- The trial's organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and is in full charge of the trial. This trial is being held under the Agility Association of Canada, Inc. (AAC) Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of these Regulations.
- No provision will be made for inclement weather.
- Move-ups are permitted.
- This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance or

dogs exhibiting signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.

- Before they compete, all dogs must be registered with & have a valid AAC Dog Identification Card. Dogs without an AAC ID number will not receive credit for any legs earned.
- There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, except for injured dogs or bitches that come into season with a Veterinarian's note prior to the Trial.
- No Refunds once the Trial has commenced.
- Agility obstacles will be chosen from those described in the AAC Rule Book, Rubberized Contacts, E-timing are used.
- The ring is 100' X 100' fully fenced with an Entry and Exit gate. Footing is grass
- All dogs with a qualifying score will be awarded a qualifying rosette. As well, first to fourth place ribbons will be awarded in each height division for Standard and Games Rounds. In each of the Veterans and Specials rounds, First to Fourth place ribbons will be awarded in the mini (6" and 10") and open (16" and 22") height divisions. Titling Rosettes are available for all Starter, Advanced and Master Titles up to ATCh & Rosette for Lifetime.
- Bring your own lunch or closest food vendors are 7 minutes away.
- Crating is available in a 30X40 building close to the Trial ring or in your car.
- Parking available on front field close to the trial ring.
- Venue offers 50' X 50' off leash fully fenced play area beside the Little Barn with 1 km hiking trail through wooded area on property.

CLASS DESCRIPTION:

AAC Starters Class: The starters class shall be for dogs not having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. A dog must achieve 3 clear starter rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the ADC title.

AAC Advanced Class: The advanced class shall be for dogs having earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title, but that have not earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC). A dog must achieve 3 clear advance rounds under 2 different judges to be awarded the AADC title.

AAC Masters Class: The Master Class shall be for dogs having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. To be awarded the Master Agility Dog of Canada title by the AAC, a dog must achieve 3 clear Master rounds under 2 different judges.

AAC Veteran Class: Veteran class is for dogs 7 years of age and older or dogs 5 years of age and older who have been competing in the Special Agility Class for a minimum of 1 year.

AAC Special Class: Special class is open to all dogs. A dog entered in Special Classes may move to the Veteran Classes. A dog may no longer compete in the Starters, Advanced & Masters titling classes once entered at an official trial in any of the Veteran or Special agility classes. Dogs moving into Veterans & Specials from regular classes take their titles with them (i.e. they move laterally).

GAMES: Classes are now offered at 3 levels: Starters, Advance and Masters. Progression from one level to the next is as follows: \Box Movement into Advance Games from Starters level games requires 2 qualifying scores under 2 different judges in the game. \Box Movement into Masters games from Advanced level games requires 3 qualifying scores under 2 different judges in the game.

AWARDS: In each of the Starters, Advanced, Masters rounds and all games flat ribbons will be awarded 1st to 4th in each height division. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs that achieve a qualifying score in any class. Titling ribbons will be given out for all titles starter to Life Time Achievement Awards.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES UNLESS COMPETING IN THE RING AND REMAIN 30' AWAY FROM THE RING FENCING. DOGS MUST BE UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES, EACH PERSON IS RESPONSIBLE TO ENSURE THEIR DOG IS BEHAVING CORRECTLY, if not your dog will be asked to leave the venue. You must clean up after your dog, if found not to, future entries will be refused. Please Note: No choke, prong or electric shock collars are permitted on P-N-T property.

Note For 2018: All competitors are required to show their dog's AAC Jump card. Either scan and email a copy to the trial secretary gwen@paus-n-train.com or show it the day of trial.

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog or that I am the duly authorized agent of the dog entered hereon. In consideration of acceptance of this entry, I (we) have read, understand and will abide by the Official Rules and Regulations of the Agility Association of Canada, (AAC)Inc. in effect at the time of this entry, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the Agility Trial Schedule for this event. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and General Agreement/Disclaimer. I (we) agree to conduct myself (ourselves) in accordance with such Official Rules and Regulations (including all provisions applying to discipline) and to abide by any decisions made in accordance with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event (Paus-n-Train Agility & Obedience) has the right to refuse this entry for any reason which the organizing committee deems sufficient.
