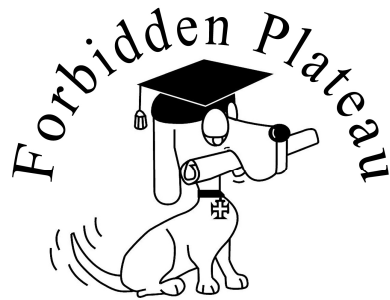

ATTENTION: FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please purchase Bank Drafts of Money Orders payable in CANADIAN DOLLARS. Personal cheques must be payable in US dollars. Please do not mark them payable in "Canadian Funds" or "at par" as such items are not readily cleared through banks.

A listing fee is required for each dog that does not possess an individual CKC registration number, or if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number (ERN), a Performance Number (PEN) or a Miscellaneous Class Certification Number (if designated as a Listed or Miscellaneous Breed with the Canadian Kennel Club). The fee is in addition to each entry for each trial.

CKC Non - Member Participation Fee:

Canadian Resident non-CKC members competing with a wholly owned dog cannot win an award or title unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. The Canadian Resident Non-member Participation Fee is \$57.60. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Move Ups:

A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN, or an MCN and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the CKC Obedience Trial Rules, may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the Trial Secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE FIRST TRIAL ON THAT DAY, schedule permitting.

Females in Season: When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be refunded.

PLEASE NOTE: NO UNENTERED DOGS IN THE BUILDING

REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Novice A: For dogs which have not won a CD (Companion Dog) title in any country. No trainer or person who previously exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in Novice A.

Novice B: For dogs which have not won a CD in Canada. Dogs may be handled or exhibited by owner or any other person.

Open A: For dogs which have earned the title CD in Canada but have not yet earned the title CDX (Companion Dog Excellent) . No trainer or person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in Open A.

Open B: For dogs which have earned the title CD in Canada. A dog may continue to compete in this class after winning the title CDX and / or Utility. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class.

Utility A: For dogs which have won the title CDX in Canada, but has not earned the title UD. Any person who has Trained or Exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families.

Utility B: For dogs which have won the title CDX in Canada or UD (Utility Dog).

Both Utility A and B: Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must enter the dog in all exercises.

¹ Novice A and Open A: one dog only may be entered in these classes by any one exhibitor and every dog must be exhibited by the owner or member of the immediate family.

² Novice B and Open B: For sit and down exercises each dog must have a separate handler.

When a dog is wrongfully entered in any class any score awarded will be cancelled and any trophies must be returned. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the CKC Rule Changes effective January 1st, 2012. The Trial Secretary has attempted to incorporate the entrance changes in this Premium List, but the current CKC Rule Book takes precedence.

TRANSITION CLASSES

Pre-Novice: For dogs which have not won a PCD (Pre-Companion Dog) title in Canada or a comparable title in any country. Only dogs that have not earned a title of CD may enter the Pre-Novice Class.

Novice C: For dogs which have earned a CD, CDX, UD or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada, prior to the closing date of the trial for which it is to be entered.¹

Novice Intermediate: Novice Intermediate Class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any Obedience Trial Championship.¹

¹Novice C and Novice Intermediate: **The scores earned in these classes are not eligible for High in Trial.**

40th ANNIVERSARY PARADE OF VETERAN TITLEHOLDERS

VETERANS: For dogs that have any obedience title and are 7 years old or older on the day of the trial.

RULES GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

FORBIDDEN PLATEAU OBEDIENCE & TRACKING CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THESE TRIALS. THE TRIALS' Superintendents SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THIS EVENT WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB RULES. THE OBEDIENCE TRIALS' Superintendents SHALL PROMPTLY REPORT TO THE CKC ANY INFRINGEMENT OF THIS REGULATION AND THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO TAKE SUCH ACTION AS IT DEEMS FIT ON RECEIPT OF A REPORT INDICATING THAT THIS HAS OCCURRED. Section 20.7, Obedience Trials Rules and Regulations, Effective January 1, 2012, of the Canadian Kennel Club, states "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair" (Trail Superintendent) "shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred."

NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE TRIALS CANNOT OPEN OR BE COMPLETED BY REASON OF RIOT, CIVIL DISTURBANCE, FIRE, ACT OF GOD, PUBLIC EMERGENCY, ACT OF A PUBLIC ENEMY, STRIKE OR ANY OTHER CAUSE BEYOND THE CONTROL OF FPO&TC.

THE TRIALS COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT, LOSS OR OTHER MISFORTUNE TO DOGS, EXHIBITORS OR PATRONS.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD IS TO BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR. IT IS DISTINCTLY UNDERSTOOD THAT EXHIBITORS WILL EXERCISE CONTROL AND RESTRAINT OVER THEIR CHILDREN DURING THESE TRIALS.

THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE TRIALS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING THEIR DOG; REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM THE ENTRY WAS MADE.

ONLY DOGS ENTERED IN THE REGULAR CLASSES OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ARE ALLOWED WITHIN THE PRECINCTS OF THESE OBEDIENCE TRIALS. DOGS ENTERED IN THE OPEN OR UTILITY CLASSES MUST HAVE A CKC INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION NUMBER OR A CKC EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN) OR A CKC MISCELLANEOUS CERTIFICATION NUMBER (MCN).

EXHIBITORS ARE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT AND ACTIONS OF THEIR ANIMALS WHILE THEY ARE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WITH THE EXCEPTION OF EXHIBITING IN THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS, INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE BUILDINGS. DOGS ARE TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.

ANY DOG EXCUSED BY THE TRIALS CHAIRPERSON OR A VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON, SHALL NOT COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARD FOR THE BALANCE OF THESE TRIALS.

THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE COMPLETE IN EVERY RESPECT. EXHIBITORS MUST ABIDE BY ANY ERRORS MADE IN ENTERING THEIR DOG.

IN CASE OF A SUBSTITUTE OR OVERLOAD JUDGE CHANGE, AN EXHIBITOR MAY ENTER A DOG UNDER THE REPLACEMENT JUDGE PROVIDING THAT THE DOG IS ENTERED IN ONE OF THE REGULAR CLASSES OF A SHOW BEING HELD AT THE SAME VENUE BY THE SAME CLUB AND HAS BEEN ASSIGNED A COMPETITION NUMBER. A NEW ENTRY, ALONG WITH THE ACCOMPANYING FEES WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE SHOW SECRETARY UP TO ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SHOW.

TENDERING OF AN NSF CHEQUE IN PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES SHALL BE CONSIDERED NON-PAYMENT, AND IS AN OFFENCE PUNISHABLE BY DISCIPLINARY ACTION AND CANCELLATION OF AWARDS (CH. 16, SEC 3, DOG SHOW RULES).

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY NOT COMPETE. FULL REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR DOGS WITHDRAWN BECAUSE OF INJURY, ILLNESS OR DEATH AND FOR BITCHES IN SEASON, IF NOTIFICATION IN WRITING IS ACCOMPANIED BY A VETERINARIAN'S CERTIFICATE. ALL REFUNDS MUST BE REQUESTED IN WRITING AND ONCE THE CATALOGUE HAS BEEN PRINTED, WILL HAVE THE CKC EVENT FEES AND LISTING FEES, IF APPLICABLE, DEDUCTED.

ANY PERSON EITHER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE JUDGING RING, WHO DOES ANYTHING CALCULATED TO ATTRACT OR DISTRACT OR OTHERWISE AFFECT IN ANY WAY, THE ATTENTION DEPARTMENT OR PERFORMANCE OF A DOG UNDER JUDGEMENT, MAY BE DISCIPLINED BY THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE IN WHATEVER WAY IT CONSIDERS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF FPO&TC, OR THE JUDGE MAY TAKE SUMMARY ACTION.

THE PRECINCTS OF THESE TRIALS ARE THE GYMNASIUM OF QUENEESH SCHOOL. DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY OTHER PART OF THE SCHOOL.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB RULES:

Non-Member Participation Fee (Effective January 1, 2011)

- a) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.
- c) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members.

Information:

- . A non member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.
 - . There are 2 options for non-members:
 - a) Join the CKC
 - b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee
 - . Dogs co-owned by two or more individuals; the first person listed in the CKC dog records will be considered the caregiver of the dog and all communication will be sent to this person.
 - . The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 01 to December 31 in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs or titles or awards earned, and is assessed against the owner(s).
 - . Non members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.
 - . Payment of the Non-Member Participation Fee or becoming a CKC member will protect all awards, points, titles and legs in the calendar year in which they were earned.
 - . Failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the notice will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. Once cancelled the awards, legs, points or titles will be given to the next applicable dog.
 - . Once cancellation takes place, any subsequent awards, titles, legs etc earned will automatically be cancelled without further notice.
 - . The Non-Member Participation Fee is applicable starting at the first event in which the dog earns awards, points, titles, legs and is not prorated.
- *Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the CKC website under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.
