The Alberta Lure Coursing Association is excited about taking on the challenge of holding CKC Events during this continuing pandemic. We are absolutely committed to offering you a safe event and will follow Alberta Government guidelines regarding gathering limits, physical distancing, temperature testing and the wearing of face masks.

IMPORTANT: Please read and agree to all rules and guidelines regarding this event. By submitting entries to these events you are declaring that you agree to the following strictly enforced rules and regulations. Please do not enter if you have personal or political reasons for not respecting what we must do to abide by the Alberta Government Covid-19 protocol to keep us all safe.

PARKING & EXHIBITOR BENCHING: Please park in accordance with social distancing guidelines and will be assigned as you arrive. Please inform the Event Trial Secretary by Closing Date if you have mobility issues that require special parking arrangements. Exhibitor benching will be at the vehicle parking site. Pop-Up tents may be set up in your space if needed. Because of Covid-19 Safety Rules - Exhibitors are requested to be self-sufficient while on the grounds. We will have a food truck to provide your meals. Seating will be 'bring your own' and social distancing will be required.

MASKS: This is an outdoor event. Masks are required 100% of the time in the Event Trial Secretary's area, at the line when your dog is running, and in the food truck lineup. Masks are strongly encouraged at all other times REGARDLESS if you can or cannot social distance. We request that you bring your own mask, however, masks are available at the venue.

SOCIAL DISTANCING: Social Distancing must be diligently practiced, and all exhibitors will follow the direction of ALCA volunteers, Event Trial Secretary, Event Chair at all times. Accomplishments are exciting but please ... no hugs or high-5 celebrations outside your bubble!

HANDLERS BRIEFING: Social distancing & Mask protocols are mandatory. Dogs to be gaited to check for soundness and adequacy of equipment for Event Committee without breaching the social distance guidelines. ALCA will provide tissues and designated waste receptacle so that owners can swab females to demonstrate that they are not in season.

HAND HYGIENE: Hand sanitizer will be available to exhibitors and volunteers throughout the grounds – PLEASE USE THEM REGULARLY.

- A continuous loop system will be used for all the events.
- Dogs are required to be present at Handlers' Briefing unless prior arrangements have been made with the Event Secretary. They are free to leave after completion of their run(s).
- Handlers may use a slip lead when releasing their dogs. ALCA will have a limited number available for sale.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety.
- Dogs may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion. All tags must be secured or removed.
- Retractable (Flexi type) leads and/shock collars are not permitted.
- The Chair may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable.
- A \$20.00 fine, payable to ALCA, will be levied for any dog loose on the field at any time between Handlers briefing and the completion of the last test/event.

WHAT IS THE CHASE ABILITY PROGRAM (CAP) TEST?

This exciting event, developed after the ever-popular Lure Coursing, allows dogs to uncover their natural prey drive through chasing a lure - all while having lots of fun. The Chase Ability Test also provides purebreds and mixed-breeds with the opportunity to compete and earn multiple titles and certificates in a field event that all dogs are capable of performing.

Two types of courses will be available: one for dogs shorter than 12 inches at the withers or brachycephalic dogs and another course for the remainder of the dogs entered. The Chase Ability program is a pass/fail event. How does your Dog earn a Pass? A dog must run alone, chasing the lure and complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

The CAP is an athletic pursuit that requires your dog to be in very good condition. Your dog relies on you to ensure this. Females in season may not compete.

If in the opinion of the Test Committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season, it shall not be allowed to compete and the entry fees shall be refunded.

TITLES

There are three titles dogs may earn doing the Chase Ability Program. They are:

Chase Ability (CA)

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event three times under at least two different judges

Chase Ability Excellent (CAX)

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of then times (CA + 7 additional passes)

Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX 2)

awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability event a total of 20 times (CAX + 10). For every further 10 passes the dog may add a higher number after the CAX (CAX 3, CAX 4, etc.)

WHAT IS THE SPRINTER EVENT?

The SPRINTER EVENT was launched by the Canadian Kennel Club on July 1, 2018. The Sprinter is a fun event open to all dogs to enjoy the challenge of running a 100 meter dash. All dogs entered will receive a handicap score based on their height, and their time to finish will be converted to kilometers per hour. Titles are awarded upon the dog accumulating a given number of points.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

SPRINTER EVENT participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

Sprinters are an athletic pursuit that requires your dog to be in very good condition. Your dog relies on you to ensure this, Females in season may not compete. If in the opinion of the Test Committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season, it shall not be allowed to compete and the entry fees shall be refunded.

YOUR TEAM

CKC rules state that 'It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed.' ALCA would like to reinforce this recommendation. Please find a 'buddy catcher' to support your team.

EARNING POINTS

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH).

A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- (a) 18" or greater - handicap is 1.25
- (b) 12" up to less than 18" - handicap is 1.5.
- (c) Below 12" - handicap is 2.0.

Points - KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example $20 \text{ KPH} \times 1.5 = 30$ points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

TITLES

There are four titles dogs may earn doing the Sprinter event. They are:

- Novice Sprinter (NS)** - awarded to a dog that earns 150 points
- Sprinter (S)** - awarded to a dog that earns 500 points
- Advanced Sprinter (AS)** - awarded to a dog that earns 1000 points
- Sprinter Excellent (SX)** - awarded to a dog that earns 1500 points
- Sprinter Excellent 2 (SX2)** - awarded to a dog that earns 2000 points. For each additional 500 points the dog may add a higher number after the SX (SX3, SX4, etc.)

AWARDS

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a score.

A rosette will be awarded to each dog that achieves a CKC Sprinter title.
