Please note that there is a \$5 stakeout fee. This money is collected and paid to the landowner to offset the costs of any damage that may be caused by the event and to thank him for his generosity in allowing us to use his land. The \$5 may be added to your entry fees or paid to the Test Secretary at the event.

ENTRY FEES: \$55.00 per dog per test (PLEASE NOTE: each day is a separate test)

Payable in cash, cheque or money order (in Canadian funds) to **The German Shorthaired Pointer Field Club of Alberta (GSPFCA)**

U.S. exhibitors: Our bank will not accept cheques marked "payable in Canadian funds". Entry fees must be paid in Canadian Funds.

LISTING FEE: A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. This listing fee is \$8.30 per dog per each event entered during the field test and is in addition to the entry fee(s). Exhibitors should be aware that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in their records.

NEW THIS YEAR:

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE APPLIES ONLY TO DOGS WHOLLY OWNED BY A NON CKC MEMBER AND ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CKC MEMBERS

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. Please contact the CKC or refer to the CKC website for more details. www.ckc.ca

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to confirm that The Secretary has received their entries.

NOTE: In the case of electronic or telephone entries, the entry is not considered complete until fee is paid and a signed entry form is received by the Test Secretary.

All entry forms must be in the hands of the Field Test Secretary and entry fees paid in full before a dog will be

allowed to run. There will be no exceptions.

Entries close TUESDAY, MAY 3, 2011 at 6:00 pm. Draw will be held on Tuesday, MAY 3, 2011 at 7:00 pm at the home of Janna Jackson, Cranford, AB: ([call Field Test Secretary for directions](#)). Running order will be emailed to handlers by Wednesday May 4, 2011. If you do not have an email address, please call the test secretary to obtain a schedule of running order.

All entries for the Field Test are accepted on condition that the GSPFCA, its officials and members, and the land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this field test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of a parent or guardian.

TEST INFORMATION:

- **Courses & Birds** - Chukar partridge and/or pheasant will be released. The tests will be over a single course with birds released along the course. There will not be a bird field. Three birds will be released for the first dog tested and two birds per dog thereafter. The GSPFCA reserves the right in case of a bird shortage, to use alternate bird species.
- **Horses on the course** - Bird planters, marshals and judges may use horses. All other participants & spectators must be on foot. **All dogs will be handled on foot**
- **Gallery:** At the handler's discretion, a gallery of up to 6 spectators may be permitted to follow the test dogs. Spectators must wear blaze orange, remain together at all times and shall follow the directions of the judges, marshal & gunners. All other spectators must remain in the camp area.
- Total entries will be limited to the **number of dogs** that can be run in approximately 8 hours of judging time.
- **Starting times** will be announced. (Earliest start will be 7:30 am.) Running times are an estimate only and may change due to absentees or dogs "picked up" early. It is the handler's responsibility to be at the start of the course when it is their turn to run.
- **FDJ & FD** dogs will have **20-30 minutes** to complete all aspects of the test. **FDX** dogs will have **30-45 minutes**. Dogs will be run individually in the FDJ & FD Tests; FDX dogs will be run in braces.
- **Firearms** - Official gunners will be the only persons permitted to carry firearms on the test site. In FD & FDX, shotguns will be fired over dogs with bird work when possible. Shooting will be done by **official gunners** only. In FDJ blank shells will be fired – please **provide your own starting pistol** (calibre not less than .22 long).
- Bitches **in season** will not be permitted to run.
- **Collaring** a dog will be allowed only at the judge's instruction.
- **No tracking collars** or any apparel that could be considered a training aid will be permitted.
- **Training or exercising** of dogs is prohibited on the test grounds during the test weekend (from Friday evening until completion of judging on Sunday).
- **Smoking** is prohibited except in the designated camping or headquarters area.
- **Accommodation:** Camping will be allowed on the grounds in the area specified. Please do not leave the trail with your vehicles while driving on the pasture. Facilities are limited, come prepared. Outhouse is provided.

- **Food:** There will **NOT** be a concession at the grounds. Please bring your own food, snacks, water etc.
- **Prizes** - Rosettes will be awarded to all qualifying dogs. All ribbons are to be claimed at the Test – no ribbons will be mailed
- All participants must be familiar with CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Test Rules are available from the CKC. **NOTE: Make sure you review the rules for Field Dog Tests (available on the CKC website: www.ckc.ca)**

LOCATION

From Irricana Alta., junction of hwy. 9 and TWP Rd 270, go east for 13.5 km. Look for gate and sign on Right side of Road. Go through the gate and follow path. Please keep gates closed at all times as there are cattle in the area. The club is grateful to have the use of these grounds and asks for your cooperation in keeping them free of litter. Parking will be restricted to the designated camping areas. Camping on the grounds will be allowed from 4pm May 6th until 6pm May 8th, 2011. Training and running of dogs on the grounds will not be permitted before, during or after the test. Hay must be removed from grounds upon departure.
