Without changes we will be unable to continue with any trials.
- Remind one another to adhere to the protocols and measures that are in place at this
 trial to ensure everyone is safe. This is a shared responsibility. Recognize that people
 may inadvertently slip up and offer a gentle, kind reminder.
- If an individual consistently disregards the guidelines, whether inadvertently or intentionally, it is everyone's responsibility to make sure unsafe behaviour is not permitted to continue, since it places everyone at risk. Individuals not complying with the trial protocols and measures may be asked to leave the trial.
- Respect the neighbours: control barking, & be courteous if walking on the road.
- Bitches in season are allowed at this event. We recommend panties be worn in between events.
- Read the entry form and the confirmation... they contain actual information.
