Junior Handling Conformation will be held **on Saturday, June 4 and Sunday, June 5, 2022.** (Times will be listed in the Judging Schedule. Entry forms will be available at the show secretary's desk and must be submitted at least one hour before the start of the junior handling competition. All dogs used for junior handling must be entered in a regular official class (can be exhibition only) at the show on Saturday and Sunday. **The dog must be entered** in the show by entry close date May 20, 2022. The fee is \$5.00 for each day of competition. Junior Handling competition classes are listed on the entry forms available at the Secretary's Desk.



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.

* A ten percent service fee applies to credit card entries through the entry service

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- The show secretary is unable to accept or cancel entries after the specified closing date/time.
- Tendering of a NSF cheque as payment of entry fees shall be considered to be a non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
- Entrants must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made except as outlined in the Conformation/Obedience and Rally Show Rules. The show secretary **will not** be responsible for checking the accuracy of entries. Errors should be brought to the attention of the show secretary.
- Substitution or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving class dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
- The show committee reserves the right to refuse entries subject to CKC rules.
- In the case of non-acceptance of an entry, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance.
- Telephone, facsimile, and e-mail entries are prohibited except in such circumstances as the CKC may otherwise authorize.
- Please **use separate entry forms for conformation and obedience**. If copying the entry forms, they must be the same size as the original.
- The address section of the entry forms should be completed for every entry to facilitate the speedy mailing of the judging schedule and receipts.
- If you wish your entry to be acknowledged, please include your email address.
- The entry form must be completed in full. An incomplete entry form must be rejected by the show-giving club and returned to the designated owner or agent.
- Every dog entered in a championship show except those breeds designated by the board, as being eligible to compete in the miscellaneous class, must be registered or eligible for registration in the studbook of the CKC.
- **No dog under the age of six (6) months is permitted within the precincts of the show, except, preregistered puppies 4-6 months of age that are with the owner who has other dog (s) entered in regular classes of the show. These puppies will not be listed in the catalogue but must be pre-registered by the owner at or before the closing date and time of entries. There is also a 4-6 month Baby Puppy competition at these shows in Show 1 and Show 3. Baby Puppies must be entered by entry form and will be listed in Catalogue. No listing fee apply to the Baby Puppy entry. BABY PUPPIES MUST HAVE A TCN**
- The authorities of the shows may decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of viciousness or disease.

No one shall have any claim or recourse against the organization holding the show or any official connected therewith for the refusal of an entry.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only" providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the show secretary **in writing** at least one hour prior to the BREED JUDGING of the show, by the owner or handler. Please note that A DOG WITH A TCN IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE MOVED TO SPECIALS ONLY.

THIS IS A SELF-CLEAN SHOW

All exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs whether **in or out** of the rings. Cleaning products will be available at ringside. If your dog soils the ring throughout judging, our ring stewards will gladly hold your dog while you clean up. Poop Bags will be available at ringside and at the show secretary table as well as the entrance table near the front door. All exhibitors are also expected to clean up after your dog outside to ensure the grounds are left in proper condition for those who use the arena after our shows have concluded.

FLOOR CARE

It is imperative that the floor be protected from products and urine. Please use plastic beneath your floor covering to protect against floor damage. The use of silicone-based products and powders are discouraged. If you used such foreign substances on your dog, your entire set-up floor area must be totally covered. Duct tape and other such adhesives are **NOT** to be used on the floors. Painter's tape is acceptable however if the tape or products that you use result in damage to the floor or create a hazard for the next tenant, the Landlord will require that you pay for the clean-up. The Avalon Kennel Club is not club is not assuming liability. Be advised that it is very expensive to have the products removed from the floor by the Landlord staff.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

ALL DOGS ENTERED MUST AT LEAST HAVE A TCN. All dogs that are foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering a CKC event requires an Event Registration Number (ERN). The (ERN) does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes but enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards, or scores to avoid cancellation. ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par". The banks will not clear them. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds.

NON MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Policy: FORMS AVAILABLE AT SHOW SECRETARY'S DESK

- a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.
- c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

INFORMATION:

- > A non-member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.
- > There are 2 options for non-members:
 - a) Join the CKC
 - b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

GENERAL INFORMATION

- o On the day of the show, the show superintendent will be in complete charge of the show which is to be governed by CKC Rules and Regulations
- o Only dogs properly entered in the show will be admitted.
- o The building will be opened 1 (one) hour before the start of the show.
- o Dogs may be removed from the building when not required for further judging.
- o Dogs **must not** be left in the building overnight.
- o Dogs and their handlers should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused from each show when not required for further judging.
- o **It is the responsibility of the exhibitors/handlers to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs is not possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds' conflict. Judging will proceed without any dog not present when called by the ring steward.**
- o The show committee and the Avalon Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and the exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortunes to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- o There are no security services provided at the venue, therefore, property left at the show grounds is done so at the owner's risk.
- o If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- o We regret that trailer hook ups **will not** be available at the show site. **If you wish to enquire of hotels that host dogs, please contact the Show Secretary for assistance.**
- o **It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities.** The Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation. The Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- o The show grounds are defined as the confines of The Common's, 8 Kinsmen's Place, Torbay.

COVID STATEMENT

AT THE TIME OF THE PUBLICATION OF THIS PREMIUM LIST, THERE ARE NO PROVINCIAL OR FEDERAL COVID-19 RULES IN PLACE. DUE TO THE FACT THAT COVID-19 IS STILL VERY PREVALENT IN THIS PROVINCE, AVALON KENNEL CLUB IS PLAYING IT SAFE AND ENFORCING THE WEARING BY ALL ENTRANTS INTO THE SHOWS/TRIALS VENUE (THE COMMON'S) OF A MASK TO PROTECT THEMSELVES AND OTHERS FROM THE COVID-19 VIRUS. JUDGES AND OFFICIALS WILL ALSO BE WEARING MASKS, UNLESS PROHIBITED BY THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CKC IN PERFORMANCE SPORTS. WE WILL ALSO TRY TO MAKE ADEQUATE SPACE FOR THE EXIBITORS FOR THEIR SET UP AREA. AN ALTERNATE ROOM WILL ALSO BE AVAILABLE FOR SET UP. THERE APPEARS TO BE ADEQUATE ELECTRICAL PLUGS IN EACH AREA FOR EXHIBITOR USEAGE. WE WOULD ALSO, IN AN EFFORT TO KEEP US SAFE FROM COVID-19 ENCOURAGE FREQUENT HAND WASHING. AS THINGS COULD CHANGE DRASTICALLY AND QUICKLY, WE WILL TRY TO KEEP ANY UPDATED COVID RULES OR IF THE SHOW/TRIALS ARE AFFECTED BY THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 AND PROVINCIAL OR

FEDERAL COVID PROTOCOL SHOULD CHANGE BY NOTIFYING THE PARTIES TO THESE EVENTS. AVALON KENNEL CLUB WILL ALSO ABIDE BY THESE RULES ACCORDINGLY. EXHIBITORS, VOLUNTEERS AND VISITORS MUST KNOW THAT THEY ARE ENTERING THE COMMON'S (DURING OUR RENTAL TIME) AT THEIR OWN RISK AND THAT THE COMMON'S NOR THE AVALON KENNEL CLUB WILL NOT ASSUME ANY LIABILITY SHOULD ANY PERSON OR PERSONS, THE EXHIBITOR OR VOLUNTEER OR VISITOR BECOME ILL.

FURTHER INFORMATION

THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE OF VERBAL ABUSE AGAINST YOUR JUDGE, SHOW/TRIAL OFFICIALS AND FELLOW EXHIBITORS. CKC COMPLAINTS WILL BE FILED.

THERE WILL BE ZERO TOLERANCE OF EXHIBITORS NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR DOG WHETHER INSIDE OR OUTSIDE OF THE VENUE. SUPPLIES WILL BE PROVIDED FOR CLEAN UP.

THERE WILL BE AN AKC CANTEEN AT THE VENUE. WE WOULD APPRECIATE YOUR SUPPORT OF SUPPLIES. AS WELL AS PURCHASING PRODUCTS. THIS WILL BE A FUNDRAISER FOR THE CLUB. THERE WILL ALSO BE A TICKET DRAW THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND FOR A SPECIAL PRIZE. DETAILS TO FOLLOW IN THE JUDGING SCHEDULE.

CHAMPIONSHIP POINT RATINGS

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded winners shall be as follows: Dogs competing (including dog awarded winners) in counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from their ring by the judge ***shall not*** be included in the calculation for championship points.

- **In no case may a dog earn more than 5 (five) points at a single show.**
- In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.
- A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

CLASSES OFFERED

CONFORMATION

Regular official classes at the CKC championship show shall be as described below:

<u>Junior Puppy</u>	Dogs 6 (six) months of age and under 9 (nine) months of age on the day of the show.
<u>Senior Puppy</u>	Dogs 9 (nine) months of age and under 12 (twelve) months of age on the day of the show.
<u>12 - 18 month</u>	Dogs 12 (twelve) months of age and under 18 (eighteen) months of age on the day of the show.
<u>Canadian Bred</u>	Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.
<u>Bred By Exhibitor</u>	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.
<u>Open</u>	For all dogs
<u>Specials Only</u>	Dogs which have recorded a CKC registration or event registration number and have attained the required points for championship status.
<u>Exhibition Only</u>	All dogs entered shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as for a dog entered in competition. This is a non-competition class for dogs over 6 months of age. NOTE <i>Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, provided that the owner of the puppy has also entered a dog in one of the regular classes in the show on that day (these puppies are not entered in any competition and there is no fee, however an entry form must be provided on the date of closing of the entries). These non-competing puppies will not be listed in the catalogue.</i>

Non-Regular Classes at this CKC championship show shall be as described below:

** <u>Baby Puppy Class</u>	Baby Puppy Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered to compete in this class. An entry form and entry fee are required for this class. These competing puppies will be listed with their respective breeds in the catalogue. There is no listing fee applicable for these puppies who do not have their registration number, but if a registration number has been obtained from CKC it must be indicated on the entry form. <u>SHOW 1 and 3 ONLY</u>

OBEDIENCE

<u>Pre Novice</u>	for all dogs over 6 months of age (Not eligible for High in Trial)
<u>Novice A</u>	for dogs handled by the owner or immediate family member for all exercises
<u>Novice B</u>	for trainers, multiple entries, exhibitors who have attained a Can. OTCh. degree or dogs who have earned titles in another country.
<u>Novice C</u>	for dogs who have obtained a C.D. title in Canada (Not eligible for High in Trial)
<u>CDI</u>	Novice to intermediate, for dogs who have earned a C.D. title in Canada. (Not eligible for High in Trial)
<u>Open (HA & 18A)</u>	No dog may be entered in more than one OPEN class at one trial (HA &18A). For dogs that have earned a C.D. in Canada but has not earned a title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in these classes must be the owner, co owner or a member of the immediate family.
<u>Open (HB & 18B)</u>	For dogs who have earned a CD in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in either the Open HB or Open 18B class. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility class are also eligible for entry in one of these classes.
<u>Utility A</u>	For dogs who have earned a C.D.X. but not a U.D. in Canada
<u>Utility B</u>	For dogs who have earned a C.D.X. or U.D. in Canada
<u>EXHIBITION ONLY</u>	Dogs 6 months and over, with a TCN, not in competition.

A Bitch in Estrus (season) may not compete in Obedience Trials. See rules and regulations concerning refunds.

RALLY OBEDIENCE

Novice A	For dogs that have not earned the RN title or a CD or higher and are handled by the owner or immediate family member.
Novice B	For any dog until a qualifying score in Advanced is earned.
Intermediate	For dogs that have earned the RN title.
Advanced A	For dogs that have earned the RN title but not earned the RA title and are handled by the owner or an immediate family member.
Advanced B	For any dog that has earned the RN title.
Excellent A	For dogs that have earned the RA title but not earned the RE title and are handled by the owner or an immediate family member.
Excellent B	For any dog that has earned the RA title.
Master	For any dog that has earned the RE title.

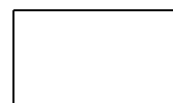
