# ATLANTIC LABRADOR RETRIEVER CLUB

No post-dated cheques accepted. A post-dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trial. Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes-It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules and Regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or copies of sent emails will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

# **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being

cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN) - \* Effective March 2, 2020 A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN. TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. Dogs may still enter CKC events without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account. \* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

**REFUND POLICY:** If, because of an act of God, riot or civil disobedience, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations or decree or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the ALRC, and it is impossible to open or complete the Shows, no refund of entry fees will be made. Please see DogShow.ca for their service fee policy.

# **REGULAR CLASSES**

Veterans class will be divided into three classes (7-9 years, 9-11 years, And 11 years & up)

**Note:** Award of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the Maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

**Field Dog:** This class is optional at specialty shows for breeds that have Participated in performance events in the field. Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging and the winners in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

# NON-REGULAR CLASSES JUDGING AFTER BEST OF BREED

Dogs entered in Non-Regular classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Baby Puppy - shall be for puppies 4-6 Months of age

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Generations Class – shall be for Sire or Dam with two generations of get.

Gun Dog Class – shall be for any dog that has attained a Working, Hunting or Field Title or placement.

Costume Class – shall be for any dog wearing a costume

Brace – shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex). A Brace must be Handled by one handler with one lead.

Altered Male Class - All sexually altered males, regardless of age will be judged together

Altered Female Class - All sexually altered females, regardless of age will be judged together.

The winner of these two divisions competes for Best Altered

**Competition for Sexually altered Dogs** These classes will be offered to all spayed and neutered dogs over six months of age, to compete for Best Altered Male, Best Altered Female and Best Altered in Breed. Judging will take place after Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

**Note: All Non-Regular Classes** will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please Be sure to mark non-regular classes on your regular Entry form.

# **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES**

\*\*\*We will be offering a breeder/owner/handler sweep award separately if the

winner of Best in Sweeps is not the breeder/owner/handler.

To qualify you must be the B/O/H as of July 1 2024 and MUST remain on the dog from start to finish. Be sure to check off box when entering sweeps.

**Puppy Sweepstakes** shall be for any dog 4 months up to but not Including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only.

There will be eight classes, divided by sex.

**Baby Puppy**-for Labradors at least 4 months of age, up to but not including 6 Months.

**Junior Puppy**-for Labradors at least 6 months of age, up to but not including 9 months.

**Senior Puppy**-for Labradors at least 9 months of age, up to but not including 12 months.

**12-18 Month**-for Labradors at least 12 months of age, up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as Best in Sweeps and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweeps and if eligible, Breeder/Owner Handler in Sweeps.

# **VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES**

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes, divided by sex.

7 up to 9 years-for Labradors at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years 9 up to 11 years-for Labradors at least 9 years of age up to but not including 11 years

11 years of age plus-for Labradors 11 years of age and older

For Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes, the class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% remaining of the entry fees will be awarded to the class winner

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best of Opposite Sex in Sweeps 25% will be retained for administrative purposes

# NON-PUREBRED DOGS IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS

Non-purebred dogs will be accepted in both Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials. If entering your non-purebred dog in either of these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number. Please theth the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.34 (found on line at the CKC website) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN.

This award will be presented on Friday at the ALRC trials. This award is graciously donated by Imelda McDonald, Tony Moores and Esther Cox who were dear friends of Shawn.

HIGH IN TRIAL SPECIAL AWARD – The Atlantic Labrador Retriever Club will be presenting to Saturday's HIT a special award in memory of Shawn Kelly. Shawn was a well loved member of our dog community. He was often a Judge at our events, and was in fact scheduled to judge at these trials. Sadly and unexpectedly Shawn passed away this year. A special donation was given to our club and we decided that we would give back and present this one time award. The presentation will be in the big ring (conformation) and will be presented by Shawn's wife, Patty Kelly.

# LRCC NATIONAL VERSATILITY CHALLENGE

Donated by Jim Girvin and Tracey Griffin of Cedarbrae Labradors to recognize the outstanding versatility inherent in our breed, a trait that Cedarbrae has worked to emulate in their dogs. This will be an annual trophy offered by the LRCC at the National Specialty. Points are awarded for prior accomplishment as demonstrated by achievement of CKC titles as well as for demonstrated versatility at the Specialty. A dog must enter three events at the specialty (Conformation, Obedience and Working Certificate Test). For conformation a dog must be entered in a class where they compete for Best in Specialty (Exhibition Only classes excluded). For a

# **CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

Champion & Championship Points-Chapter 1 Section 1-A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder: Section 2:

The system provides for additional points if the dog awarded WINNERS also places in the Group.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dog in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed,** 

excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation of Championship Points.

# **CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS**

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with the CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- \*The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- \* The ALRC will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators. The ALRC and property owners will not be responsible for any equipment left on the event premises.
- \* No additional cover will be provided in the case of inclement weather.
- \* The ALRC, Show Committee and Property Owners will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- \*The precincts of the show shall be the fenced area of the rings and 3 feet surrounding the rings.
- \* Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have their dog in the ring when required.
- \* "Puppy/Dog for sale" signs will not be permitted within the precincts of the event.
- \* It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to clean up after their dogs at all times and in all areas. Please make sure your area inside and outside is clean and all garbage is is placed into the appropriate receptacle before you leave.
- \*Proper footwear must be worn in the ring. No sandals, flip flops, bare feet.
- \* Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their class (allowing for absentees)
- \* EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. RULE BOOKLETS FOR ALL EVENTS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C. IN PRINT AND ONLINE AT CKC.CA

ONLY an electronic version of the catalog will be provided to your email address on file with Dogshow.ca unless you specifically order a hard copy. No extra copies will be available at the show site. Electronic copies will be available 1 hour prior to start time.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

# \*\*\*\*\*EXHIBITOR BAGS\*\*\*\*
