## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Saturday July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016 - during the lunch break

Held under CKC Rules.

Classes Offered: Pee Wee (non-competitive) / Junior Novice / Intermediate Novice / Senior Novice / Junior Open Intermediate Open / Senior Open.

Age Structure: Pee Wee (4-6 years), Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

Entry Fee: \$2.00 payable at registration. Entries will be taken Saturday, 10:00 - 11:00 AM. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day. The dog need not be owned by the Junior Handler. The MHCA will be offering suitable prizes for all participating in Junior Handling.

Held under CKC Rules.

Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day. The MHCA will be offering a rosette for the Best Overall Junior Handler

**\*\*Please Note:** Effective Jan. 1, 2016 - Section 3.4.1 "All Junior Handlers with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

## CLASSIFICATIONS

The following **CKC CONFORMATION** classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; <u>champions in any country excluded</u>
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
Open	for all dogs.
Specials Only	for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration, ERN or MSC number must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
Exhibition Only 3 – 6 Months	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in <u>Exhibition Only 3-6 Months</u> provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog

**NOTE:** There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all NSF cheques and credit card declines. Tendering of an NSF cheque or declined credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the CKC. The Show Secretary will not accept any entry from an exhibitor known to have tendered dishonored cheques or declined credit cards. Post-dated cheques for after the closing date are not acceptable and will be returned. Telephone entries (excluding electronic entries) are prohibited.

**Attention US Exhibitors:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

## CKC SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

### CHAPTER 4.1.3 – JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

### CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

<b>Competing*</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>3 – 5</b>	<b>6 – 9</b>	<b>10 – 12</b>	<b>13 or more</b>
Points	1	2	3	4	5
* includes the dog awarded Winners					

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

### **RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS**

1. The Medicine Canine Association will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be held responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
2. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
3. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.
4. Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour prior to the judging of their breed.
5. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
6. The Club reserves the right to remove any person/dog from the show.
7. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the Show.
8. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
9. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself.
10. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.

#### **Additional Show Information**

11. Group judging will follow breed judging through to BIS whenever possible. No two groups will be judged simultaneously. Should a conflict arise, the Chief Ring Steward shall determine which Group will be judged first.
12. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the rings.
13. **Exhibitors MUST pick up after their dogs. Any exhibitor not picking up after their dog shall be excused from the show by the Show Superintendent.**
14. **All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their sink drains.** Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the Health Department and may be subject to a fine.
