I (we) agree that the Northern Alberta Canine Association has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association and associated Specialty Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries will not be accepted.
3. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone but **MUST BE FOLLOWED UP IN WRITING** to the Show Secretary so as to be received by entry closing date. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
4. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or cancelled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
5. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be sent to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's address.
6. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR SPECIALTY CLASSES:

The following classes will be divided by sex:

JUNIOR PUPPY – dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show

SENIOR PUPPY – dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show

12-18 MONTHS – dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show

CANADIAN BRED – dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – for all dogs

VETERAN CLASS – for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs will compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs competing in the Veteran Class **may be spayed/neutered**.

SPECIALS ONLY – dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:

BABY PUPPY (3-6 Months) – dogs between 3 mths & under 6 mths on day of show

Exhibition Only: Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.

Exhibition Only 3-6mths – catalogue listing only

(dogs in the following classes must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only)

Sire & Get: for a stud dog and 2 or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.

Dam & Progeny: for a dam and 2 or more of her progeny. Same rules as Sire & Get.

Brace: for 2 Golden Retrievers not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Judged as an identical pair and handled by one person on one lead.

Gun Dog: For dogs who possess a CKC/GRCA Working Certificate title, or a CKC/AKC Hunt test or Licensed Field Trial title.

NOTICE TO U.S. EXHIBITORS RE: ERN NUMBERS

Dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or Visa/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$62.40 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. Provide your complete address for return of the ERN. This Event Registration Number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Please forward your request to: The Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials Division, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite #400 Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9.

PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES BY U.S. EXHIBITORS: Current exchange rate favors the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they must be payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do not mark personal cheques payable in Canadian funds, or 'at par' as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated!

BORDER CROSSING: A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this certificate and it MUST be updated at least thirty days prior to re-entry into the U.S.
