GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION:

- All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- To comply with instructions issued by the Canine Federation of Canada we will be unable to accept, cancel, or substitute an entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing date.
- All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
- It is your responsibility to verify the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.
- Refunds will not be given for anyone double entering the same dog.
- No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by full entry fees. NO post-dated cheques.
- Handlers and agents please note the full address of all owners must be filled in.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited except for moving to champions class.
- All entries will be charged non – member prices without proof of membership, where applicable.
- The Canine Assn. Of N.S. reserves the right to refuse any entries, subject to CFC rules.

- The Show precincts will be the building and its entrances. No un-entered dogs will be allowed within the precincts of the show.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, governed by CFC rules.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the controls of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- The Canine Assn. Of N.S. will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortunes, however caused.
- Neither the Agri Dome, Canine Assn. Of N.S. or any associates accept any responsibility for loss by any means

SHOW ETIQUETTE

Any exhibitor who allows their dog to defecate or urinate inside or outside the building other than in the designated Exercise Area without immediately cleaning up or arranging for a clean up may not be permitted to exhibit at future shows or trials held by this club.

Please co-operate in keeping these grounds tidy.

PLEASE ABIDE BY THE NO SMOKING RULES OF THE BUILDING.

AROUND AND NEAR THE RINGS

Every effort will be made to accommodate our exhibitors. Should there be a judging conflict; the exhibitor shall be responsible for advising with Ring Steward at ring side his/her conflict. Exhibitors are requested to keep the grooming area and crating areas clean and tidy. Dogs not being exhibited or groomed must be crated. If space is at a premium, at the request of the C.A.N.S., exhibitors will be asked to remove private exercise pens, if needed.

- Excessive aggression will not be tolerated. You will be asked to leave the show grounds and entry fees will not be refunded.
- PRONG COLLARS are not permitted in the show ring, nor will flexi leads be allowed on the show site at any time.
- EACH PERSON will be responsible for their dog's behavior and proper clean-up of their dog's droppings. The show committee will strictly enforce this rule. Anyone that has been warned more than once will be asked to leave the show site and the entry fee will not be refunded.

PRIZES AND ROSETTES

The Canine Assn. Of N.S. will offer rosettes & prizes for Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show & Best of the Best. Rosettes will be awarded for Best of Breed, Best Puppy in Breed & All Group Placements

A veterinarian will be on call should one be required.

CLASSES AVAILABLE (FOR BOTH SEXES)

Entering a dog in more than one class is prohibited.

- This show will be organized in accordance with the regulations of the CFC (Canine Federation of Canada), along with the standards of the FCI (Fédération Cynologique Internationale), The dogs will be judged in the following classes :
- **Elementary Puppy Class** : Shall be for dogs at least 3 months of age and under 6 months on the first day of the show. This class does not qualify for a Rating. The judge simply formulates an appreciation on the dog (by descending order: very promising, promising, rather promising, insufficient). It does not give place to a classification.
- **Puppy Class** : Shall be for dogs at least **6 months of age and under 9 months** on the first days of the show. This class does not qualify for a Rating. The judge simply formulates an appreciation on the dog (by descending order: very promising, promising, rather promising, insufficient). It does not give place to a classification.
- **The BEST of the BREED PUPPY**: shall be selected from the best of the Elementary Puppy class and the best of the Puppy class.
- **Junior Class** : Shall be for dogs at least **9 months of age and under 18 months** on the day of the show entered. This class qualifies for a Rating of EXCELLENT but does not give a CACStowar a championship. Winning Junior male & winning Junior female will compete for the Best Junior. The Best Junior will be given a crd to entitle it to compete in the Best of Breed class. Should the best Junior win they will not receive a CACS toward a championship.

- **Working Class**: All purebred dogs over the age of 15 months which are obliged to present a copy of their working certificate attached with the entry form. This class qualifies for a Rating of Excellent and a CACS in competition with Intermediate class and the Open class.
 - **Intermediate Class**: For dogs at least **15 months of age and under 24 months** on the first day of the show entered. This class qualifies for a Rating of Excellent and a CACS in competition with the Working class and Open class.
 - **Open Class**: For dogs **over 15 months** of age on the day of the show entered. This class qualifies for a Rating of Excellent and a CACS in competition with the Working class and Intermediate class.
 - **CHAMPION CLASS**: For all dogs, which have obtained the title of CFC Champion. *Please include photocopy of the CH certificate along with your entry form.* Without the proof of this Champion title the dog will be entered in the open class. Enrolment is permitted in one class only per show.
 - **Veteran Class** : For all dogs 8 calendar years of age. This class does not qualify to compete with other classes and does not qualify for a CACS
 - **Qualification for a CACS**: For each breed, one CACS will be given per sex (male & female). A first place dog or bitch of the following classes : Working, Intermediate and Open will compete for the award of CACS.
 - **Qualification for a CACSC**: For each breed, one CACSC will be given per sex (male & female) for the Champion Class only.
 - A first place dog or bitch must receive a rating of EXCELLENT to be eligible to compete at the breed level.
- BEST OF BREED**: a maximum of 5 dogs will be selected from the **Best Junior, the male and the female awarded CACS from the following classes: Working, Intermediate, Open and the 1st placed Champion male and female.** The Best of Breed Adult and Best of Breed Puppy will then proceed onto compete at group level, if 1st placement is awarded, they then compete in: **BEST IN SHOW PUPPY OR BEST IN SHOW**

BEST OF THE BEST - All 4 Best in Show Winners will compete for the Best of the Best under the 4 judges.

The winner will also be presented with the Eukanuba Cup of Excellence. A keeper trophy will be provided to the winner.

MOVING A DOG TO THE CHAMPIONS CLASS

A dog which has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the rules of the CFC/FCC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Champions Class", providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING by the owner or handler at least one (1) hour prior to the first scheduled judging time of the show, you are moving classes in.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to "Champions" must be made at least one (1) hour prior to the first scheduled judging time of the show affected.

Please note that this rule is effective up to one (1) hour prior to the first scheduled judging time of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

RULES FOR OBTAINING A CANINE FEDERATION OF CANADA CHAMPIONSHIP

I. CFC Championship can be obtained for dogs who receive 3 CACS (Certificate of aptitude for the championship of conformity to the standard) and a rating of EXCELLENT given from 3 different judges. All dogs over the age of **15 months** are eligible for a full CFC championship and whose breed is fully recognized by the Canine Federation of Canada or by the Federation Cynologique Internationale (F.C.I.).

II. CACS: One CACS per breed and per sex (male and female) will be giving. The following classes will compete for the CACS : Working, Intermediate and Open.

III. A CFC Champion can become an Elite Champion if he/she compete in the Champion class. To get the title Elite Champion, he has to receive 4 CACSC from 4 different judges. The title of Elite Champion will be sent as soon as the dog will receive the forth CACSC and the owner notifies the CFC.

IV. A CACSC are given at the judges discretion to the best male and the best female of the Champion Class.

V. You must notify the CFC when your dog has attained all of the requirements, which qualifies your dog as a Canadian CFC Champion. You must follow all the rules and regulations to receive your championship certificate. No dog will be officially a Canadian CFC Champion until the certificate of championship is issued. You must send a photocopy of your dog's CACS along with a cheque of 10\$.

VI. You must notify the CFC when your dog has attained all of the requirements, which qualifies your dog as a Canadian CFC **ELITE** Champion. You must follow all the rules and regulations to receive your **ELITE** championship certificate. No dog will be officially a Canadian CFC **ELITE** Champion until the certificate of championship is issued. You must send a photocopy of your dog's CACSC along with a cheque of 10\$.

VII. Junior Championship title: A Junior can obtained a CH title when he/she has accumulated 3 BJ (Best Junior) card with the rating of Excellent – You must notify the CFC and present proof (a photocopy) of your dog's 3 BJ card along with a cheque of 10\$. A Junior Champion **cannot qualify to compete in the Champion class** (adulte).

VIII. A dog must have a certified pedigree with at least three (3) generations, issued by an organization recognized by the Canine Federation of Canada, by all countries members of the Federation Cynologique Interntionale (F.C.I.) The Kennel Club (England), The United Kennel club, AKC or CKC.

FOR BREEDS RECOGNIZED BY THE FEDERAL CYNOLOGIQUE INTERNATIONAL (FCI), THE APPROVED BREED STANDARDS FOR THE ORGANIZATION WILL BE USED FOR THE CFC SHOWS.
